

Rustic Crate

Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Rustic Crate (162265) or Bundle (162268); Sketched Plaid (161424)
- **Cardstock (CS) and Paper:** Very Vanilla (101650); Crushed Curry (131199); Pebbled Path (161722), Early Espresso (119686)
- **Stamp Pads:** Crushed Curry (147087); Memento Tuxedo Black (132708)
- **Tools:** Stampin Cut & Emboss Machine (152392); Deckled Circles (162286); Rustic Crate Dies (162267) or Bundle (162268); Stampin' Blends: Daffodil Delight (154883); Pumpkin Pie (154897); Granny Apple Green (154885); Pool Party 154894)
- **Miscellaneous:** Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Stampin' Seal Adhesive (152813); Rustic Metallic Adhesive Backed Dots (159082); Pebbled Path 3/8" Textured Ribbon (161632); Mini Glue Dots (103683)



Measurements:

- Crushed Curry Cardstock: 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" scored at 4 1/4".
- Very Vanilla Cardstock: 4" x 5 1/4" (cut two) and 3" x 3" for Deckled Circle
- Early Espresso: 2" x 3" to cut hellos

Instructions:

1. Using the Sketched Plaid stamp and Crushed Curry Ink stamp the background onto one of the 4" x 5 1/4" pieces of Very Vanilla cardstock attaching it to the card base with Stampin' Seal Adhesive. Attach the second piece to the inside of the card.
2. Using the Deckled Circle dies to cut a Pebbled Path Circle and one size smaller Very Vanilla circle.
3. Stamp image onto Very Vanilla cardstock using Memento Tuxedo Black ink and color in using Stampin' Blends. Attach circles together with Stampin' Seal Adhesive then to card with Stampin' Dimensionals.
4. Cut a 1 1/2" piece of ribbon, loop it and attach it under image with Mini Glue Dots.
5. Attach Rustic Metallic Dots.
6. Attach Early Espresso cardstock to a piece of an Adhesive Sheet and die cut three hellos using the Rustic Crate Dies layering one on top of the other. Attach to card base.
