The History of Livraria Lello: A Legacy of Literary Excellence



Livraria Lello's story begins long before the iconic building we know today. In 1869, a bookstore called **Livraria Internacional de Ernesto Chardron** was established in Porto. It quickly became a hub for book lovers, writers, and intellectuals. After Chardron's untimely death, the bookstore changed hands several times before being acquired by the Lello brothers, **José and António Lello**, in the early 20th century.

The Ceiling and Lighting

The ceiling is a work of art in itself, with intricate plasterwork and gilded accents. The interplay of light from the skylight above and the carefully placed lamps creates a magical ambiance, making visitors feel as though they’ve stepped into another world.

The Harry Potter Connection: Fact or Fiction?

One of the most enduring legends about Livraria Lello is its connection to the Harry Potter series. While living in Porto in the early 1990s, **J.K. Rowling** was an English teacher and a frequent visitor to the city’s cafés and landmarks. It is widely speculated that her visits to Livraria Lello inspired elements of the Harry Potter universe, particularly the design of **Hogwarts Library** and the **moving staircases**.

Although Rowling herself has neither confirmed nor denied these claims, the rumor has only added to the bookstore’s mystique. Today, it is a pilgrimage site for Potterheads, many of whom come dressed in Hogwarts robes to pay homage to what they see as the birthplace of magic.

What to Expect During Your Visit

Tickets and Admission

To manage the influx of visitors, Livraria Lello now requires an entrance ticket. The cost is €8 (approximately £6.73), which is refundable with the purchase of a book. This price is accurate as of 28/01/2025, but it is always a good idea to check for updates on the [official website](#) or nearby kiosks. Due to its popularity, it is highly recommended to buy tickets in advance, especially during peak tourist seasons.

Operating Hours

Livraria Lello is open from **9:00 AM to 7:30 PM**, Monday through Saturday. It is closed on Sundays. Arriving early or late in the day can help you avoid the busiest crowds.

Exploring the Bookstore

Once inside, take your time to explore both floors of the bookstore. The ground floor offers a wide selection of books, including Portuguese literature, international bestsellers, and rare editions. The mezzanine level provides a quieter space to browse and admire the architecture.

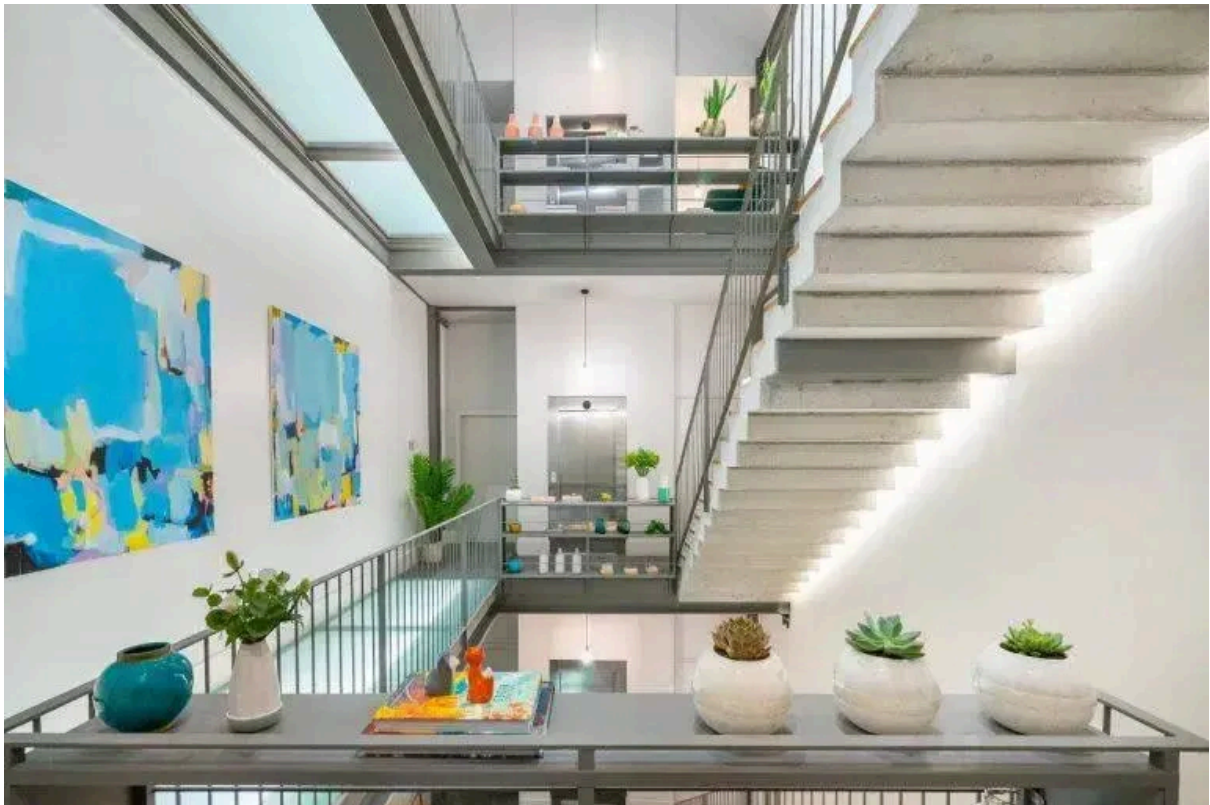
