- **Dream School Litigation**
  - Dr. Kaya provided an overview of Dream School’s claims and YSCP’s counter-claims
  - Mr. Ayata provided additional details about interactions with Dream Schools since the litigation was filed
- **Ferguson Township Zoning Appeal**
  - Dr. Kaya provided an overview of current issues around zoning (based on agreement made with township to conduct traffic study if enrollment goes over 384 students). YSCP is appealing decision at upcoming township meeting 8/27/2019 at 7pm.

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#### VI. -CHARTER SCHOOL’S ADMINISTRATORS REPORTS

- **CEO-Principal Report**
  - Charter renewal letter will be submitted as first step in the process (planned for 2nd week of September)
  - Special Education monitoring (May 2020)
  - Gov Wolf opened a charter school campaign including the following points:
    - Enrollment cap for unsuccessful charter schools
    - Focus on admission and enrollment of charter schools
    - Transparency in finances
    - Conflict of interest disclosure
    - Financial audit

- Oversight of franchised charter schools
- Modification/regulation of renewal process
- Initiate fee-for-service model for costs associated with implementation of charter school law
- Recoup tax-payer costs for free services charter schools receive
- Performance outcome standards
- Moratorium on new cyber charter schools
- Cap on enrollment for low performing cyber schools
- Post employee salaries to PDE site
  - Equitable funding for special education students (in cyber schools)
    - Currently 423 students (though it is in flux right now)
    - To date staff report provided
- **PYP Assistant Principal Report**
  - Unit planners for the year have been mapped out
  - All classrooms will have PYP items displayed (including ‘wonder wall,’ classroom agreements, current program of inquiry)
  - Teachers have had opportunity to work on plans over the summer
  - Language and assessment policies completed
- **MYP Assistant Principal Report**
  - Change in bell schedule - 50 minute periods instead of 60 minute so that students can see students each day → lunch times will be about a half hour earlier
  - Working on putting students and teacher’s schedules on PowerSchool
  - Over summer teachers built curriculum; will be able to send all MYP curriculum documents
  - Team Time - it will continue next year (first month - team building, make team color shirts; will also work on both soft skills and academic goal setting)
  - Oral proficiency training for language teachers
- **Business Manager Report**
  - Detailed business, financial and technology reports covering 2018-2019 school year shared.
