- 2. Notice D background and current (external) collaboration partner updates
  - Purpose: establish a shared understanding of:
    - i. where we were when we submitted the proposal in August 2019,
    - ii. what has happened since then,
    - iii. and who are the stakeholders now
  - Notice D emerged from the PLM work and intersects with the WHO accelerator kits and smart guidelines
  - Original OpenMRS scope in August 2019 proposal with Jembi, Intellisoft, and OCL envisioned:
    - i. Subscribing to OCL
    - ii. Submitting a FHIR bundle to OpenHIM
    - iii. Having an ETL solution
  - Award in February 2019
    - i. Original consortium was split up. New partners were funded, familiar partners funded through other sources.
      - 1. Intrahealth with Smile CDR was funded instead of Jembi.
    - ii. At the time of the award in February, we had a FHIR squad, an OCL for OpenMRS Squad, and no ETL squad working on a solution.
    - iii. Constrained by the award amount, revised scope to give us the maximum amount of flexibility to deliver on a simple solution.
  - Digital Square is a mechanism intended to support alignment of donor investments in digital solutions.
    - i. Notice D is funded by USAID, came out of PEPFAR PLM's work
  - o Intrahealth
    - i. Proposed scope

- Define Measure resources for use case, including PEPFAR HIV (ADX HIV)
- 2. CQL Engine tied into HAPI FHIR
- 3. FHIR server to evaluate Measure resources
- 4. Mediator to convert Measure Reports to ADX
- 5. Documentation and training resources on how to develop measures and CQL
- 6. Engagement with stakeholders to drive greater maturity of technologies
- ii. Scope update (4/2020):
  - 1. With a CQL Engine and HAPI FHIR, looking to have Measures with a library that would be using FHIR.
  - 2. Can request a MeasureReport with any Measures you upload.
  - 3. Can create a Measure and MeasureReport can be generated from it.
  - 4. Instant OpenHIE with Jembi
- Digital Square
  - i. Share a collaborative communication strategy with Digital Square
  - ii. DS is a very "community" "collaboration" friendly donor they like to build this into their awards.
  - iii. DS was established to help donors align their investments in digital solutions (Principles for Donor Alignment) meant to reduce fragmentation
  - iv. Different awards are funded by different donors. This award is funded by USAID
- 3. High level review of <u>deliverables for OpenMRS</u> and Bahmni (Intellisoft)
  - DS deliverables: OpenMRS revised scope is simplified and broader, with as few dependencies included as possible.
  - Grace, Jen, Esther, and Steve have already worked on aligning the workplans for OpenMRS and Bahmni
  - Architectural designs are converging only outstanding point of potential departure is if Bahmni will adopt debezium or continue with atomfeed
- 4. Understand where these scopes and the Notice D deliverables fit in with the data workflows
  - Our responsibility is extracting patient data. OpenHIM, calculating the indicators is out of our scope (Intrahealth?)
  - We still need to identify where other partners fit in
- 5. Go through the current scope of the FHIR and Analytics Engine Squads
- 6. If this is something that we want to work towards together, how can Jen & Grace and other community resources best support the coordination and the work?
  - Yes
  - Still not entirely clear how we collaborate, make sure we re-use what we can
  - We're still wrapping our heads around this: we need to break down the high level deliverables into more tangible actions
    - i. Define who and where the work will happen, when

- Be clear about communication channels and frequency
- Define how are the different Notice D grantees aligning their work
  - i. Jen to reach out to Jenny Thompson about having partners present their scope/solutions
  - ii. Shared technical resources (ie, sandbox/test servers)
