### \*\*\*\*\*RULES OF THE PARKING LOT\*\*\*\*\*

1. Student and parents shall be required to attend a mandatory orientation meeting regarding the NISD Drug Testing Policy. **Failure to attend drug testing policy orientation meeting and failure to sign a consent form will result in loss of permit.**
2. Speed limit for all school property shall be 10 MPH.
3. **Students must park in the student parking lot only!** This area is located in the front of high school (not the AG building, tennis court, west side of the high school and choir/band area). Vehicles in violation will be given a warning sticker and on the third warning sticker the vehicle will be towed away at owner's expense and student will lose parking privileges for the rest of the school year.
4. Once the student parks their vehicle, they must enter the building. They may not just sit in the vehicle.
5. Vehicles must park between the lines and use designated parking spaces only.
6. Students and parents agree to follow the district drug policy. Students and parents agree to let the drug dog company search their vehicle at any time.
7. Vehicles must stop for the School Resource Officer when asked to do so.
8. Students will follow the direction of administration and School Resource Officer at all times.
9. Vehicles must be driven on paved areas only.
10. The owners of any vehicle on school property shall not hold the school accountable for any loss or damage.
11. Students may not go to their vehicle between or during classes.
12. Unsafe driving or actions will result in loss of permit immediately for the remainder of the school year.
13. Cost of permit is \$10.00.
14. Tinted windows must meet state guidelines.
15. Students who are ill, or for some reason must leave campus, must first go the office and pick up a pass from the office.
16. Students must have a valid Texas Drivers License.
17. **The owner of the vehicle must have the student insured on the auto and student must be listed as an insured driver on the insurance card before the permit may be issued.**
18. Students must be in compliance with all the state laws, district policies and school rules.
19. Parking permits must be displayed at all times.
