You get the prescriptions for these shots from your Dr. and then he/she can administer them OR if your pharmacist has the "Travel Certificate" for immunizations you can talk to them and get your shots there. Everyone needs to phone the S'toon Travel Clinic 1-306-655-4780 to arrange to get your typhoid and Hep A/B shots.
- 5. Jana -When you see you DR. you need Imodium PLUS A PRESCRIPTION FOR TRAVELLERS DIARRHEA either CIPRO or AZITHROMYCIN DIHYDRATE PLUS a General broad spectrum antibiotic -do it this month
- 6. Jana- if you are taking pictures and putting them on any type of social media -you must get permission from the person you took the picture of or it CANNOT BE POSTED.
- 7. Jamie How to handle Homesickness and Anxiety when travellers are away.
