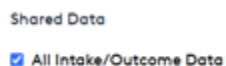

If the box next to “**All Intake/Outcome Data**” is NOT checked, click the blue “Edit” button.

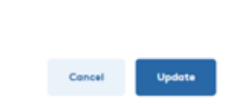

To find and join our coalition, click on “All Coalitions”



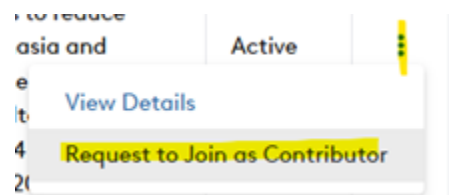
Enter “Florida Shelter” in the search bar and click enter or “Search.”
