Football Game: To help people get in faster we are asking Fans to buy their tickets in advance here: https://www.gobound.com/ia/schools/glenwood/tickets or fans can use their credit/debit card at the gate. Due to the expected crowd, we would suggest having your ticket in advance so we can quickly get you through the gate and into the game. There will be ticket gates at the main entrance, the YMCA & the ramp behind the baseball field. Please follow the signage at the main gate for the quickest entrance into the game. Those with passes, tickets already purchased will stay to the right upon entering the main entrance area.

XC Chicken Dinner-








Our XC Teams will no longer be doing a XC Chicken Dinner.
