I interviewed Randy Titony and Lee Ann Limber from the Limbs For Life organization, which was founded in 1995 by a man named John. A Sabolich, and he saw a need to help amputees who don't have enough money to get prosthetic limbs.

I asked both Randy and Lee, "What challenges does the organization face?" Lee responded, "One challenge we face is not having enough money to make the prosthetic limbs we give out". Then Randy added, "Yes that very much the case, we very much in need for more money." Next I asked, "what is the reason you two to this do type of work." Randy responded "well the reason for me is just helping people in need of prosthetic help." Then Lee said "Yes, that's the same reason for me." Then I said, "what advice would you give a student like me who may want to start a non profit organization." Lee said, "well you should start by starting a fundraiser for whatever you're interested in, then go from there." The last thing I said was, "Have the recent funding cuts from the Trump administration made it hard for you to work." Randy replied, "No not at all, because we don't take government money, we make our own money with our labor."
