MLB: Toronto Blue Jays vs Seattle Mariners - 1 Unit (+120) - 6:08pm ET

Bryce Miller Under 11.5 Outs

Analysis:

Game 5 in Seattle screams short leash. The Mariners already showed urgency in Game 4 (quick hook, leverage pen ready), and they'll have Bryan Woo available behind Miller - meaning one stressful inning or second-time-through traffic can get him out before 12 outs. Toronto just saw him days ago, a familiarity bump that typically drives pitch counts as Springer/Guerrero and the top half force deeper at-bats against his four-seam/zone approach. In a 2-2 series with every baserunner magnified, the bullpen plan + second look outweighs Miller's earlier success this round. **There's no information about the public or money sides of this game.**

MLB: Milwaukee Brewers vs Los Angeles Dodgers - 1 Unit (+110) - 8:38pm ET

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Shohei Ohtani Under 15.5 Outs

Analysis:

Sweep chance = short leash risk. Up 3-0, the Dodgers don't need length; they need clean innings. With a fully armed bullpen and the ability to keep Ohtani's bat in the lineup after he leaves the mound, Dave Roberts can pull the plug at the first sign of traffic or a stressful inning rather than letting him wear a second trip through. Add in Ohtani's light 2025 workload and 12 days between starts (often means early rust/extra pitches), and the path to <16 outs is pitch-count, not damage. Milwaukee's profile helps: top-tier on-base approach, low K rate, and a willingness to foul off heaters to push counts. In a postseason game state where every baserunner is magnified - and with the World Series on deck—our bet is the hook comes before he records out No. 16. **There's no information about the public or money sides of this game.**
