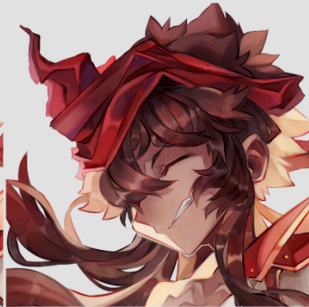

- Grants self Guts status for 1 time, 4 turns
- Increases defense for 3 turns

The faithful battle between two warriors, one stained with the blood from the massacre within the palace and another with the absolute order from the

Sultan to kill the other. For 7 days have the two fought for so long that it was only a matter of time before the other falls

As the Sultan's constant aid, Hang Tuah has voyaged across the seas many times in establishing relationships between kingdoms. With the experience as an admiral, his riding rank becomes higher if he were to steer a ship especially during his Noble Phantasm.

- **Magic Resistance D**
- Increases own debuff resistance by 17.5%.

While the actual class itself does not offer said skill, Hang Tuah's spirituality from learning silat was strong enough to give him even a good enough immunity from weaker magecrafts. It would have been a higher rank if he was summoned in the Caster class.

## **Noble Phantasm:**

---

**“Takkan Melayu Hilang di Dunia” / “Prosperity to my People”**

**Rank:** B-

**Noble Phantasm Type:** Anti-Army

**Range:** 1 ~ 20

Hang Tuah will call forth the ship that he had set sails many years ago as the admiral instead of the warrior, giving orders to his fleets to defend his country from invaders. The ship he boards is manifested from his strong will in becoming the sole protector of his people and therefore raises his party's defenses.

Incidentally, the power to give a boost to his team in terms of defensive support is thanks to the Taming Sari he holds, which is actually capable of being a Noble Phantasm for himself within another class, Assassin. With the power used by the dagger, it gives a protective barrier similar in that of a gust of petals forming a coat around the party. What the Noble Phantasm lacks in power it makes up for defense instead.

In the battle system of **FGO**, his NP would deal damage to all enemies as well as granting 3 turn defense buffs to his party.

## Personality

---

**Hang Tuah** is well known for his act of bravery and determination under the servitude of his Sultan. Whenever there is downtime you can see him either training with a friend in order to keep his toes steady in battle or doing some spiritual training to calm his mind before a battle. When he is not doing that, he enjoys carving out woodland creatures since he finds them quite cute.

While he is a powerful warrior that takes his strict training seriously, he does enjoy being around people , especially respecting those he finds worthy to battle alongside as well as against. His friendly attitude makes it quite easy to strike a conversation with him. Though this may be helped by the fact he was his Sultan's ambassador, giving him much experience in saying what others want to hear.

In battle he is calm and collected, always keeping a lookout to any slip-ups or weaknesses shown by his opponent. He is quick to improve throughout battles in order to cover his own weaknesses or to find one from his enemies and was at the top of his group of friends during under the wings of their teacher.

He is also a bit of a smooth-talker when it comes to the ladies, able to convince princesses from other empires in order to be wed to his Sultan, one of them being Tun Teja who was under the impression she is to be wed to

him instead of the Sultan. Despite being a seasoned warrior, Hang Tuah has trouble understanding the sensitivity of women especially in the modern era with little romantic experience he had before fully submitting himself to the ruling of his Sultan. Due to this dilemma, he had a few slaps here and there from women who were annoyed by his flirtatious antics even if sometimes he did not mean to do so. In a way, he can accidentally flirt with someone without knowing. He is able to use this advantage in getting his way with people in order to extract information from them if so his Master allows it.

You could say he's more bark and no bite in terms of romance.

Regarding his sense of loyalty to his King or Master, he places the absolute importance in carrying out their wishes without a shred of doubt. He sees himself as nothing more but a tool for the greater good and disregards his own emotions whether he agrees with the methods or not. He sees it that a single person like himself is not capable of ruling over a country or his people and so does whatever he can to better his people's lives no matter the cost.

This is however not how he sees it during the battle with Hang Jebat, his childhood friend within that faithful battle within the palace walls. Seeing the massacre and death that was brought upon his 'death', he takes it up to himself to stop his friend whom he deemed as 'beyond saving'. It was not a matter of loyalty versus justice but rather to stop any more senseless killings. He blames himself for the deaths in the palace as well as the death of his beloved friend. To the Sultan, he is but a dagger plunged through his friend's heart. To take a life and to save many more in the future is what he keeps telling himself after that day to save himself from the guilt of it all. The guilt of taking his friend's life and future away.

The battle can easily be wrote off as his sense of loyalty overriding the view of justice Hang Jebat has, however, Hang Jebat 's 'justice' was no more an overwhelming sense of emotions over the lost of his best friend and Hang Tuah's 'loyalty' was more so for his loyalty to Jebat, to stop him from becoming a killer. The incident completely affected Hang Tuah's psyche yet he continued to serve the Sultan faithfully for many years until his 'disappearance'.

---

## Motives and Attitude Towards His Master

---

With a high sense of loyalty and order, Hang Tuah has no qualms with his Master, even if they are more so on the injustice side. Justice was never truly something he himself holds in high regard, unlike someone he once knew. For a Master that dwells within blackmail or betrayal, Hang Tuah will see fit that he does whatever he can to cooperate and grant victory to them both. While he may find it distasteful, he will still carry out his mission without hesitation.

If the Master is one with a heart of gold, the Malaccan warrior would be more than eager to assist them in their plight. Hang Tuah will at first treat them as his King, but over time may even see them as a close friend and would simply hang out with them talking about whichever topics that come to mind just as he did with his old friends.

His wish, should he and his Master ever achieve complete victory in the Holy Grail War, is to protect the people he loves, to see a bright future for all of them and be at peace afterwards. However, he never outright states this as



he gives full authority and power of the Grail to his Master whom he is most loyal to. The only types of Masters he would have trouble with are the ones who are with high authority and do not serve their people well. From Hang Tuah's past with his own tyrannical King, he does not wish to serve one who cannot serve their own people.

---

To serve a King is to also serve one's people, the strong belief Hang Tuah has held for years as the Sultan's warrior and ambassador. What truly blossoms his love for his people are the memories and moments he holds dearly. For all of it to disappear be one fate he will do whatever it takes to prevent. Summoned into his greatest peak as an admiral, he wastes no time contemplating about the past and strives to stop anyone from attacking his home. But before all of that, he was just your average village boy.

He was once just a young boy who wanted to help his family's wood carving business. His skills as a warrior were ever so present even from a young age with how in tune he was with his spirituality and his pretend fights with his friends. It showed potential and with that potential he was then known as the most skilled silat masters in the world.

In that fateful battle, the battle that determined it all and the battle that is most known for in all of Hang Tuah's stories and legends was the battle he

had facing his greatest opponent, as well as his closest companion, Hang Jebat. Did he have the choice to talk things out? The choice to help his friend? The choice to side with justice and against tyranny, that he did. But he swore not to the Sultan but to his dear crazed friend, he knew what he needed to do to prevent anymore bloodshed.

## General Armaments

---

A mystical dagger he had won from the ruler of Majapahit himself after winning a duel against the famous warrior **Taming Sari**, in which was also the name of the dagger he obtained. It is a powerful weapon that is imbued with mystical powers as well as capable of giving full invulnerability to anyone who wields it from physical attacks. It is also capable of attacking on its own in place of its wielder. The weapon is in actuality a Mystic Code similar to that of Ruby and Sapphire.

Hang Tuah has been known as the most skilled silat master in the world and is capable of incapacitating his foes swiftly. Between Hang Jebat and himself, he is by far the superior fighter but due to the former wielding Taming Sari, it was a miracle in itself Hang Tuah was capable of lasting that long. While his arsenal may not look impressive, he does very well in one-to-one combat with the help of Taming Sari's invulnerability and distracting the enemies, defeating Hang Tuah will be no easy task.

As well as having the title of an admiral, he is capable of commanding a fleet to defend his home from any outside invaders. Due to being in the Rider

class, his armada is available to his disposal for any fights within a Holy Grail War

## Taming Sari ( Abilities and Personality )

**Taming Sari** was named after its original user before being gifted to **Hang Tuah** by the Ruler of Majapahit for his victory against the former owner, Taming Sari whom the weapon was named after. Those who wield the weapon are fully imbued by powerful magic that makes them completely invulnerable from physical attacks as well as attacking on its own. It seems as if the weapon was created by an extremely skilled mage in Indonesia.

Little did anyone know, the magical artifact is actually sentient and is capable of conversing with its owner or to any being that is similar to it. Taming Sari's personality is that of a grumpy old man who at first despised **Hang Tuah** for killing his previous owner. But as time goes on, they have formed a close bond with one another like that of old friends, though Taming Sari is the older of the two, he would scoff and say how he is still within his prime.

As **Hang Tuah** served under the **Sultan**, **Taming Sari** would get quite annoyed of how much of a lapdog **he** really is and wonders if he even is human for him to act so obedient. **Taming Sari** would also call **Hang Tuah** 'loyal dog' or 'King's favorite slave' whenever he can just to spite him. He

would also leap out of the man's belt and hit him right on the head (with his sheath still on ) whenever **Hang Tuah** worked way too hard.

Despite **Taming Sari**'s harsh words, the old kris truly does care for his new owner and does not want to see the young man waste his life becoming nothing but a tool, which **Taming Sari** has to deal with all the time. All in all, the two worked well together.

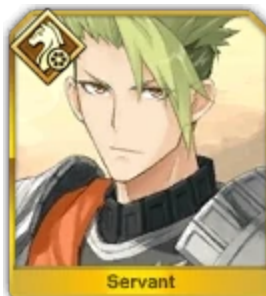
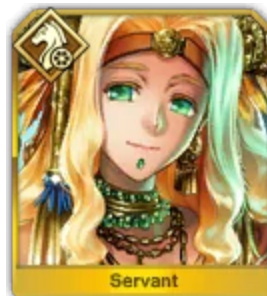
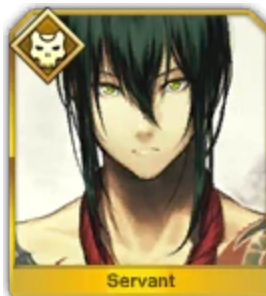

# GAMEPLAY

For Hang Tuah's gameplay kit, I really do want to make him a buster/arts crit as the cards focus on both power and support. This fits well with Hang Tuah's powerful martial arts skills but also his love for his people. His two Arts cards do help with getting NP back after using his AOE Arts NP but it is not a very powerful NP as its main usage is getting defense for the party similar to Mash's Lord Camelot NP. This is due to Hang Tuah's more personal and up close attacks with his silat which would probably end up making his Assassin class's NP a ST with using Taming Sari as his NP along with his superior silat martial arts.

# CHARACTER DESIGN

Now on to Hang Tuah's design, it is heavily inspired by book covers and illustrations and a film in which he wears primarily red for his clothes. If I have to be 100% honest, his design is especially inspired by the cancelled Hang Tuah character for Mobile Legends. In turn, his friend Hang Jebat wears blue instead which makes a nice contrast between the two warriors. It also helps tell the conflict between the two's ideals and beliefs with one another.

Hang Tuah's portrait has shown the man having long hair which many fanservants from what I've seen incorporate that as well with long haired characters being quite popular in mainstream anime. And yeeah the biggest feature I and many others also leave out is Hang Tuah's facial hair.

Sorry old man, get on with the times- just kidding, facial hair isn't very popular with the newer generations so I did not incorporate it in. Sorry facial feature fans.

For his final ascension card, I haven't worked on it yet but I will draw Hang Tuah posing in front of an incoming ship ( run my guy ) referencing many book covers with this exact pose. Of course the angle will be different as to create something new rather than anime-fying an iconic look. ( I have done that a lot but shh )

The yellow/gold colors emphasizes Hang Tuah's royalty connections with him becoming the Sultan's aid and being very close with said Sultan. For his further ascensions the gold and more accessories may be more present within the design but for now, I am brainstorming how exactly to color over his sprite ;;

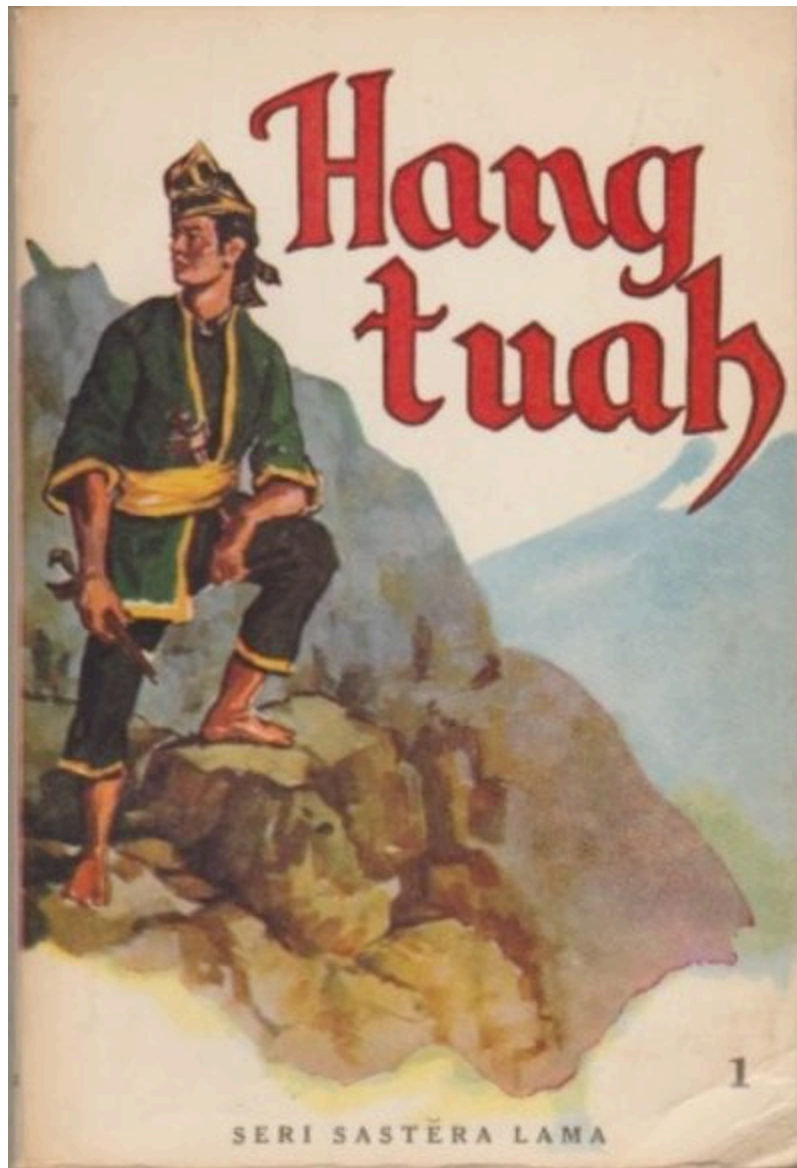
