FROM THE COUNTRY CLUB: Please do not walk, play or bike along the cart paths on the golf course. The ONLY people allowed on the course are those that have an active tee time.

FROM SECURITY COMMITTEE: Golf carts DO NOT have the right of way at golf crossings. Golfers, please adhere to the STOP signs on the cart paths and yield to the roadway.

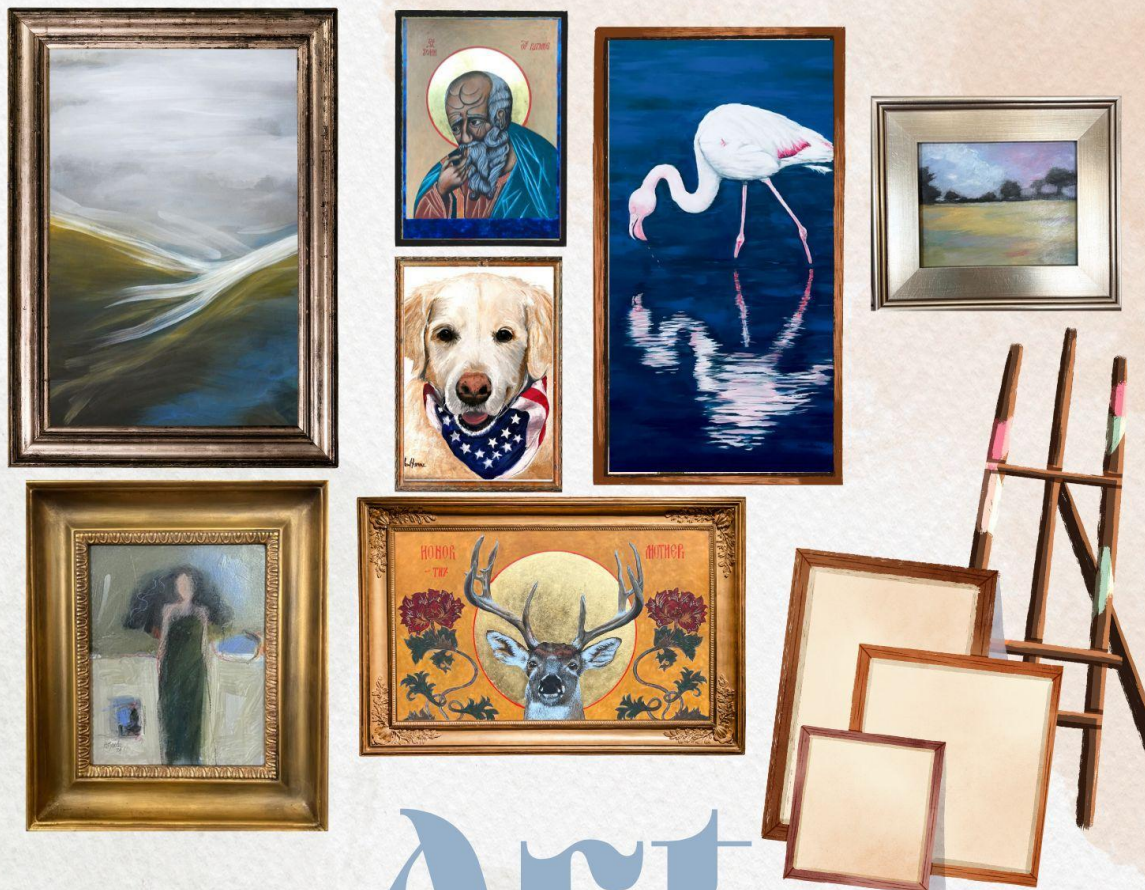

Over 1.9 million people in the U.S. are diagnosed with Type 1 Diabetes. It most frequently affects children, teens, and young adults.

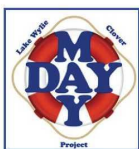
There is no cure. It requires a 24/7 delicate balance of frequent blood sugar checks, carb counting, and insulin monitoring.

T1D is an autoimmune disease where the pancreas does not make insulin. The cause is unknown and it is irreversible.

Symptoms:

- Frequent urination
- Increased thirst
- Dry mouth
- Itchy, dry skin
- Increased appetite
- Unexplained weight loss
- Yeast infections

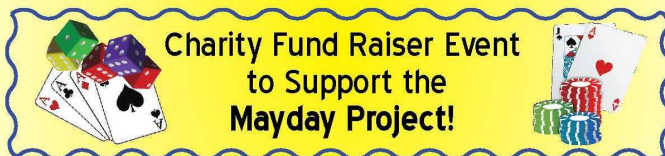
