- Complete written work as directed by supervisor based on the needs of the students
- This position will support mostly general education students, but may also support special education students as needed
- Other duties as assigned by supervisor

- Patience and calmness with students of all abilities and personalities
- Competent technology and writing skills
- Ability to work independently with minimal supervision
