STUDENT ATTENDANCE:

WEDNESDAY SIGN-OUT:

- Students and parents should discuss whether or not the student will sign-out each week before the student leaves home on Wednesday. We had a ton of phone calls this past week, and notifying numerous students is a challenge for our secretary.

- Students who have a permission slip on file in the office may sign-out at 2:25 PM on Wednesdays.

- No student may leave campus before 3:25 PM without signing out.

- To expedite the process, students will sign-out with their 8th period teachers from this point forward.

- If a student does not sign-out, they MUST report to the cafeteria and sign-in with the staff there.
