Woodside Lego robotics team will work to create and communicate ways to share art across the globe through STEM. Within that, the team will identify a problem and create a prototype of an innovative solution. The Lego Eaters compete as part of the First Lego League (FLL). This year's theme is Submerged. Our team will use creative thinking and Lego technology to explore the layers of the ocean and bring their learning to the surface as they "sea" the future. The TEAM will also be designing, building, and programming a robot to complete the different challenges that are presented as part of the robot game. *** NEW CLUB FORMAT ***

Chess club is open to all current Woodside students. Club members receive a 30-mins. instructional session, 30-mins. practices of lesson materials, as well as free play chess games. Younger students can be picked up earlier during their practice session.

The structure of the program is as follows:

3:30-4:00 Free Play & New-Start Lessons (0-minimal experience with chess)

4:00-4:30 Thematic chess topics that rotate week to week.

4:30-5:00 Practical: Practicing concepts taught in class.

Each practical game result will be recorded, and unofficially rated (internal club rating only). At the end of series of class topics, the student with the most practical games played wins "The Woodside Chess Monster" trophy. And the student with the most wins will be awarded "The Woodside Top of the Class" trophy.

** Each session needs to be registered to participate for the entire year. However, sessions will not be available for registration until Nov 15th (Winter), and Feb 10th (Spring). Those who enroll consecutively will receive a coupon toward the next session as a "thank you for your support!"
