Current Work

User Lifecycle Policy Configuration Update (from Zoom Al)

User Lifecycle events (wiki page)

The team reviewed progress on a user lifecycle workstream, where Vivek presented a new configuration option under Miscellaneous that allows users to set up lifecycle events and policies. The system enables users to define events (such as group removal), actions (like setting an end date for membership), and policies (with low, medium, or high severity levels), with a maximum of 10 events per policy.

Vivek demonstrated how policies can be assigned to groups through the UI, with only one policy allowed per group, and explained that the configuration will be reflected in the attribute assignment section.

User Lifecycle Events Implementation (from Zoom AI)

The team discussed the implementation of user lifecycle events, including database tables and daemons for tracking events and managing group memberships.

Chris explained that a new daemon would check for lifecycle events in groups and adjust attributes accordingly, with manual override options for managers.

The team agreed to improve the UI visualization and documentation, and to invite Georgia Tech to the next dev call to review the implementation of their suggested features.

User Sync Endpoint Progress Review (from Zoom Al)

Shilen reported progress on a new endpoint for syncing users with a data provider, including adding it to the grouper client and implementing group authorization.

He also fixed issues related to duplicate keys in source data and job status overrides. Chris reviewed Shilen's work and suggested documenting the new endpoint on the web service page.

They briefly discussed upcoming tasks and agreed to reconnect soon for a more detailed discussion.

Grouper UI Announcement Banner Implementation (from Zoom AI)

Chris discussed the implementation of an announcement banner in the Grouper UI, explaining its functionality and customization options. He outlined how the banner would display in different UI contexts and emphasized maintaining backwards compatibility for customizations. Chris also suggested potential applications for the banner, such as displaying training requirements for power users and admins.

Group Screen Customization Overview (from Zoom AI)

Chris explained how customization works with headers and divs, clarifying that it involves adding new elements rather than replacing existing ones. He described the structure of the group screen customization, including the use of HTML tables for alignment and the possibility of adding dynamic content through the groupViewLogic method. Chris also demonstrated a feature that counts the number of stems in a group, showcasing its functionality.

System Updates and Bug Fixes (from Zoom AI)

The team discussed several updates and bug fixes for their system. Chris explained improvements to group member addition functionality and performance optimizations for folder screens and GSH templates.

Chad reported progress on fixing the report editing screen issue, though some challenges remain due to the system's design.

Ben raised a request from service desk staff to access user-level audit logs without full sysadmin privileges, which Chris agreed to investigate further.

The team also discussed improvements to unique ID generation for reports and debugging logs.

Grouper Banner Customization Discussion (from Zoom AI)

The team discussed implementing banner functionality in Grouper, with Kellen sharing his experience of customizing templates at UVA to display maintenance messages and environment information. Chris agreed to add banner customization to his list of features to implement, and the team discussed the possibility of including blank includes for customer

customization. Shilen suggested adding customizable content below the group summary header in the summary screen, which Chris agreed to consider further with more specific requirements.

Docker File Permission Best Practices (from Zoom Al)

Chris and Chad discussed Docker file permissions and multi-stage builds. They clarified that file permissions should be set in the stage build, not the final image, to avoid creating unnecessary layers. Chris agreed to revise the Dockerfile to remove permission changes in the final image and will test if the container works without them. They also discussed the need for an empty /root directory in the final image for mounting purposes.

Custom UI and Group Summary Updates (from Zoom AI)

Shilen demonstrated a custom UI for Grouper and discussed the possibility of inserting custom content into the group summary, such as attributes and descriptions. Chris Hyzer and Shilen debated the feasibility of implementing this feature, considering performance implications and the need for Java classes or JSPs. They agreed that a Java class interface could be a viable solution. Shilen also mentioned updates to JIRAs, including adjustments to fail-safes in data providers and the ability to approve them in the UI.

Data Provider Sync Issues Resolved (from Zoom AI)

Shilen and Chris discussed issues with data providers, focusing on a bug where new members weren't being created for subject sources and Gail's problem with only half of data changes being processed. Shilen agreed to work with Gail to investigate and fix the changelog issue. They also reviewed a new web service for triggering data provider syncs, discussing its functionality and the need for better error handling and response codes. Chris suggested making the service accessible to a built-in group with appropriate privileges.

UI Cleanup and Jira Issues (from Zoom AI)

The team discussed two main topics: UI config cleanup and Jira/Confluence issues. Chad requested approval to remove unused UI configs, which was granted with the condition of tracking and documenting removed items for future reference. Chris Hubing reported on Jira and Confluence upgrade issues, including problems with user creation and browsing, and mentioned that TSG is investigating the problems. They also discussed managing issue creation permissions, with Chris Hyzer suggesting using the co-manage UI to add appropriate team members to the issue creation group.
