*For Math 7 and Math 7 Plus, a calculator that has the four basic math operations, exponents, and fractions will work. For Math 7 Plus, the TI-84 is recommended in efforts to get students accustomed to some of the features of a graphing calculator. For Math 1, a graphing calculator is required, such as the TI-84. There is an online calculator that students are able to access if they do not own a physical calculator. Thank you!

Family Contact Information Form: Please fill out the family contact form online if you did not already do so. This only needs to be completed **once** for all 7th grade teachers.

Websites: Students should bookmark their teacher's website. The homework calendar is posted there! Go to www.wcpss.net/millsparkms, click on "Academics," select "7th Grade," scroll down to "Math," and click on your math teacher.

Warm-ups: Monday-Thursday students will be given two warm-up questions they must answer during the given class time. This can be new material or review of previous material. On Fridays, students will complete a four-question warm-up quiz. This warm-up quiz will be put into PowerSchool as a classwork grade.

Homework: Every problem on a homework assignment should show some attempt or thought process. Homework will be given on a daily basis and is due the next day. Homework is extremely important to practice what was taught in class. We expect students to show work on a separate piece of paper or another online tech tool. Homework is graded on completion.

Absences and Make Up Work: Students who are absent from math class are responsible for collecting any missing work and notes from the days of their absence(s). If an absence occurs, it is very important and expected that a student checks the homework calendar for activities missed that day and turn in graded assignments within two days of their absence.

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Late Work Policy: Work turned in after the due date, but prior to the late work deadline can earn up to an 80% grade. Note that this policy applies to students with extended time (IEP/504) only AFTER their extended time has expired. After that extended time, we should take late points.

Test Point Recovery: This is only available on tests and projects if the student scores below 70%. The student will be given the opportunity once within a specified time frame to demonstrate mastery. A Delta Math assignment based on the Unit's standards will be assigned and must be fully completed in order to be eligible for point recovery. A student can earn up to a 70% on the assessment.
