Goal 1: Improve Financial Support

Donation, Endowments and Funding:

- Pursue fundraising events and activities to meet specific needs within the library, with a focus on library collection and learning spaces.
- July 2023: Attend Clear Creek Amana Foundation meetings and work closer with the Springmier Library Foundation to address new ways to inform community members about the Springmier Foundation and the support it provides the library.
- December 2023: Find appropriate community members, through the library board and "Friends Group," to help in pursuing grants and other funds from local and state outside sources.
- August 2023: Receive, and provide, training to implement a donor recognition program for the Springmier library and begin the task of implementing it throughout the year.
- In July 2023 the director will address both short term and long term finance goals for the library's planning and operations and proceed in accordance with realistic projections with the Tiffin City Council, the Library Board, Johnson County Board of Supervisors and the Clear Creek Amana School Board Of Education

Goal 2: Friends Group

- Establish a "Friends Group" August 2023, with the goal of meeting monthly (in conjunction with the library board)
- Attend webinars and create connections with libraries in the community that have an established "Friends Group"
- Provide adequate education to members of the "Friends Group" on methods on how to collect materials to seek donations, endowments, estate and memorial giving.

Looking into these efforts will allow the library to sustain and enhance their current service, and work toward their long term goals

Goal 3: Enhance Access to Library Services

- Update and add devices to public computer lab
- Purchase and implement computer monitoring software
- Create and share Public Service Survey to collect data on library programming, hours, and services in order to offer user-centered services

- December 2021 Find appropriate community members to help in pursuing grants and other funds from local and state outside sources.
- We have not found anyone to pursue grants for the library but will continue to work on that 2023-2028.
- August 2020 Get training to implement a donor recognition program for the Springmier library and begin the task of implementing it.
 - We were unable to implement the donor program but will continue to work on this in 2023-2028.
- In January 2021 I will address both short term and long term finance goals for the library's planning and operations and proceed in accordance with realistic projections with the Tiffin City Council, the Library Board, Johnson County Board of Supervisors and the Clear Creek Amana School Board Of Education.
 - The City of Tiffin cannot even give us a realistic projection. With our growth having us as one of the fast's growing cities in Iowa. There are so many things on the docket water plant upgrades, streets and sidewalk repairs, new businesses, roundabouts, a rec center and so much more.
