- March 2022 minutes were approved
- Financial Report reviewed by Rodrigo Gouveia
 - Carryover of \$25K for next year, ~\$15K below what we'd foreseen spending. This suggests we should be spending more.
 - We increased spending on staff appreciation. Per Mr. Bilock Staff appreciation last week was much appreciated by teachers and staff
 - Opportunities for spending in the future:
 - Minigrants
 - Enrichment programs
 - We need to know much will be spent on 8th grade events
 - We can move funds around as long as they remain within the same category. Otherwise it requires approval of reallocation.
 - Heather Collick has volunteered to explore an ice cream cart and/or coffee cart as an additional staff appreciation event before the end of the year.
 - We voted to move \$2K from enrichment and \$2K from family support outreach into student activities.
