- a. Known facet display issue
 - i. Scrolling issue/facets stick over search bar
 - ii. Primo listserv reports worse on Macs, specific triggers (brand new search)
 - iii. Blake used a css fix (not perfect but better; can't guarantee it won't break something else) *[See below](#).
- b. System down issues
 - i. Do we still need to flood ExLibris with cases?
 - 1. Yes for system down.

2. No for when it is just some issues appearing. At this point, an Alliance-level case is the best bet.
- c. How reliable is the [Status Page](#)?
 - i. It is only reliable if someone has already reported problems and Ex Libris has updated the page.
 - d. Support follow-up re: Rapido
 - i. Institutions are not seeing the right forms/availability. This became a bigger issue than originally reported, and hopefully a November fix will address some of these issues.
 - e. SCTS/NRSG - exploring removing the books local resource type
 - i. Overhead: Institutions need to add 972 to reserves personal copies in order for them to show as print books
 - ii. Bug: It is causing the wrong digitization request to appear for print books in Rapido (possibly not related to the resource types, but to rft.genre)
 - iii. Bug: It appears to be causing a lack of relationships with print books (i.e., book reviews are not associated with print books)
 - f. No deduplication is happening at the NZ level and there is no ETA on when that will be fixed (current status is that dedup only affects IZ records)
