

### **Arguments In Opposition:**

- +46% Net Effective (73% to 27%): “There’s a reason crime is down this year—we invested in putting more police on the street. Police make our communities safer, not mobile crisis response units. We need to stay the course and support the investment we’ve made in increasing the size of police departments.”
- +18% Net Effective (59% to 41%): “There’s no need to implement alternative approaches to community safety. We all know what makes cities safer: more police.
