WHEN, WHERE	When and where does the problem occur
WHY	Why do you think this is important to solve

Lets build out the details of WHO. Map it out on a large sheet of paper with the WHO you defined earlier placed in the center of the paper.

- 1. Who are the other people in this persons life connected to this challenge? Who are the supporting characters?
- 2. What are their hurdles/conflicts (internal and with other characters)?
- 3. What is happening in this scene? What are the challenges in this scene? How do you characters in this scene interact when these challenges are happening?
- 4. What is working for the characters? Not everything is a challenge, somethings are good and helpful what are those?
- 5. What are the characters driven by? What is their motivation and aspirations?
