

10 Tips for Assessing with Integrity in the Age of AI

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How to manage student use of AI and writing in the age of AI.

Prioritize pedagogy over punishment...

1. Provide clear guidelines on when and how AI tools can be used.
2. Educate students on the ethical use of AI tools.
3. Design assignments that require critical thinking.
4. Implement process-oriented assessments (e.g., drafts, outlines, presentations).
5. Encourage open discussions about AI use in coursework.
6. Focus on developing skills AI cannot replicate (e.g., creativity, analysis).
7. Incorporate in-class writing and presentations.
8. Teach information literacy and source evaluation.
9. Emphasize the value of original thought and personal growth.
10. Create a culture of integrity through positive reinforcement.

Six Tenets of Writing in the Age of AI

1. Human-AI writing is normal.
2. Human creativity is enhanced.
3. Language barriers disappear.
4. Humans relinquish control, not responsibility.
5. Attribution is critical and always provided.
6. Past definitions of plagiarism no longer apply.
