#### ***Calling Talented Kansas Public Library Workers: Know Your Value and Experience Growth***

In online competency-focused sessions, the School of Library and Information Management faculty presents the mission, fundamentals, and the libraries' roles in improving lives by addressing community needs. Addressed are aspects of the ethics, values, and governance of libraries, and the basic knowledge needed for public library positions. All sessions are for all new and veteran library workers, as well as anyone interested in becoming employed in a Kansas Library. No prior college attendance is required. The topic selection recognizes library workers' existing skills and provides opportunities to learn more. Participants will experience low-stress, high-impact learning opportunities through engagement with knowledgeable others without leaving their library or home. Access is through enrolled participant's Canvas account to view materials and engage in learning activities.

There will be seven sessions. Each session is a month long.
