TSI

Why does my student need to take this test?

- Students need to pass TSI ELAR and TSI MATH by the end of their senior year so they do not have to take remedial classes in college.
- Students that want to take dual credit classes must pass TSI ELAR by the end of their sophomore year and TSI MATH by the end of their junior year.

Who can test?

- Any student unless specifically stated

How do I sign up to take the test?

- Sign up sheets will be posted in google classroom with deadlines. Students will sign up with Ms. Moreno in the front office a week before the test.

ASVAB

Why does my student need to take this test?

- RHS uses this aptitude test as data to talk to students about careers they might want to pursue based upon their abilities and interests.

PSAT

Why does my student need to take this test?

- The test will allow sophomores to get an idea of what the SAT will be like. Their scores also help us decide who is best suited to sit for the National Merit Scholarship PSAT their junior year.

Who can test?

- Any Sophomores
- Select Juniors for National Merit Scholarship

Why does my student need to take this test?

- Many scholarships require students to supply an SAT or ACT score in order to apply.

How do I sign up to take the SAT?

- You must register online at
 - <https://collegereadiness.collegeboard.org/sat/register>
- If you qualify for free or reduced lunch, you can get:
 - Two SAT Waivers
 - Four college application waivers
- See Mrs. Greer for waivers
- Students with Accommodations
 - You need to request accommodations with Mrs. Greer
 - College Board will review and approve or deny the accommodations request
 - It takes 7 weeks for accommodation approval from SAT
 - Once approved, Mrs. Greer will notify you
 - Then you may register for your SAT

ACT

Why does my student need to take this test?

- Most colleges/universities require specific ACT or SAT scores to gain admission to their institution.
- Many scholarships require students to supply an ACT or SAT score in order to apply.

Who can test?

- Juniors and Seniors
- All juniors will test for free on the ACT School Day, Mrs. Greer will register and the district will pay for testing

How do I sign up to take the ACT?

- You must register online at
 - <https://www.act.org/content/act/en/products-and-services/the-act/registration.html>
- If you qualify for free or reduced lunch, you can get:
 - Two ACT test waivers
- See Mrs. Greer for waivers
- Students with Accommodations
 - You need to register for your test then request accommodations with Mrs. Greer
 - ACT will review and approve or deny the accommodations request
 - It takes 2-4 weeks for accommodation approval from ACT
 - Once approved, Mrs. Greer will notify you
