Who can participate- Ages

- 3. 2nd Grade and Under (Coloring Pages to be done in classroom)
- 4. Elementary 3rd- 5th Grades
- 5. Junior High/Middle School 6th 8th Grades
- 6. High School 9th 12th Grades

Categories

- 1. Old Testament
- 2. New Testament

And

- 1. Individual
- 2. Group of 2-4 (all members of a group must be in the same age grouping)

Divisions

- 1. Paper
- 2. Display/Project
- 3. Performance

General Rules

- Participants can enter only one time per division. (example student may enter in paper, individual project and group performance- a participate cannot enter into group display/performance and individual display/performance)
- Each church affiliation that recognizes contestants must provide one judge that is established within the church.
- 3. The decision of the judges is final and is not disputable.
- 4. Any situation that arises that is not covered by these guidelines will be of the ruling of the Bible Fair director and members of its committee.

Name

Paper

- Papers are only for individuals
- Paper Length-- (E 1 page), (JH/MS 3-5 pages), (HS 5-10 pages)
- All Papers will contain a title page with the paper's title in the top center of the page.
 Name and Grade
- E and JH/MS papers can be handwritten in their own handwriting or typed. HS must type their paper in no larger than a 12 font.
- Paper should be well developed with an introduction, Bible supported Body and Conclusion.
- The introduction should clear state the purpose of the paper and its importance.
 It should also state what you hope to achieve with writing on your topic.
- Pictures/Drawings/ Tables/Graphs/Maps are encouraged but do not count in the length of the paper.
- Body should list Bible references and/or outside reference sources, such as books, articles, personal interviews, and websites.
- Summary should summarize the main purpose of the writing.
- A separate page not counted in the length of the paper should give credit to all those who have helped you with your paper.
- Presentation and neatness will account for part of the scoring.

- Display must be student –self operated/explained to the different aspect of the project during time of judging.
- A title and purpose/story/biblical lesson should be in plain view. Make sure everything is explained/labeled clearly for the audience as if seeing the project for the first time unattended.
- Size of project/displays shall be no larger than 18 in/45.7 cm deep, 48 in/122 cm wide and no taller than 36 in/ 91.4 cm high. All displays/projects must be self standing and sit on a table top. Store bought display boards meet this criteria.
- Pictures/Drawings/Tables/Graphs/Maps must be clearly sited if obtained from a outside sources. Personal photographs are permitted providing names are excluded.
- Displays should be creative, neat, and appealing to the eye of your audience.
- Displays that require electricity must supply their own power source or wall electrical sockets may be available at a first come first served bases.
- Any handouts to judges/public must be limited to one page with printing on only one side.
- Live, sharp, flammable, and anything deemed dangerous are prohibited items for the display.

- Performances shall begin with a statement of the title, performers' name(s), and purpose of the performance.
- Performances should be original in nature with a biblical story/lesson clearly evident within the delivery.
- All props and costumes shall be of appropriate nature. Live, sharp, flammable, and anything deemed dangerous are prohibited props for the performance.
- Performances shall be no shorter than 3 minutes and no longer than 5 minutes. A penalty in scoring for all performance that does not meet the time limits.
- Performances should be creative, original and informative/entertaining to your audience.
- Any handouts to judges/public must be limited to one page with printing on only one side.
- Performers should be prepared to answer questions about their performance after their presentation.
