A bar of soap has a surface that is smooth and hard.

Description: Bars of soap are shaped like rectangles and fit in the palm of your hand.

A cupcake is squishy and soft.

Salient Features: Cupcakes have a square shaped bottom and a triangular shaped top.

A lollipop is sticky and hard.

Salient Features: Lollipops have a long thin stick to hold onto and a round top to lick.

A pillow is fluffy and soft.

Description: Pillows come in many different shapes and sizes. This pillow is a square.

A table is smooth and hard.

Salient Features: Tables have a flat top surface and usually have four legs.

A raspberry is spongy and soft.

Salient Features: Raspberries are red, small, round and bumpy.

A carrot is smooth and hard.

Salient Features: Carrots are orange and long. When they grow, they have a leafy green stem.
