School Assignments

The maximum number of MUN delegates to be sent by IASAS schools this year is 14-16 (16 for the current and future host schools ISB and TAS, 14 for the other four IASAS schools, ISKL, ISM, JIS and SAS). The maximum number of MUN delegates to be sent by Associate IASAS schools this year is 10. Please note that 'delegate' refers to delegates, chairs, ICJ presidents/advocates, and members of the secretariat. Delegation assignments for schools will be sent out on Monday, September 12. Upon finalizing the list of students participating in IASAS MUN 2022, please fill out the names of the students in the roster (linked above) by Monday, October 17.
