St. Andrews Heights Community Association Membership Rules

Membership is open to residents of SAH and non-resident property owners. (Bylaws Section 3 (b)).

Membership is acquired by paying the annual membership dues. The Executive establishes the annual membership fees on the advice of the treasurer. Memberships are available throughout year.

General Membership is to be limited to actual residents and non-resident property owners of St. Andrew's Heights. Members in good standing, eighteen years of age and over, are permitted voting rights.

A Family Membership entitles all children under the age of 18 and up to two adults full community association benefits. Additional adult members can be added to a family membership for a fee.

An Associate Membership is to be limited to non-community residents who desire to engage in St. Andrew's Heights sports for themselves and/or family. Associate members do not have voting rights nor do they enjoy membership rates on hall rentals.

There are three categories of membership with different membership fees set annually by the Executive:

1. Family - household memberships include two adults and two children under the age of 18.
2. Senior - same rights as a household membership. Seniors are defined as those 65 years of age and older.
3. Associate Membership - available to non-residents who register their children in the St. Andrew's soccer teams or who register for tennis. This is a non-voting membership.

Members may resign their membership or be expelled by the membership as outlined in section 3 (d) and (e) of the bylaws.

According to the Societies Act, a membership list must be maintained and must be open to the members on request.

Members receive discounts on the hall rental rates and the right to participate in community programs.
