What does the role do?

Greet participants, check-in and distribute items to credentialed members and verify ID applicable. Must have computer knowledge.

What skills, experience, and attributes are needed?

- Check in arriving skaters, coaches, and chaperones for competition.
- Verify and/or distribute credentials
- Help answer questions about the event
- Collect fees and hand out test credit packets
- Collect fees for same day ice practice time purchases
- Have basic skills with a computer to enter in information

What is the time commitment?
