Abstract

Abstract in Candara 12, written in both Indonesian and English, should contain approximately 150–250 words. The abstract must be clear, descriptive, and provide a concise overview of the research problem. It should include the rationale for choosing the topic or its importance, research objectives, research methods, and a summary of the findings. The abstract should conclude with a comment on the significance of the results or a brief conclusion.

Notes:

1. For reference management, this journal requires the use of reference management applications such as Mendeley, following the American Psychological Association (APA) 7th Edition citation style, and utilizing the "Insert Bibliography" feature in the reference section.
2. The manuscript must not have been previously published or currently submitted to any other journal.
3. Manuscripts should be formatted on A4 paper size using 12 pt Candara font with single (1.0) line spacing (for manuscripts written in Arabic, use Traditional Arabic font, size 16). There should be no paragraph spacing, and the word count must be between 6,000 and 9,000 words.
4. Articles may be written in either Arabic or English. All articles are required to include an abstract written in English.



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A. Introduction / المقدمة

The introduction must provide the reasons for conducting the study, including social facts, literature review (previous relevant studies), and general theories underlying the research. It should highlight the research gap, hypothesis, and the novelty of the study. At the end of the introduction, the researcher must clearly state the full research objectives.

Articles can be written in English or Arabic. The text should use Candara, size 12, with 1.0 line spacing.

B. Method / الطريقة

The method section must include references. Research procedures should cover the approach, research type, data collection methods, data analysis techniques, and data validity. The research locus (if any), population, and sample must be fully specified.

C. Findings and Discussion / النتائج والمناقشة

In the Results section, present the collected data and the analysis performed on the data relevant to the problem being addressed. The results must be clear and concise. Write objectively and factually, without expressing personal opinions. Include numbers, tables, and figures. Number the tables and figures sequentially in the order they appear in the text.

The Discussion section explores the significance of the research findings. A combined results and discussion section should be fully synchronized. This section allows you to offer your interpretation and explain the meaning of your results. The Discussion section should serve as a rational and justifiable commentary on the importance of your findings. It explains why the problem is significant, as well as the broader issues and propositions that are confirmed or refuted by extrapolating the results to that problem.

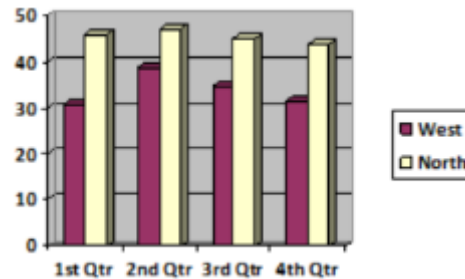


Figure 1. Description (below the figure)
