Times to fly in:

- Here's what Morgan has been telling those who ask:
 - So, I'd definitely recommend being there the whole week, because Mon/Tues is the formal event, then Weds-Fri we'll be coworking, getting to know each other, I have some fun interesting events planned, do touristy stuff to see the city etc (it's a shame to go so far and not even see the famous sights!). So leave Friday night? And arriving, I'd suggest arriving Sunday, so that you're all ready for Monday; and the important thing is that all flights from the US to BA are overnight flights, usually arriving in the morning, like 9am or 10am depending on from where, which means you should probably take a flight that leaves saturday night and arrives sunday morning. Note: Sunday, I'll be there just to hang out with everyone who arrives then so we can spend the day hanging out. In conclusion: I'd recommend leaving Saturday night (arriving Sunday morning); then leaving BA on Friday night. If that's too long and you want to get back to your home sooner, then I'd recommend shortening it by leaving one day early, leaving Thursday night instead, because that will leave 1.5 days for the fun-secret event and also to do tourism and cowork.) And of course, if you want to stay longer--please!

Where is this?

- Palermo, Buenos Aires. (Exact location TBD.)
- Note that Palermo is the hipster/cool neighborhood, where there will be lots of nightlife and activities around in general.
- Hotel suggestions (★★★★) in Palermo, Buenos Aires, Argentina (prices are per day in USD):
 - Hotel Palermitano by DOT Boutique: (\$97) With a rooftop swimming pool and views of the trendy Palermo SoHo district, this venue offers designer style décor and free Wi-Fi. The hotel's art collection is on display. Air-conditioned rooms have a flat-screen cable TV. They feature parquet floors, dark wood furnishings and an elegant palette of earth tones. Some rooms have private balconies, seating areas and bathrooms with bathtubs and Carrara marble fittings. There are mini-bars and laundry services. A buffet breakfast is served daily with regional jams and treats. The restaurant serves local flavors and the after dinner drinks can be enjoyed at the bar. Serrano Park and its famous artisans' fair and designer shops are 2 blocks away. The tour desk can offer advice and there is a handy currency exchange service. Jorge Newbery Airport is 2.1 mi away. Car

- rental can be arranged. **Uriarte 1648**, Palermo, Buenos Aires, Argentina. **(200 meters away from AreaTres, the co-working space in which we'll meet)**
- Prodeo Hotel + Lounge: (\$101) Located in the Palermo Soho district, near all the trending bars and shops, it offers free Wi-Fi and buffet breakfast. Plaza Serrano square is a 5-minute walk. There is an outdoor swimming pool with a retractable roof which can be used in case of bad weather. The suites feature private bathrooms, air conditioning, and TVs. Guests can have a snack at the bar. Meeting facilities are available and express room service can be arranged. The hotel offers tourism information and concierge services to explore the city, to book tours and to make reservations in the finest restaurants. - ❖ 1828 Smart Hotel Boutique: (\$130) Boasting and outdoor heated swimming pool, gym facilities and modern, minimal-style décor, accommodations with free WiFi, room service at no extra charge and a restaurant. The property features a terrace with a solarium, and is 300 m from Serrano Square. All guest rooms boast premium beds with 800-thread count bed linens, a mini-bar, noise-isolating windows and a smart TV. They are all fitted with air conditioning, dimming lights and electronic curtains. The Italian-marbled bathroom facilities include anti-fog mirrors, a hairdryer and premium toiletries. Guests can rely on the tour desk for

- getting around the city. The property is located in Palermo Soho, 500 m from Armenia Square. **Fray J.S.M De Oro 1828**, Palermo, Buenos Aires, Argentina. **(300 meters away from AreaTres)**
