



SENIOR ASSISTANCE

Family Services Association of Boyle County is a private nonprofit “help agency” that has been providing a variety of assistance to individuals and families with a low income since 1916.

WHAT KIND OF HELP IS AVAILABLE? We can provide a variety of services. *We advise you to just call and ask!* If we cannot help, chances are we may find someone who can. Some of the things we can assist with are...

- Emergency* payment toward rent or mortgage.
- Emergency* Payment toward essential utilities such as electric, natural gas, or water
- Vouchers for medication or medical equipment
- Medical supplements such as Boost or Ensure
- Incontinence Supplies
- Assistance purchasing medical alert.
- Assistance with furnace repair by a certified HVAC company (clients 65+)
- Eyeglasses (WalMart Vision Center or Dr. Ward’s office)
- and more....

Financial Assistance can be given once in a 4–5-month interval for up to three times per year. We DO NOT assist on a “regular” basis. There are also limits on how much we can assist with.

HOW DO I QUALIFY FOR HELP?

The eligibility criteria for senior assistance are as follows...

- **You must be a resident of Boyle County.**
- Your net income must be at or below 150% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. (\$1,823.00 for one-person household, \$2,465.00 for a two-person household).
- Some funding is designated for those aged 55 or older and other funding requires you to be 65 or older.
