Thanks for Praying! 12/02/2025

Thank you for standing with me, and thank you for praying. Your prayers truly carried me during my time in Tanzania. And as we move forward, there are two huge things I want to ask you to continue praying for.

First, please pray for the fundraising for the new Standard Two classroom for The Potter's Pre and Primary School. This building will serve our preschool and second-grade students, giving them a safe, clean, Christ-centered learning environment. The total cost is \$12,000. Christ Laborers Church has already raised \$1,900, and a gift of \$650 has already been given. Those funds are finishing the foundation. What remains is

- \$4,000 for the walls and roof—the shell of the building,
- \$4,000 to complete the inside—tile floors, plaster, windows, and doors, and
- \$2,000 for desks, educational materials, and school supplies.

Pray that God will move on hearts, open doors, and release the full provision needed to complete this classroom.

Second, pray for individuals who are willing to shine for Jesus by coming to The Potter's Center—people who feel called to serve even for a short time, helping our students practice conversational English and sharing the love of Christ through their presence. We are asking God to send individuals, couples, or small groups who can come for a week, or even a month, to pour into these children. Just spending time with them, talking with them, and showing them the heart of Jesus leaves a lasting impact.

These two areas—the classroom and the people—are at the center of what God is doing right now. Your prayers make a difference. Thank you for standing with us, believing with us, and helping us move forward in the work God has called us to.

Prayer Request — Saturday, November 29

Dear friends,

Our plans here have changed abruptly today, and it is with great sadness that I share that the father of our dear friend Pastor Vincent Komba (my host and ministry partner) has gone home to be with the Lord.

Family members are now traveling from all over the country to gather and make preparations. Please lift this precious family before the Lord. Pray especially for Vincent's mother, that she would be strengthened, comforted, and upheld by the Holy Spirit during this difficult time.

Thank you for standing with us in prayer. Your intercession means more than you know.

(Jamie — for those following this prayer log who may not know him personally, Pastor Vincent is my friend, my host, and my ministry partner here in Tanzania.)

Friday, November 28th, 2025

Dear Prayer Warriors,

Thank you for standing with me in prayer during these nights of mini-revival here in Vasiga. God has moved powerfully among us—speaking deeply to our hearts about our identity in Him, and calling us to a life fully surrendered for His glory alone. Tonight I will be preaching a commissioning message—a word about anointing, about receiving the mantle God is placing upon His people in this hour. I ask you to stand with me once again. Pray that the Holy Spirit would rest powerfully upon the message and upon every person who hears it.

Tomorrow we begin a full day of travel to Morogoro for an ordination service. There we will meet with church leaders who want to invite us into their communities for future crusades. Please pray that the right connections will be made and that together we will advance the Kingdom in the coming year.

We will also be meeting with pastors who have expressed interest in hosting a crusade in Burundi, possibly as early as 2026. This is incredibly exciting—our first opportunity to preach outside of Tanzania here in East Africa. Ask the Lord to open the right doors and confirm these opportunities according to His will.

Please continue to lift up the nation of Tanzania. There are protests being planned shortly after I return home, and the atmosphere has become uncertain. Pray for peace, for stability, and especially for the protection of our brothers and sisters who live here day by day.

Finally, I want to mention again the burden the Lord has placed on my heart to help build a new classroom for the Potters Center Primary School.

– \$4,000 will get the structure usable.

– \$8,000 will complete the building.

– \$10,000 will provide desks and books for the students next year.

Please stand with me in prayer that the Lord will raise up partners who will join us in providing these urgently needed resources for these precious children.

Thank you for carrying this burden with me. Your prayers matter, and I can feel the strength they bring. May the Lord bless you as you stand with us in this great work.

Thursday, November 27, 2025

Thanksgiving Day

Dear prayer warriors,

Thank you for standing with me so faithfully. First, let us lift up a praise report unto the Lord for the outpouring of His Spirit in last night's service. There was hardly a dry eye in the building as we poured out our hearts in praise and repentance during the first night of our mini-revival here in Vasiga. The praying continued deep into the night, and I truly believe God was pleased. I witnessed His hand moving upon the people, and I know your prayers played a part in that.

Please continue to pray for tonight's service—the second night of our three-night revival—where I must preach a very hard message. Pray that the Lord will grant me wisdom, and that His power and anointing will rest upon me to preach His truth in His way.

I also ask you to continue lifting up Pastor Vincent's father. There has been little change, and the burden weighs heavily on Pastor Vincent and his entire family as their father remains seriously ill in the hospital.

I have a new and urgent prayer request as well. Here in Vasiga, they have launched a small primary school with two grades: kindergarten and standard one. Their school year is ending soon, and the new year begins in January. They need a third building—truly just a third classroom—to house standard two. The vision is to add one classroom each year until they have a full school. There are a little over 30 students, and they are being taught the Word of God and how to speak English alongside their regular lessons.

When I return to the United States, I will begin raising a minimum of \$4,000, which will complete the foundation and provide walls and a roof so the school year can start. We are praying for a total blessing of \$8,000 to finish the building completely. Please make this an urgent matter of prayer. The need is great, and the cause is worthy.

Wednesday, November 26th, 2025

Please keep us in your prayers as tonight begins the first of three revival services at Christ Laborers Church in Vasiga, Tanzania. We are believing God for a mighty move of His

Spirit—that the lost will be saved, that hearts will be stirred, and that all who feel dry or weary will be refreshed by the presence of the Lord.

Also, please continue to lift up Pastor Vincent's father. His health has not improved, and we are asking the Lord for mercy, strength, and healing in Jesus' name.

Thank you for standing with us in prayer and faith. Your support means more than you know.

Tuesday, November 25th, 2025

Please join me in praying today.

The opportunity before me is not what I had planned. I came expecting to preach as an evangelist to the lost—but God has opened a different door. I have been given the privilege of speaking to pastors, along with more than 30 new students from The Potter Center who will soon scatter to the ends of Tanzania. This is a sacred assignment, and I'm asking for your intercession.

Pray that God will speak through me with clarity, authority, and anointing. Pray that He will fill these pastors and students with a burning zeal for evangelism, a boldness to preach the Word of God, and a deep passion to pray and contend for revival and awakening across this great nation.

I believe God is moving. Please join me in proclaiming revival, in believing for the salvation of His Son to be made known, and in declaring the hope Jesus offers to every man, woman, and child in this land.

Thank you for standing with me in prayer, faith, and partnership. May God receive all the glory.

Monday, November 24th, 2025

Prayer Request

Please join me in prayer as I preach messages to pastors tomorrow. Pray that the Lord will pour out His wisdom, discernment, clarity, and anointing—so that every word spoken will strengthen, encourage, and equip His servants.

There is usually a question-and-answer time afterward, and I need to hear clearly from the Holy Spirit during these moments. Young pastors often ask difficult, controversial, and culturally sensitive questions, and I want to speak truth with grace, accuracy, and the leading of the Spirit.

Also, please lift up Pastor Vincent's father, Brother Samuel Komba. He is very ill—experiencing heart failure, fluid in his lungs requiring a chest tube, and currently on oxygen. His condition is very serious.

Pray for God's healing touch upon Brother Samuel, for strength and peace for Pastor Vincent and his family, and for the Holy Spirit to surround them with comfort during this time.

Sunday, November 23rd, 2025

Traveling ...

Saturday, November 22nd, 2025

Please be praying for me today. My flight boards in about 30 minutes, and I'm asking the Lord for traveling mercies at every step. Pray that I'm able to sleep on the plane, that all of my connections go smoothly, and that I am welcomed into Tanzania with favor at customs. Thank you for covering this journey in prayer.

Friday, November 21st, 2025

Prayer Request:

Please pray for strength and clarity as I enter these final days of preparation. I still have so much to do, and the lingering illness—along with the medication I've taken to fight its symptoms—has left me weak in body and addled in mind. Pray that the Lord would restore my strength, remembering His promise: **“He gives power to the weak, and to those who have no might He increases strength”** (Isaiah 40:29 NKJV).

Ask God to renew my mind and give me focus, standing on the truth that **“God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind”** (2 Timothy 1:7 NKJV). Pray that He would grant me the clarity needed to finish the remaining tasks: preparing a few more messages, getting church responsibilities in order before my time away from Ball Ground Fellowship, packing, completing school plans, topping off horse supplies, getting a haircut, and managing the seemingly endless list of last-minute details.

Pray that the Lord will multiply my energy and redeem my time, trusting that **“My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness”** (2 Corinthians 12:9 NKJV). Ask Him to order every step, believing that **“the steps of a good man are ordered by the Lord”** (Psalm 37:23 NKJV).

Finally, pray that nothing—whether sickness, fatigue, or distraction—will hinder the calling God has placed before me, holding onto the promise that **“He who has begun a good work in you will complete it”** (Philippians 1:6 NKJV).

Thursday, November 20th, 2025

Prayer Request:

Please pray for my health. I've picked up a stomach bug from school, and my strength is very low. Pray for full recovery and healing, trusting the promise that **“He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses”** (Matthew 8:17 NKJV), and believing that **“the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up”** (James 5:15 NKJV).

Pray also over my journey in the days ahead—that the Lord would go before me and make a straight path, remembering that **“the Lord shall preserve your going out and your coming in from this time forth, and even forevermore”** (Psalm 121:8 NKJV). Ask Him to strengthen me

with might in my inner being, because **“those who wait on the Lord shall renew their strength”** (Isaiah 40:31 NKJV).

Lift up the mission itself, that nothing would hinder the work God has called us to do. I believe the Lord is sending us, and the kingdom of darkness is opposing us in every way. Pray in faith that **“no weapon formed against you shall prosper”** (Isaiah 54:17 NKJV), and declare the victory of Christ, for **“the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil”** (1 John 3:8 NKJV).

Pray for divine breakthrough, covering, and supernatural success—that every message, every moment, and every ministry opportunity would be empowered by the Holy Spirit and bear eternal fruit.

Wednesday, November 19th, 2025

(4 days until I fly out)

Prayer Request:

Please pray for my dear friend and brother in Christ, Pastor Vincent—my translator, guide, protector, and co-laborer in the gospel. His father has been taken to the hospital with what is believed to be congestive heart failure. Pray for healing over his father, trusting that **“the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up”** (James 5:15 NKJV), and believing in the promise that **“I am the Lord who heals you”** (Exodus 15:26 NKJV).

Lift up Pastor Vincent’s entire family, asking that the God of all comfort would surround them with peace and strength, for **“God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble”** (Psalm 46:1 NKJV). Pray that the Lord would guard their hearts and minds with His peace as they walk through this trial, remembering that **“the peace of God... will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus”** (Philippians 4:7 NKJV).

Pray also for our whole ministry team in Tanzania, that the enemy will not hinder or disrupt the proclamation of the gospel. Stand firm on the truth that **“no weapon formed against you shall prosper”** (Isaiah 54:17 NKJV) and that **“greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world”** (1 John 4:4 NKJV). Ask the Lord to strengthen our resolve and unity, because **“a threefold cord is not quickly broken”** (Ecclesiastes 4:12 NKJV).

Finally, pray that God will use even this situation to bring glory to His name and advance His mission, knowing that **“all things work together for good to those who love God”** (Romans 8:28 NKJV).

Tuesday, November 18th, 2025

(5 days until I fly out)

Prayer Request:

Please pray for next week's evangelistic outreach in Tanzania. We had planned to hold an outdoor evangelistic event in the town of Chalinze, but the government has denied our petition due to safety concerns following the late-October protests and riots. We are now moving the outreach indoors, and this saddens us because many who come to our outdoor meetings are unlikely to step inside a church building.

Pray that the Lord would go before us, for **“the steps of a good man are ordered by the Lord”** (Psalm 37:23 NKJV), and that He would grant us smooth logistics and divine wisdom as we adjust plans—trusting that **“if any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God... and it will be given to him”** (James 1:5 NKJV).

Ask God to protect our team in every detail, remembering that **“the Lord is faithful, who will establish you and guard you from the evil one”** (2 Thessalonians 3:3 NKJV). Pray also that He would open unexpected doors for ministry, because **“a great and effective door has opened”** (1 Corinthians 16:9 NKJV), even when circumstances shift.

And above all, pray that the hope of the gospel will reach those who need it most, for **“the gospel of Christ... is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes”** (Romans 1:16 NKJV).

November 8th through November 21st

Preparation Prayer Focus – Tanzania Mission 2025

Before the journey begins, we invite our prayer partners to join us in daily intercession as we prepare the way for this next mission to Tanzania. These prayer points cover both spiritual and practical needs—trusting that the Lord will go before us and make every crooked path straight.

1. Provision and Protection in the Midst of Uncertainty

Pray that, despite the uncertainty surrounding the U.S. government shutdown, all necessary travel arrangements and financial provisions will be released on time. Ask the Lord to remove any obstacles related to flights, funding, or administrative delays, and to cover every detail of this mission with His peace.

Scripture: *“My God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.” – Philippians 4:19 (KJV)*

2. Sadly, I must report pastor Vincent was denied his Visa and will not be able to join us in America at this time. Pray for future favor.

“Favor for Pastor Vincent’s Embassy Appointment

Pastor Vincent Komba will soon meet with the U.S. Embassy to apply for a visa to travel to America before the trip. Pray that God will grant him favor in every conversation, that all paperwork will be in order, and that the interviewers will sense the integrity and purpose of his ministry.

Scripture: *“For Thou, Lord, wilt bless the righteous; with favour wilt Thou compass him as with a shield.” – Psalm 5:12 (KJV)*

3. Open Doors for Invitations and Partnerships

Pray that God would open new doors for invitations to preach and share about the vision of revival across Tanzania. Ask that hearts in both America and Africa would be stirred to partner in prayer, giving, and participation.

Scripture: *“For a great door and effectual is opened unto me, and there are many adversaries.” – 1 Corinthians 16:9 (KJV)*

4. Visions and Dreams Preparing the Harvest

Ask the Lord to move supernaturally across Tanzania and especially in the town of Chalinze—sending dreams and visions to prepare people to receive His Word even before the crusade begins. Pray that those who will attend the meetings will experience divine encounters that soften their hearts and awaken their hunger for truth.

Scripture: *“Your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions.” – Joel 2:28 (KJV)*

5. Wisdom, Health, and Strength for the Team

Cover Pastor Jamie, Pastor Vincent, and every local and international team member in prayer for health, strength, and unity. Pray for discernment in every decision, and for the Lord's timing to order every step.

Scripture: *"In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy paths."* – Proverbs 3:6 (KJV)

6. Peace and Stability in Tanzania

Acknowledge the recent unrest and ask the Lord to bring peace to the nation—especially in the cities and regions where the team will minister. Pray for protection from violence, political tension, and spiritual opposition.

Scripture: *"Peace be within thy walls, and prosperity within thy palaces."* – Psalm 122:7 (KJV)

7. Revival Fire to Fall

Finally, pray that even before the team lands, God will begin to stir hearts across Tanzania with conviction, repentance, and expectation. May the Holy Spirit go before every crusade (revival) service, every message, and every conversation, preparing the soil for an abundant harvest.

Scripture: *"Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his paths straight."* – Luke 3:4 (KJV)

Final Praise Report & Prayer Request – Tanzania Mission Trip

Day 20 - June 2025 – Two Crusades, One Mission, Eternal Impact

Dear friends and prayer warriors,

Thank you for standing with me on this journey. The ground in Dar es Salaam was extremely hard. We faced significant spiritual and social opposition. Neighbors surrounding our crusade site created and shared a viral video, publicly accusing us of being loud and disruptive. Tens of thousands across Tanzania viewed the video—many criticizing the church and, by extension, the gospel we preached.

But the work of God was not stopped.

In the face of adversity, the gospel went forth, and hearts were changed. Over the course of this final week, 14 people professed faith in Jesus, and 9 committed believers have stepped forward to form the core team for a new church plant:

House of Revival – Christ Laborers Church, Dar es Salaam.

This is a seed of faith planted in rocky soil—but we believe with God's help, it will grow strong and bear fruit.

Across both crusades (Mvumi and Dar), we:

- Proclaimed the gospel to thousands
 - Witnessed 164 adults make public decisions to follow Jesus
 - Fought spiritual warfare with prayer, preaching, and perseverance
 - And saw the light of Christ pierce even the darkest opposition

Please continue to pray:

- That the new church in Dar es Salaam will take root and grow strong, becoming a beacon of hope and truth in the city
- That those who received Christ will be discipled and connected to the body
- For my safe return to America, and that I would carry the testimony of this mission well
- That doors will open to share what God has done—in churches, small groups, or even homes
- For ongoing provision and funding so that the ministry can continue reaching unreached places
- And that in everything, Jesus Christ would be glorified

If you or someone you know would like to hear firsthand what God is doing in these remote regions—I would love to come and share. Whether it's a church service, a mission night, or a small gathering, I believe the stories of God's power and faithfulness need to be told.

Day 19 – Sunday, June 22

Prayer Focus: The Final Service – A Highway for His Glory

Today marks the final service of this mission trip, and what a journey it has been. I leave for America on Monday. Last night, we saw 12 people give their lives to Jesus Christ—a beautiful breakthrough that has encouraged our hearts after a hard-fought week.

But today is more than a conclusion—it's a beginning.

We are not just closing a crusade; we are launching a new church:

House of Revival – Christ Laborers Church, Dar es Salaam.

This morning, I'll be preaching a message titled: "Make Straight the Way of the Lord – A People Prepared for His Presence and Power." Our text is Isaiah 40:3–5, a call not just to preach, but to prepare.

Please pray with us today:

- That God would anoint this final service with His presence and confirm the word with power
- That people would not just attend, but come with hearts ready to be transformed
- That this new church would be a highway for the glory of God, not just a gathering place
- That every valley of discouragement would be lifted, every mountain of pride brought low, and every crooked place in the hearts of people made straight
- That God would break every stronghold, expose every lie of the enemy, and bring healing to those hurt by false religion or wounded by counterfeit Christianity
- That many would see the glory of the Lord revealed today, not only in the service but in the days and years to come
- And always, pray for the salvation of the lost

Praise the Lord for another powerful night in Dar es Salaam! We had 11 guests in attendance, and we rejoice that 6 of them gave their lives to Jesus Christ. Two other individuals began the process of deliverance, and we are believing for their complete freedom in Jesus' name.

During the altar time, one man under demonic influence physically attacked me—he kicked me and tried to sweep my legs out from under me. While I was commanding the demon to be bound and leave in the name of Jesus, the demon shouted back, “Hapana, wewe toka!” (No! You get out!). But Jesus has all authority, and the enemy must flee when we stand in His name!

Thank you for standing in the gap through your prayers. Victory is being declared here. Keep pressing in—souls are being saved and chains are breaking!

Dar es Salaam Crusade – Night 3 Report

Day 18 Prayer Requests

Saturday, June 21

Tonight was a difficult night.

Unfortunately, no one from the community came to the service. Despite our preparations, invitations, and prayers, the field was empty of guests—but the team showed up, and that mattered.

Pastor Vincent and I both preached, not for the crowd we hoped for, but to encourage the faithful team members who have stood with us day after day. These messages were for them—reminding them that obedience is never wasted, and that God sees every act of faithfulness.

Still, the opposition feels both physical and spiritual. There’s resistance in the atmosphere. There’s weariness in the body. But we are not giving up.

We are asking you to pray earnestly for a breakthrough tomorrow night. Pray that:

- Barriers will break—spiritual, emotional, cultural
- People will be drawn supernaturally to the field
- That God will honor the persistence of this team
- That we will see salvations, joy, and movement in the Spirit

We’re still believing for revival in Dar es Salaam. Thank you for praying.

The breakthrough may be one night away.

Day 17 – Friday, June 20

Prayer Focus: Night 3 of the Dar es Salaam Crusade – Breaking Strongholds & Gathering the Core

Tonight is Night 3 of the Evangelistic Crusade here in Dar es Salaam, and we are asking God for a spiritual breakthrough—not just in attendance or response, but in the invisible realm where strongholds are torn down and hearts are set free.

Please pray with us for the following:

- That the power of the enemy would be broken—over individuals, families, and entire communities
- That spiritual strongholds would collapse—generational lies, demonic oppression, and religious confusion
- That the lies of the enemy would be exposed, and that the truth of the Gospel would shine with clarity and conviction
- That those who have been hurt or wounded by people claiming to represent Christ would experience healing, and that those offenses would no longer keep them from Jesus
- That the enemy would not be able to blind people to the love, mercy, and invitation of Christ being extended tonight
- That God would begin gathering a core of believers, the very first seeds for the launch of House of Prayer, Christ Laborers Church – Dar es Salaam
- And as always, that tonight would bring a mighty harvest of souls, that the lost would be saved, and that heaven would rejoice

Day 2 Report – Dar es Salaam Pastors Conference & Crusade

Today marked the conclusion of our Pastors Conference here in Dar es Salaam. Though we hoped for a larger turnout, just over 50 pastors attended, and the Spirit of God moved powerfully among us. We sensed that timely words of encouragement were shared and received. Ministry relationships take time to form, and we believe that seeds were planted for future collaboration and lasting kingdom fruit.

In the evening, we held the second night of our Evangelistic Crusade. Earlier in the day, I felt strongly convicted that even if no one came, I must still preach the gospel—believing by faith that the sound system would carry the message beyond the building and into the streets. So I preached on the Rich Man and Lazarus, presenting the message of salvation as clearly as I could. I led a sinner’s prayer, and Vincent followed with a word of strength on starting and finishing in the power of Jesus.

After the service, as we were saying our goodnights, we were invited to minister in a side room. There we met Elisha—a young man in his early twenties who had received one of the 20,000 invitation handbills. He told us he searched everywhere to find the service and arrived late, slipping in unnoticed. But he heard the gospel and came under deep conviction. Though he didn't respond during the public invitation, he asked to be led to Jesus afterward. With joy, we prayed with him and cast out several demons as he received salvation.

Elisha, who says he has no family, may have been abandoned in childhood. We don't yet know his full story, but we know this: he now belongs to the family of God. On Night 2 of the Dar es Salaam crusade, all the effort and expense were worth it for this one precious soul. After all, did Jesus not say He would leave the ninety-nine to find the one?

Please continue to pray for Elisha, and for the launch of House of Revival – Christ Laborers Church, Dar es Salaam. This is a hard place, but it is ripe for the gospel.

Dar es Salaam Crusade & Conference – Day 1 Report

Wednesday, June 18

Today was a very hard day. Emotionally, physically, and spiritually. I preached three messages, and though I poured my heart out in each one, the day was long and heavy.

We launched our Pastors Conference, which we had prepared for months in advance—expecting 300 pastors. But only 30 attended. Our team handed out over 10,000 printed invitations throughout the city for the evening evangelistic crusade—yes, 10,000—and only three guests came. All of them were already believers.

It was discouraging. The turnout did not reflect the effort.

But we’re not giving up. We believe this city belongs to Jesus, and He still wants to move in power.

Would you please pray with us:

- That hearts in Dar es Salaam would be stirred, and that people would respond to the invitations
- That our team would not lose heart, and that we would continue to serve with faith and joy
- That I, as the evangelist, would not become discouraged, but would stay focused on obedience and faithfulness, even when the results seem small
- That tomorrow would be a turning point, both in attendance and in spiritual breakthrough

Zechariah 4:10 says, “Do not despise these small beginnings, for the Lord rejoices to see the work begin.”

We are holding to that truth tonight.

Day 15 – Wednesday, June 18

Prayer Focus: Launch of Pastors Conference & Crusade in Dar es Salaam

Today marks the beginning of two major events in Dar es Salaam: a two-day Pastors Conference and a five-day Evangelistic Crusade. We believe this is a divine appointment not only for the city, but for the future of revival across Tanzania.

I'm also still dealing with ongoing digestive discomfort, which continues to impact my strength and energy levels. I ask for your continued prayers for healing and full recovery.

- For productive meetings with local pastors and leaders, full of unity, wisdom, and shared vision

My heart longs to see thousands come to Christ, and I believe God is calling us to do exactly that.

By 2027, I plan to resign from my teaching position to increase my availability for this mission. The vision is to conduct four or five crusades during three dedicated months each year. To accomplish this, we estimate a need of at least \$75,000 annually. Currently, we raise about \$20,000 a year, which limits the scope of what we can do. The only thing standing between reaching hundreds and reaching thousands is financial provision.

But we know this: God wants us to do the work.

- More prayer partners who will intercede for revival and protection as we go.
- More financial partners who will help us build a sustainable and reasonable budget.
- Open doors to preach the gospel freely and fruitfully.
- God's favor and anointing on every crusade, every village, every soul.

What a glorious finale to an unforgettable week in Mvumi!

During the Sunday morning service, the presence of God was tangible as worship filled the sanctuary with power and joy. That brings our total number of public professions of faith among adults this week to 150!

Sunday night's final crusade service was a beautiful outpouring of grace. Many children responded to the gospel, praying to receive Christ. As the evening closed, hundreds of believers gathered together to pray for God's blessing over Mvumi Village—a true picture of unity, revival, and hope.

We believe a great work has been accomplished here. Seeds of the gospel have been planted, watered, and some have already begun to bear fruit. Now we set our eyes toward Dar es Salaam for the next leg of the journey—hosting a pastors' conference and a crusade in the city in partnership with the launch of a new Christ Laborers Church: The House of Revival.

Day 12 – Sunday, June 15

Prayer Focus: Final Day of Crusade – Strength, Salvation, and Revival

Today is the final day of the Mvumi Crusade, and it is traditionally the most exhausting and spiritually demanding day of the entire campaign.

On Sunday mornings—as is the case this week—we typically begin the day by visiting the local church. We begin early with prayer at 9:00 a.m., followed by worship from 10:00 to 12:00, preaching from 12:00 to 1:30, and the invitation and ministry time stretching until 2:00 or even 2:30 p.m.

We're helping gather the congregation and encouraging those attending the crusade to also attend Sunday morning worship. Our desire is to inspire and strengthen the local church, to see a true connection between revival on the field and transformation in the church. After the morning service, we'll grab a quick lunch and return to the crusade field for the evening session starting at 4:00 p.m., which often continues until 7:00 or 7:30 p.m.

Immediately after the final altar call, we will pack up, load into the vehicle, and begin our return journey to Vasiga—a drive that should take around nine hours. In every sense, today will be a long, physically draining, spiritually intense day.

But it is also a day of harvest. A day when many who have heard the Gospel may finally respond. A day when revival can break out in hearts, homes, and this land.

- That I would preach with a clear and undistracted mind—free from personal pain, emotion, fatigue, or frustration—and fully led by the Holy Spirit

Mvumi Crusade – Day 4 Report

Tonight night was our largest crowd yet—more than 600 people gathered on the field, with hundreds more listening from a distance as the sound system carried the Word to over 1,000 people.

We praise God for 32 adults who came forward to profess faith in Jesus Christ. Dozens of children also responded, though in this culture, only adult decisions are typically recorded. Many entered the deliverance tent, seeking freedom from spiritual bondage.

While we have not yet received testimonies of physical healing, many are coming in faith, asking for healing. **Please continue to stand with us in prayer, asking the Lord to release miracles of healing and wholeness—that bodies would be restored as hearts are being transformed.**

Thank you for your faithful support. The Gospel is advancing, and we believe greater things are yet to come.

Day 10 – Friday, June 13

Prayer Focus: Moving from Glory to Glory – Victory, Vigilance & Continued Breakthrough

Praise God—last night we saw 29 people make decisions to follow Jesus! It was a night of real spiritual breakthrough. The atmosphere, which had previously carried a heavy spiritual weight, shifted. The service ended not with oppression, but with lightness and joy. We truly left with joy in our hearts—a sign that something has broken open in the spirit.

Even after the service ended, the team of nearly 50 local workers and leaders stayed behind for over two hours of intercessory prayer. During that time, the Lord gave them a deep sense that we are moving from glory to glory, that the battle is being won, and that victory is unfolding here in Mvumi.

I also want to say—thank you for your prayers for me personally. I felt completely free in my preaching last night. The words flowed, and there was no heaviness or distraction. I can say with full confidence: your prayers are making a tremendous impact on this mission. Please continue to lift me up—I need your covering.

That said, the battle is not over. There is still much demonic activity. Manifestations continue, and the enemy remains active in the shadows. But we are not afraid. God is at work.

Day 9 – Thursday, June 12

Tonight is Day 3 of the Crusade in Mvumi, and we are witnessing God move with power and mercy.

So far, over 80 people have made decisions to follow Jesus Christ, and many have been delivered from demonic possession and oppression. **The Gospel is breaking chains—but this region is a stronghold of the enemy, and we are asking for continued prayer for a breakthrough in the spiritual battle.**

The Spirit of God moved powerfully. We witnessed 19 confirmed professions of faith in Jesus Christ. All were adults. Once again, the

deliverance tent was very active, with many seeking and receiving freedom through the name of Jesus. Thank you for your continued prayers—God is at work in Mvumi!



Day 8 – Wednesday, June 11

Prayer Focus: Spiritual Warfare, Healing, & Strength for the Battle

Thank you for continuing to pray—we are in the midst of intense spiritual conflict and great opportunity. Last night, I entered the pulpit with great strength from the Holy Spirit, and the Word went forth with boldness. But by the end of the night, I was so physically and spiritually drained I could barely eat supper.

The battle is real and escalating. Before the service, a witch doctor came to the crusade field attempting to curse the gathering. He retreated before I arrived, but the darkness was felt. We also experienced power outages during worship, and over a dozen people manifested demonic spirits during the service. And yet—Jesus was victorious! Many were delivered, set free, and the Gospel was proclaimed with power.

Today, I am remaining in my room to rest, recover, and pray. I desperately need physical healing and spiritual refreshing. Our ministry and intercession teams are on the ground all day, praying for healing and deliverance throughout Mvumi. **Please continue to cover the team in prayer, especially Pastor Vincent and me.**

We are both facing health challenges, and we sense that much of it is spiritual attack.

- Pastor Vincent began running a fever and developed a severe headache as we approached last night's service.
- I am battling congestion, painful cramping in my back and legs, and a strained throat from preaching.

Please pray that the Lord would touch our bodies with healing and give us supernatural endurance and protection for the days ahead.

Please pray:

- For complete healing over my body and Pastor Vincent's—fever, pain, congestion, muscle cramping, and vocal strain
- For renewed strength and spiritual refreshing
- That every assignment of the enemy—whether through sickness, curses, fear, or confusion—would be broken in Jesus' name
- For the ministry team as they continue to pray for healing and deliverance throughout the day

We count that as 102 souls, with 65 of them old enough to understand and respond with personal faith. The deliverance tent was overflowing with people seeking freedom and breakthrough. Seeds of salvation and revival were planted all across the field. Thank you for covering us in prayer—what a mighty start to this crusade!





Day 7 – Tuesday, June 11

Prayer Focus: First Night of Crusade in Mvumi

Today marks the first night of the evangelistic crusade in Mvumi, a town in Dodoma where we believe God desires to show His glory in a powerful way.

This is the moment we've been praying toward—please cover every part of this outreach in prayer:

- **That nothing would hinder the Word of God from going forth in power and relevance**

Day 5 – Monday, June 9

Report from Day 4:

Friends and family, thank you for covering yesterday in prayer. Our Pentecost Sunday service at Christ' Laborers Church in Vasiga was a powerful time in the presence of God. Many responded to the call of repentance and received a fresh anointing for revival.

As I prayed before preaching, I asked God to make my heart His heart, that I might feel what He feels... my mouth His mouth, that I might speak His words... and my eyes His eyes, that I might see what He sees. In that moment, God gave me a vision:

I saw the Holy Spirit fill the sanctuary like a mighty white cloud, heavy with glory. Suddenly, it burst forth from the church—blowing open the doors and flowing out like a rushing river of cloud. It wasn't water, but the Shekinah glory of God.

The glory flooded the streets of Vasiga and spread rapidly—filling roads, neighborhoods, even climbing over walls and into homes and businesses. It did not stop. It grew stronger, moving through every street of Tanzania until it began to cover the whole nation. Then, I saw something deeper: the bedrock beneath the nation began to burst open, like the fountains of the deep in Noah's day—but this was not water. It was the glory of the living God, welling up from the depths.

Overwhelmed, I sat down and said, "Lord, it is too much." But the Spirit kept pouring out. I believe this was a confirmation from the Lord—He desires to bring revival to Tanzania. Not just revival, but a great national awakening that will impact all of East Africa.

Prayer for Day 5:

Today, we continue final preparations for the crusade in VuVummi. Please join me in prayer that the Lord would:

- Prepare the hearts of the people in VuVummi
- Anoint every conversation, outreach, and time of prayer
- Stir a holy hunger and readiness in the community
- Strengthen and embolden the local church
- Send a fresh outpouring of His glory and power

Also, please pray for traveling mercies.

Tomorrow, we begin our journey halfway across the country as we travel to Dodoma. Pray for safety on the roads, protection over every vehicle, and strength for the team as we cover many miles. May God's presence go before us, and may every mile be filled with peace and purpose.

May the power of the Holy Spirit fall afresh on the congregation, just as it did on the day of Pentecost in Acts 2.

Vasiga is also home to The Potter's Center, a ministry training hub where future pastors and evangelists are being equipped to preach the Gospel, serve in crusades, and reach unreached villages across Tanzania and beyond. Please pray that the Holy Spirit would begin revival on this marvelous feast day of the Lord, just as He did in Acts 2. May fire fall again!
