Unit 1 <i>History</i>	In this unit, students will learn about how Spain became "Spain" by discussing their "rise and fall", and drawing comparisons between their colonization and conquest. Unit 2 <i>Music</i>	In this unit, students will identify English and Spanish cognates, find meaning in texts using context clues, begin to form basic sentences in Spanish through appropriately selected vocabulary, and understand that while Spanish is spoken in Spanish speaking countries, each has regional differences in vocabulary. Unit 3 <i>Personal Expression</i>	In this unit, students will prepare for 8th grade Spanish by strengthening their foundation in Spanish. Throughout this unit, students will learn basic sentence structure and grammar while also using resources such as Duolingo and Spanish texts to support their learning. They will develop the skills to use Google Translate responsibly and effectively for vocabulary acquisition. In addition, students will practice crafting sentences that allow them to provide and obtain information, express their feelings, and persuade others, building confidence in both written and spoken Spanish.
