

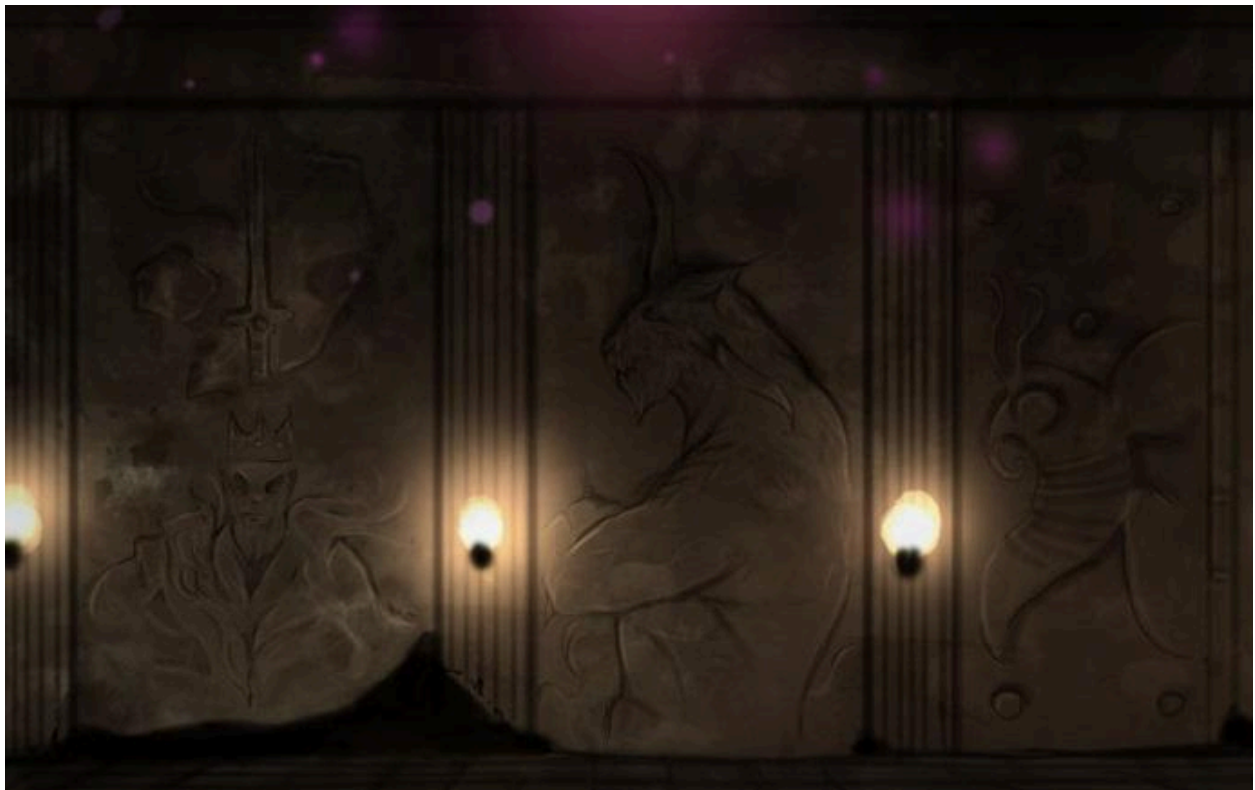
## Tower of God 'extras' - a selection of revisions of blogpost, 'Naver FanCafe' and miscellaneous external info

### Introduction: Various tidbits from Season 1

"1F (Headon's floor) is like the 'tutorial' for the Tower. Consequently, it may be hard to understand and you may just feel lost, but it has secrets hinting to the rest of the story. Maybe you can find some!"

"Between family members they refer to each other with given names, outside of familial contact, they are referred to by their main family name."

*\* [in reference to the Ten Great Families specifically, as to avoid confusion](#)*

"By the way, there are various other 'Ignition' weapons apart from the '13 Month Series'. Many Rankers use 'Ignition' weapons as their main choice of weaponry."

To further clarify, the '13 Month Series' are good, but they are not the absolute best. Yuri herself uses better weapons than 'Black March', but regardless, the '13 Month Series' do have great significance and magnitude to them within the story."

\*[Anaaak's original backstory \(now non-canon\)](#): [revised TN: The central idea of this original storyboard was fixated on the concept that one who collected all of the '13th months' could (theoretically) then bear Jahad's child (and subsequently be his wife) - thus, Anaaak's desire to get the Black March from Bam. This original plan didn't seem to interweave well with Anaaak's obsession towards getting revenge on Jahad; hence - it was dropped...]

"In the Tower, age is a meaningless concept, actually. Years lived are considered less important than the body's age and its racial traits. Power and position come before age in most cases.

(Yuri, Khun and Endorsi talk informally to most people since they are from the Great Families, while Anaaak speaks in a formal tone to most people.)

"Sometimes" learning to use Shinsu stops the body from aging.

(\*[this "sometimes" antedates further concepts in the series like the ability to make a contract with an admin or the usage of spells, thus we can assume that SiU was still in the process of touching-up certain aspects of the lore by this point](#))

Then this person will be usually treated as a child even after living a long time. Thus, normally in the Tower, body and mind are considered to be of the same age. Of course some exceptions occur due to birthplaces and Families." [TN: One's biological age is determined by their mental age.]

"The "Heuk-rin" (translation name: 'Black Fish') technique was revealed in chapter 37. It is a Shinsu technique that Scouts use to block Lighthouses' lights. [TN: Heuk-rin's name means (loosely) a waving black feather, as it blocks out light.] Using Shinsu manipulation, the light is temporarily blocked. It is an advantage for Scouts because of their fondness for darkness. Of course, the Light Bearers can use a reversal technique to 'block' the blocking spell."

“A-rank items are extremely rare in the Tower. Rankers usually don’t have any, High Rankers may have one or two. Of course, even an A-rank Pocket would be less valuable than the Black March.”

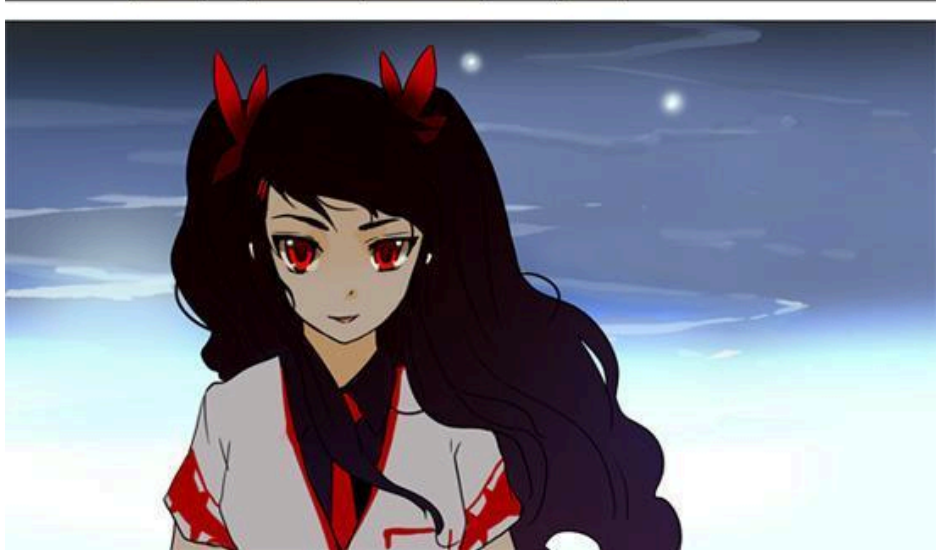
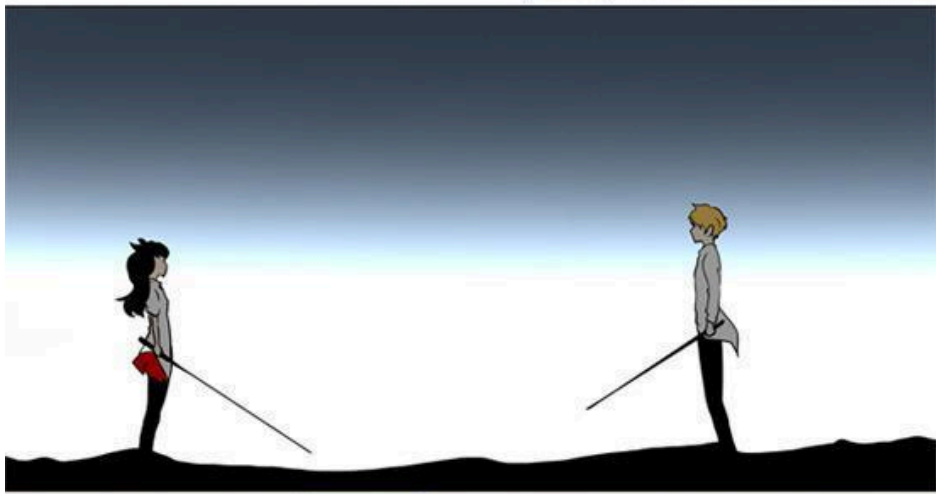
“The ‘Great Blue Spear’ is Khun Edahn’s throwing spear. A total of 11 of them have been made, and they can be ignited, which is rare for throwing weapons like spears/javelins. When ignited, instead of flying to the target, it supposedly destroys everything in front of its immediate path. This has yet to be confirmed since Edahn has not thrown it yet. When ignited it is comparable to a B-Rank weapon. Mago is another one of Edahn’s spears. There is a known joke among Regulars and inhabitants that this weapon could possibly pierce through half of the Tower when decompressed. In addition, when decompressed, its rank increases abnormally.

The ‘Carrier’ is an Inventory that combines the functions of a Pocket, Lighthouse, and Casket ([\\*the term for inventories specifically used for storing spears](#)) all into one, allowing a Fisherman to take on any position. Only 10 have been made, 3 of them A-Rank, while the other 7 of them are B-Rank. They are quite ineffective in battle though, but still very interesting. Adori Jahad uses one.”

“Bam, Anaak, Yuri, Evan, Khun, Rak, Hoh, Hong Chunhwa ([\\*swordsman that got defeated by Endorsi and had the Ignition weapon ‘Narumada’](#)) and Seonwoo Narae ([\\*little blonde Anima girl that ended up receiving Khun’s bag ‘Manbarondenna’](#)) are the only characters that made it out of the initial black and white storyboard of ToG”

[\\*Anaak was initially a regular human, not a lizard-person](#)

“Lero-Ro and Yuri were in the same class as Regulars. Thereafter, from that class of Regulars, Lero-Ro and Yuri were the only ones to become Rankers.”  
*(\*Here are panels from SiU that didn’t make it into the final cut of season 1 and were supposed to acts as added backstory to Lero Ro and Yuri)*



“One line summary for chapter 66:

‘Goblins are bad, Paracule is bad too.’

Endnote: I will get rid of Paracule.” - SiU’s poetry

\* “Deep narrator voice: “He didn’t.”

“In regard to the RED (who are infamous even within the Jahad family), the enemies they face are all people who were 'once in the Jahad Family', so even though the “criminals” they encounter are all ex-Jahad family members, they don’t feel too good about them. It’s kinda like the feelings between the military police and an official. Furthermore, the Enforcement Division has independent ranks and command hierarchies. The only person the Enforcement Division serves is Jahad. However, it isn’t like the division is loyal, or anything, because most of the members come in to fill their need for murder and battling.

There are a lot of disparities among the individuals’ loyalty to Jahad within the division. The only thing they have in common is that they are all in awe of the power of Jahad. The ones with the highest loyalty are the Royal Guards and the ‘bodyguards’.

There are some people who become psychos when their loyalty goes overboard.

The comparison I made is only surface-level, since the military police in Jahad’s army is not the RED.”

“Yuri has very strong physical strength even among the Rankers.

The Ha Family is very strong genetically and because of their specific contract with the Guardian, they are the family with the strongest body strengthening ability (Shinsu reinforcement).”

“Lero-Ro's dots are based on the design of Pikachu. It is not a dot/mole though, but a drawing. It symbolizes that a special “test” has been conducted by the user.”

“Regulars who fail to pass the Floor of Test are stripped of their rights and return to the Outer Tower (not to be confused with the “outside” space independent of the tower).”

- After the Third Floor, they have the right to retake the test. They say that most of the people who passed the Floor of Test will also pass the rest because the difficulty is not that high.
- If they give up in the middle, they are stripped of their rights and are sent to the Middle Area (of the Tower).
- From the 20th floor, the right to live in the middle area is granted. Many take the test after entering the Inner Tower, but a test requires a lot of points (money) and because of the increase in difficulty, they say there are a lot of Regulars who give up on the 20th Floor.
- It is said that even after they give up, their "premium" status as former Regulars helps out a lot in their daily needs.

### **Part I - More on the 13th Month weapons and the Princesses**

(\*I will be saving the Princess' rankings and sobriquets for later so that they're all in one place with all the other High Ranker character rankings)

“Any Princess who becomes a Ranker is entitled to a Guide thanks to the contract of the Jahad Family. There have been many cases of Princesses from normal families getting killed unnoticed. Since a Princess from a normal family becoming a Ranker means that a new power will soon be born, there are tons of people who will try to get rid of them because they don't want to see that happen.

\*SIU had also prepared a Jahad Princess arc. However, it might run a little later than expected.

\*The 13 Month Series all have their names engraved on them. The engraving is in Japanese, because their creator Ashul Edwaru ([\\*more on him in a bit](#)) uses a language based on Japanese. SiU made it clear there is no deep symbolic significance behind this, as Chinese, Arabic and other languages are also used throughout this manhwa.

\*The 13 Month Series is actually based on the lunar calendar where all months are based on moons.

When an official Princess accepts one of the Series, she must abide by a set of rules:

1. She may not give or even lend a 13 Month Series to another person, otherwise they may be viable for execution by Jahad's administration.
2. A Princess may own more than one weapon from the 13 Month Series, such as Yuri Jahad or Garam Jahad.
3. A Princess can refuse a weapon from the 13 Month Series. Heice Jahad, upon becoming a Ranker, was presented with a 13 Month Series, but she turned it down for unknown reasons.

Notable blogpost/outside info on certain Princesses ([\\*most of them have almost next to no info so I'm only focusing on a select few](#)):

**Adori Jahad** - "The wielder of the only S-Rank '13th Month weapon', the Golden November. A High Ranker who has multiple male and female fans due to her golden-blond hair and beautiful face. She is also the commander of Jahad's Royal Guards ([\\*the guards that welcomed Yuri at the start of season 2 and also the same ones Yuri beat up in front of Repellista's place right before the Hell Train saga](#)) They are special in that, like the main Arie Family members, the Royal Guards are taught how to use the Arie Family's special sword techniques - in addition, Adori knows Arie swordsmanship as well, as one might guess. As there are many secrets to her private life, no one really knows the true Adori. However, it is widely known to most of her fans that she allows people she likes to call her by her birth name (which is Adoru). Even before she became a Ranker, she defeated an upper level Ranker (quite easily to boot), and even Garam Jahad was overwhelmed and pushed to her limits when fighting her (context - before the 'Anne Jahad incident', Garam and Adori fought once). It hadn't even been 100 years since Adori became a Ranker, yet she was still able to overwhelm Garam. And since then, in the few fights she's had against other Rankers, she defeated all of them with her overwhelming combat prowess."

**Arie Hagipherione Jahad** - “The wielder of the Red October ([\\*nice Tom Clancy reference SiU](#)). She is a High-Ranker and one of only two people to have passed Arie Hon's special test on the 100th floor ([\\*more on that later](#)). Her reward was said to be 'very personal and childish'. The other known person to pass this test is Urek Mazino. It is speculated that she is likely the one who defeated the FUG slayer White and thus precipitated his "exile" inside the Hell Train, since White was supposedly defeated by a member from the same family.”

The other two known Arie Princesses are Arie Horn Jahad ([\\*the very first Princess of Jahad who is currently missing](#)) and Arie Rose Jahad ([\\*a Regular Princess who's said to have an antagonistic rivalry with Princess 'Hendo Lok Gladmerry Jahad'](#))

[\\*I'm including Horn and Rose here because there's not much extensive information for them to have their own sections.](#)

**Eurasia Enne Jahad** - “The wielder of the Colorless December, who at some point also took the White February after killing the original unknown owner. A High Ranker who went berserk and was sealed away ([\\*I'm going to spare you the Floor of Death info-dumps you already know](#)) She is the daughter of Eurasia Blossom ([\\*head of the Eurasia family - more on the family heads later](#)) and Po Bidau Gustang. Her mother was supposedly opposed to her becoming a Princess ([\\*citations on the wiki are missing for this](#)). Unie/Yunie Jahad and Rebecca Pon Jahad were killed by her, and Khun Maschenny Jahad and Pondo Jahad helped in catching her. There's also rumours that even Jahad himself had to interfere and that even Heice Jahad, who refused a '13 Month' Weapon after becoming a Ranker, participated in the battle against Eurasia Enne. It's widely known that her father Gustang was both Blossom's greatest fan and critic. There are many stories floating around about the romantic union of the two, however, most are fake. However, it is a fact that a certain legal document exists in the possession of Enne, that contains a notable secret about the two. After Enne was sealed away, her parents split up and forbade marriages between their Families. The main Eurasia family is now opposed to the selection of Jahad's princesses.”

It is said that the Thirteen Month Series were made from materials provided by Jahad. These weapons also vary in shape and function. For instance, one is a Needle (in regard to Black March) and another is a Hook (in regard to Green April). The Golden November is the only S-rank among the Thirteen Month Series. There have been five Princesses in total who had been executed for going on rampages due to the influence of the 'Ghost' of the 13th months.

## Part II - Ashul Edwaru

**Ashul Edwaru** is the famed blacksmith, who created the 13 Month Series and is one of the master artisans (장인, *jahng-in*, lit. "craftsman") of the Tower. In terms of his position in the Gong Bang (*\*the other name for the Workshop*), he would be similar to a High Ranker.

\*He also happens to be the author of the book "Of the Tower's Weapons", for which only the introductory segment has been preserved:

*"Dear readers,*

*A long time ago, King Jahad came into the uncivilised Tower and enlightened the inhabitants by ushering a new age of civilization, after which he set in motion his hegemony over them. He had declared, in regard to the tower - "[This place] is too muddied".*

*For us, who were born and raised inside the Tower, it is a statement that makes no sense. But for the people outside the Tower, the "Irregulars", it is a concept they are all too familiar with. Surprisingly, there's no Shinsu in their world and something called "air" fills their world instead. They have stated that the Tower filled with Shinsu is too boggy and uncomfortable for them.*

*I have never seen air, but I have found out some commonalities and differences between air and Shinsu by interviewing the Irregulars.*

*First, the common point is that they both let beings breathe. And they both flow constantly. Another shared aspect is that they are both powerful enough to threaten others when they flow 'harshly'.*

*Then the difference? The biggest difference is, indeed, the characteristics they exemplify whilst displaying various fluctuations in their levels of concentration. In Shinsu's case, it's more like a gas when it's in low concentration and more like liquid when it's in high concentration. But it seems air is not liquefied even in high concentrations.*

*The second difference is their respective dissimilitude in manner of circulation. The circulation of Shinsu is very fluid, but there is no common law of physics*

*being followed, in addition to which we must consider the fact that the movements are all different depending on the floors of the Tower. On the flipside, it is said that there are set laws in the circulation of air. (I want to dip my toes a bit more about the laws, but the research is slow because none of the Irregulars that I have met are knowledgeable enough about the laws of air.)*

*The third difference is consumption. Shinsu exists everywhere inside the Tower. As a result, Shinsu exists even in a room that is completely sealed. Shinsu does not flow in from somewhere else, but is rather created from the Tower. Subsequently, we can live in sealed-off places. Air is not created from within space itself inside sealed places and if a being is locked inside a sealed room, the being will consume all of the air and die. (This seems like an uncomfortable death by all accounts.)*

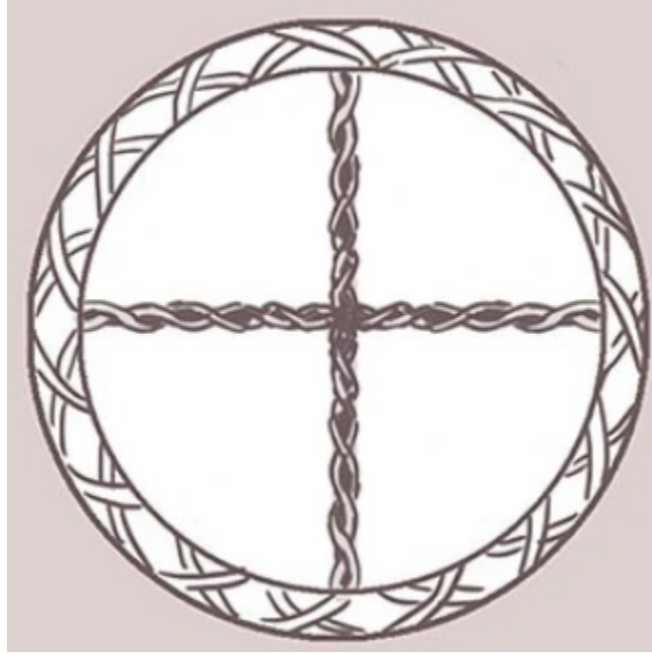
*You readers may not understand why I, a being who is not even a Wave Controller, am writing about Shinsu on the front pages of a book about weaponry. I dare say, it is because you, my dear readers, are ignorant of the weapons of the Tower. Shinsu and the weapons of the Towers are interrelated. You cannot fully understand the weapons unless you understand Shinsu.*

*All of the weapons we inhabitants use are modelled after the weapons from “the Outside” of the Tower, which Jahad and the ten Family Heads brought in with them when they came inside the Tower. Their weapons were, of course, all made to suit air, not Shinsu (even though some were supposedly used in a vacuum). They had to develop and modify their weapons to suit the properties of Shinsu. That's how the weapons we use were brought about. I feel as if I can conclude that it's absolutely essential to know about Shinsu to understand the weapons of the Tower.*

*For this reason, there are going to be a lot of stories about Shinsu in the following chapters and I request that readers place special emphasis on the relationship between the weapons and Shinsu while reading.”*

*\*Of course, it would be unwise to mention Edwaru without also introducing Macseth. Edwaru himself is only second to Macseth in the art and skills of weapons-craft.*

### Part III - Macseth (and more on the Workshop)



The 'Great Father' (\*the ultimate rank in the Workshop) **Macseth** (맥세스, *Meksehseu*; alternatively read "Mexcess") is a master weapon-craftsman and is also known as the "Father of the Workshop" (the Gong Bang). After crafting the White Oar, Macseth stopped crafting weapons. It is unknown why, or if he even perhaps kept on creating other objects such as Pockets.

\* The White Oar is the only Sword made by Macseth and it is currently owned by Arie Hon. White Oar is known as the only **S+** Rank weapon inside the Tower. Warriors in the Tower say the well-edged weapon is "like an oarfish" because of this. The name of the Sword, funnily enough, is derived from the Oarfish, a legendary type of White Steel Eel. At this current point in the story, the White Oar is the Tower's most powerful weapon (that we know of).

Macseth was indigenous/native to the Tower before Jahad and the Great Warriors (Family Heads) entered it. He was also a major factor in helping them climb The Tower. It can be insinuated that almost everything that can be (and is) called "science" in the Tower originates from him.

\*All Pocket models translate the various languages of the Tower to Macseth's native language.

He has four artificially created "children" by the name of Max, Mai, Mad and May and each of them holds the title of Great Teacher within the Gong Bang/Workshop. His most notable creation in the realms of artificial lifeforms is Flux, who holds the title of Father, one rank below Macseth ([\\*one of the Three Lords of Jahad who we will take a look at in the next segment after this](#)).

The Workshop (공방, 工房; *pronounced Gong Bang*, literally meaning "*Workshop*"), also referred as The Creation Room, The Blacksmiths, The Factory or Gong Bang, is an organization founded within the Tower by the Great Father Macseth. According to Macseth it also exists *outside* the Tower and "no-one" knows its origin. ([\\*it's unclear whether this no-one is literal or not](#))

Its ultimate ambition is to find the order and reason of all 'creation' in the world. And by doing so, to know how to recreate all such creation and with that, become a godly organization and "masters" of all creation.

There are presumably 5 ranks within the Workshop: Great Father (title only held by Macseth), Father (held by Flux), Great Teacher, Teacher and Disciple. As mentioned before, the four artificial children of Macseth hold the titles of Great Teachers. They are not given a ranking by the Ranking Administration Office because of their relationship with the Workshop. Their fighting capabilities are judged to be of S-level, comparable to High Rankers. According to certain rumours, each of the four possesses a different personality type and holds different knowledge (as ambiguous as that may be). And one of them, contrary to his or her title of Great Teacher, is a very mischievous prankster.

The title of Teacher is self-explanatory, however, it has to be noted that their influence within the Tower is enormous.

Disciples are chosen by the Teachers of the Workshop. They formally become one after a set period of training. As their position and title rises within the group, a Disciple enjoys benefits rivalling those enjoyed by Rankers.

In special cases, a Disciple may be chosen to be a Regular. However, they will be expelled from the Workshop and their knowledge "sealed" by law. The only known exception so far is Flux. On the other hand, there also have been cases where a Ranker became a Disciple; such a person is not expelled from the rankings, so it is possible to be both a Ranker and a Disciple provided you became a Ranker first.

Due to their unparalleled mastery of science and weapon engineering, the Workshop, if not for their independence and complete disinterest in the Tower's power struggles and politics, is strong enough to be a threat to Jahad's Empire, as further stated by Khun Hynd Luch.

When an unnamed Test Administrator of a Floor created a commotion with the Workshop, an attending Teacher completely humiliated him. The Ruler of the Floor himself came to ask for forgiveness from the Teacher after the news reached him.

#### **Part IV - The Three Lords**

The Three Lords are a trio of regents that take turns ruling every 1000 years over the Jahad Empire. The "Three Lords" system is actually an old tradition that has existed since Jahad first established the Empire in the Tower and stems from the crest of the crimson three eyes of the Jahad Family.

The Three Lords have the highest authority in all the politics of the Tower, and have the final say on all matters submitted by the Ruler's Conference. To avoid being bound by their heredity, they discarded their surnames and use only their first names.

**Flux** - This Lord is also known as the 'Magician'. He is the first disciple of Macseth and is one of the Fathers of the Gong Bang (and the only Father we know of thus far). Like all the other fathers of the Gong Bang, Flux is an artificial organism created by Macseth. However, no one has seen his real self and only the illusions he makes appear here and there in the Tower. He is one of three people that own the ultimate Lighthouse model, 'Opera', hinting that he is most likely a Light Bearer (although this is not confirmed). It seems that most or possibly even all Fathers are also Great Teachers. However, Flux is not a Great Teacher because he holds one of the Lord's seats and it is known that he is "out" of the Workshop (\*not in an immediate working position within the organization). One can view him as equal or slightly above the 4 children who might also be Fathers (though this is unconfirmed hence why we only refer to them by their Great Teacher ranks for the time being).

**Joochun** - Of the three, Joochun (주천, 酒川, *Jucheon*) is known to be a progressive Lord who strongly asserts and stands up for the idea of advancing onto the next Floor. Because he loves alcohol, he was named Joochun for "alcoholic river" (Joo=alcohol; cheon/chun=river).

He was born to Ari Han and an unknown woman who was native to the Tower. His mother is said to have died as she gave birth to him. There is a rumour that he is a drinking buddy to Urek Mazino, but this is unconfirmed.

His real name is, by default, Ari Chun.

**Molic One P. GR** - If Jahad is the symbol that represents the Tower's ruler and a personification of the Empire itself, Molic One (몰릭 원 P. GR, "*Mol-lic Won P. GR*") is the being who actually rules the Tower. Of the Three Lords, he is the strongest and his influence is comparable to the 10 Great Family Heads.

His name, Molic One, comes from the Molic region that he lived in, and it means the "absolute lord of Molic". As his name implies, he, quite obviously, was once the absolute ruler of the 'Molic' region of the Tower and, under a settlement with Jahad, became one of the Three Lords.

After he became a Lord, Molic faithfully performed the duties of a Lord and, unlike in his old days, he carried on the image of a benign and generous ruler. During the Rulers' Conferences, he occasionally shows a charisma that overwhelms all other Rulers (\*rulers here referencing the owners of the various floors who have the consent of Guardians like Evankhell and Khun Royale Elliot)

Although said to be a powerful warrior that even Jahad himself could not take lightly, as it's ancient history, most of the records with regard to these propositions and statements have been lost to the tides of time. Wielding his giant halberd, it is said he was able to fulfill the role of all positions; however, to say "it was not that he performed the role of every position, but rather that he fought without any regard to what a position was" seems to be the more accurate statement.

## Part V - More Wolhaiksong and FUG tidbits (and some info on the Ranking Administration Office)



**Wolhaiksong** - Co-founded by the famed High Rankers Urek Mazino and Baek Ryun (one of the most outstanding Wave Controllers in history), the influence and power of this organisation is so big that the 10 Great Families fear it ([\\*note how this contradicts Gustang's statements toward Urek in FoD](#)). Additionally, Khun Hynd Luch stated that Wolhaiksong is strong enough to threaten Jahad's Army. Their progressive image of 'finding a way out of the Tower' disagrees with the Jahad Empire's conservative ideals, but that's not enough to call them anti-government (which a lot of people brand them as). Although the relationship between the FUG and Wolhaiksong is not that good, there are a few members who are associated with both groups. The name Wolhaiksong, "the Winged Tree Under the Moon", originates from a supposedly true story between Urek and Baek Ryun; Wolhaiksong began when Baek Ryun heard the great stories of 'the world outside the Tower' from Urek and subsequently developed his own ambitions and dreams of leaving the Tower. Baek Ryun originally wandered from place to place and eventually settled down in a forest, but after he became very curious about the world outside and finally told Urek about his new desire to get

out, Urek said, "Then I'll attach wings to this forest. I'll attach wings to those big trees so that they can follow you anywhere you go." He then shrank (\*unknown as to how) the entire forest and put it in a small winged box. The name Wolhaiksong comes from this anecdote. Afterwards, the forest was moved to 77F and expanded back to normal size. Rankers who had heard stories of Urek and Baek Ryun gathered one by one, forming Wolhaiksong. Quant Blitz once said that their headquarters are located in a "hellish place" (\*Deep narrator voice returns\*: "As it turns out, Quant might not be the most reliable source of info").

**\*Bonus info on Urek Mazino** - An amazing High Ranker who set the record for climbing the Tower in the shortest time (using normal methods) - a total 50 years. Like most of the other High Rankers, he is very capable of filling all the positions. He was referred to by Khun Edahn/Eduan as "an opponent I [Edahn] really want to fight" and fought Arie Hon on an equal level when he was only a Regular, to the point that Hon praised him as a "true" warrior after their fight ended on a stalemate during his 100th floor test (and even admitted Urek was 'far better').

*\*the task of Hon's test was for Urek to endure his attacks for 10 minutes and his prize of choice was ownership over the 77th floor*

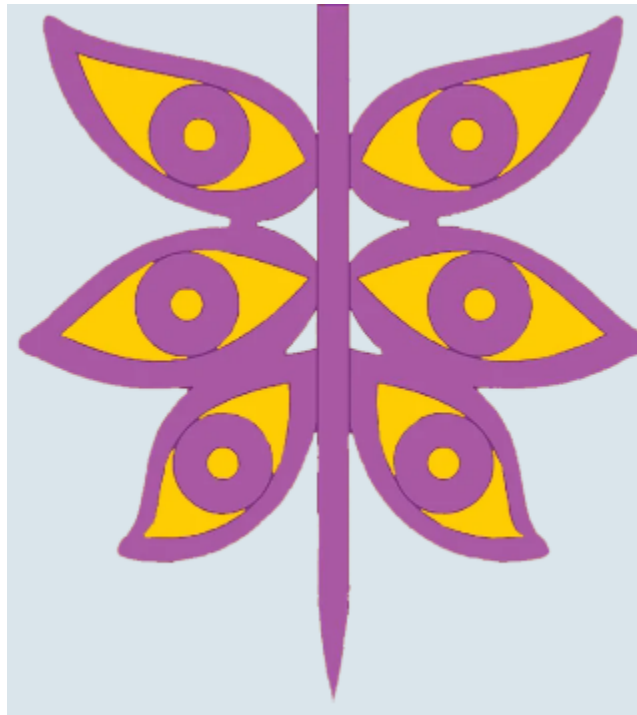
**Urek's humorous backstory with Phantaminum** - At some point in history, while both were still in the outside world, Urek had been tracking fellow irregular Phantaminum for unknown reasons, and when Phanta entered the Tower, Urek followed him inside immediately after, so we are left to assume that they have had a long history (or alternatively - a brief skirmish). There was a time when Urek, who had a complaint about his rank being lower than Phantaminum's, broke into the Ranking Administration Office, captured Robert Aisand (the deputy director of the place) and threatened him to raise his rank. To Urek, who asked, "Have you ever seen me fight Phantaminum?" Aisand answered briefly and without hesitation "You will be the loser if there was such a fight". Urek Mazino, shocked, could do nothing but go home bitterly. As a result of this incident, a number of jokes about Mazino emerged and nicknames like Urek Ma-Loser and Loser Mazino appeared. This climaxed into the production of comic strips featuring the incident which Baek Ryun said would "prove quite useful in the treatment of chronic depression". It appears that Urek has managed to get over this incident.



**\*Ranking Administration Office (\*logo above) members Tommy and Robert Aisand** - Tommy is the director of the Ranking Administration Office, one of the most influential groups in the Tower. He was chosen by Jahad to create the "Administrative Office of Ranks". He hired Robert Aisand as his assistant director and as his first employee of the Administration Office; Tommy calls him by the nickname "Aisan". Tommy is a person who is always out playing instead of being in the office - whose actions seem to say "Screw charisma, making decisions and handling issues". Because of the great (and comedic) wickedness that Tommy possesses, he included Robert Aisand in the rankings despite Aisand not being a Ranker. One day, Tommy texted Aisand asking what ranking he would give himself and Aisand responded with "?", which Tommy literally added to the rankings. Tommy is not included in the rankings (as he has not climbed the Tower). Meanwhile, Robert Aisand is a man hidden behind veils - so unknown that even Jahad does not know any of the details of his birth. Thanks to his outstanding and precise ability to handle matters and his silent personality, he is also known by the nickname "Robot Aisand" (at some point, there was a widespread rumour that he was an office-use cyborg created by the Workshop, but this was later "officially" denied by the Workshop). As the very first person put into the position by Tommy after Jahad chose Tommy to set up the Ranker Administration Office, Aisand is a man with awe-inspiring precise decision-making skills and charisma - the polar opposite of Tommy. It seems that he only has the battle power of an average person. However, despite this, he never cowers, even before High Rankers. It is said that there are many cases in which he overwhelms them instead. The majority in the Tower argues that, ignoring battle ability and purely based on influence, he can compete with FUG or the heads of the 10 Great Families.



**\*Bonus info on Kurdan and 'Ms. Ice Strawberry'** - these two Wolhaiksong members are fairly irrelevant, but it's worth noting that Kurdan holds the special position of Dansulsa (a.k.a. 'Technician') and that Ice Strawberry (real name unknown) is a member of a branch clan of the Eurasia family (\*supposedly not the Phonsekal branch but an entirely different one)



**FUG** - FUG has a total of 11 **Slayer positions**, and among the seven living Slayers, five are “missing” (\*vague wording sometimes replaced with “sleeping” or possibly inactive), while the other two, Karaka and Luslec, are reigning as “devils”.

(\*this statement was made before the Hoquin/White story-arcs and the Yama backstory re-write -> so only 3 are “missing” now - with this also being likely subject to change) Four seats are currently empty.

## Slayers

- Grace Mirchea Luslec: Founder and No. 1 Slayer of FUG (known as the God of Devils or the Demon King)
- Imort: Slayer of unknown Rank (\*there is a small possibility that Imort might not even become canon/get introduced into the plot or possibly have his name changed as he was tied to Yama’s original non-canon backstory -> more on that below)
- Karaka: No. 11 Slayer. (*targets Jahad*)
- Baylord Yama: No. 7 Slayer of FUG (\*possibly targets the head of Lo Po Bia)
- White: No. 10 Slayer of FUG (*targets Arie Hon*)
- Pephomemore Seto: Slayer of unknown Rank (“asleep”/“comatose”[?]/in need of a “revival”)
- One unnamed Slayer
- Vacant spot 1
- Vacant spot 2
- Vacant spot 3
- Vacant spot 4

“While the proper name of the organisation is unknown, some readers believe it to be “Forgiven (or Forgotten) Under Grace”, titular to its founder, Grace Mirchea Luslec, or “For Unforgettable Grace”. SIU confirmed that the G in FUG does stand for “Grace”.”

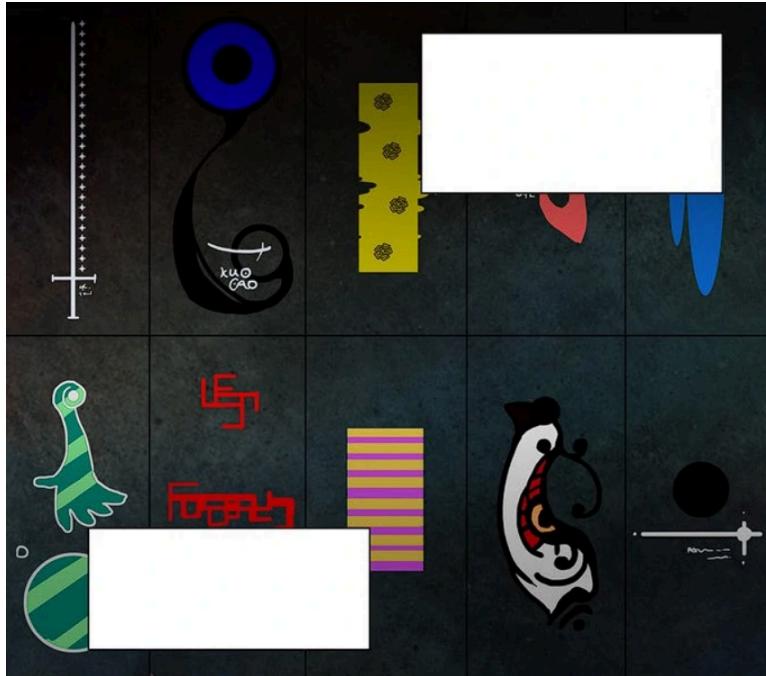


**Yama's original (now non-canon/scrapped) backstory** - "Baylord Yama was one of the Pitbulls that battled in Bayroad and it is said that he was the strongest Mad Dog of all time.

In the pit, he was a "God of Death" who drove opponents to their doom and people came to call him "Yama, the Lord of the Dead" out of respect for him. Later, he killed his own keeper and successfully became the only Mad Dog to ever escape from Bayroad and climb the Tower. Although no exact details are known regarding this escape, it is rumoured that Imort, another Slayer of FUG, was involved.

After becoming a Ranker, Yama returned to Bayroad with FUG's power backing him up and thus killed the previous owner of the pit. Hence, he simultaneously became the King of the Mad Dogs and a Slayer of FUG. Because of this, it has been frequently hypothesized that the utter domination of Bayroad was the final condition he had to fulfil to become a Slayer.

It is rumoured that he is currently using the enormous monetary revenue made in Bayroad as an impetus to build mysterious "pleasure-based" and entertainment-focused facilities (adult entertainment involving alcohol, drugs, and erotic activities) everywhere throughout the Tower and therefore expanding his influence and power. However, despite all of this notoriety, he has never once shown his face since becoming a Slayer."



## Part VI - 10 Great Families

**Ari Family** - The Ari Family head 'Ari Han' is related to the Arie Family head 'Arie Hon', however the two have created their own split family lineages (*\*fans theorize a possible brother or cousin relation - officially unconfirmed*). It is known among the Tower residents that this family has a pacifistic approach to various matters within the Tower and does not like war, doing everything they can to prevent it. They don't use real swords like the Arie Family, but instead, they use Needles. They have Needles that match the person or their personality. In addition, any member of the Ari Family can have their own personalized Needle if needed/requested. The only known members as of now are Ari Han, Ari Bright Sharon and Lord Joochun (Ari Chun).

>**Ari Han** - Aside from being the father of one of the three Lords - Joochun, Han also has two children (twins) with the Ha Family head Yurin (but was never officially married to her).

**Arie Family** - Currently the most famous family due to their swordsmanship, but also namely due to Arie Hon being the strongest of all Family heads. As of the current point in the story, they control Floors 100~95, 93~91, 79 and 78. Like all other Families, they have branch clans too, with two currently known - Arion and Ariran. The Arie have a strong ego-based rivalry with the Khun and Ha Families,

with the Arie members fighting for control over the 80~90 Floors against the Khun members. The direct/non-branch descendants of the Arie Family are quite a few, so having a chance to meet face to face with them is fairly small. All known members thus far are: Hoaqin, Albelda, Anna, David, Vicente > subsequently White; Arie Hon, Arie Hagipherione Jahad, Arie Rose Jahad, Arie Horn Jahad (\*Horn and Hon are spelled with the same Hangul characters in Korean so she basically has the same name as her father) and Arie Inieta. One can learn the Arie swordsmanship techniques, but never use them as proficiently as a member of the Arie Family would (like Adori and the various nameless Royal Guards).

>**Arie Hon** - Arie Hon is known for giving special tests on his personal Floor (Floor 100th) and at some point after entering, Urek Mazino challenged the test (\*as mentioned above). Hon's fight with Mazino is his most recent one, as he has not battled anyone after him up to this point. It is said that before entering the Tower with the rest, he challenged Jahad ten times and lost all ten times; thus he became Jahad's servant.

**Eurasia Family** - Led by Eurasia Blossom; known fairly well in the story thanks to its branch clan members' numerous appearances - the Phonsekal branch. It is said that all Eurasia members are adept at controlling Shinsu (natural-born Wave Controllers) and all of them love to sleep (not exclusive to the Phonsekal branch). It's current known members are: Phonsekal Drak, Irure, Laure, Yurure; Eurasia Blossom, Eurasia Enne Jahad and Ms. Ice Strawberry. The Po Bidau and Eurasia Families have had hostile relations ever since the Enne Jahad incident and the forbidding of marriages between the two Families.

>**Eurasia Blossom** - Blossom has the appearance of a young child (\*wow [Gustang...](#)) and loves flamboyant clothes, in addition to having the laziest personality of all the Heads. Although Blossom does not fall short of the other Family Heads in terms of talent and skills, she hasn't involved herself in the politics of the Tower since the Great Journey (\*[their climb](#)). Because of her lazy personality, she does not take care of either the Floors she rules or her Family and has thus received a lot of criticism from the other Family Heads because of this. Although she never showed any interest in the deep scientific research of Shinsu pioneered by fellow Family Head Po Bidau Gustang, Blossom's abilities on the battlefield are said to be above Gustang's. In fact, Gustang himself is said to be jealous of Blossom's superior genius (\*natural) talents and in his many writings, he has made this evident. In the end, even he himself had to

acknowledge her skills. In one of his earliest works, it is written: "Blossom is one of the greatest Wave Controllers, but she cannot teach you anything. This is evidently because she herself does not know how she controls Shinsu". This superiority complex was so famous that the idiom "Gustang looking at Blossom" was formed and used constantly to describe situations whenever a genius is jealous of an even greater genius and eventually evolved into another idiomatic phrase to describe a man and a woman in a bad relationship. Her ability to control Shinsu even allows her to instantly kill 99% of the population by just accelerating the Shinsu around her. While Gustang used Shinsu to assist in battle as a "Support" Wave Controller, Blossom used her Shinsu to directly strike in battle as an "Offensive" Wave Controller. Her way of controlling Shinsu was very violent and unpredictable, with there being cases of the other 10 Family Heads having to get out of her way once she started attacking.

**Ha Family** - Led by Ha Yurin, who has only given birth once - to the previously mentioned twins she had from Ari Han. Thus, any and all Ha branches (of which there are fewer compared to other Families) can be traced back to this split. It is also subsequently a fact that all children of the Ha Family have Ari blood within them too. Since the family is centered around the two twins, the duo do not have a friendly relationship since each one of the two claims to be the rightful heir to the family. Although not confirmed, it is assumed that "Hayeol" may be the branch family that Novick originates from. The Ha Family has an antagonistic relationship with the Khun Family. The current known members of the Family are: Ha Yuri, Ha Yurin, Ha Jinsung, Ha Cheonhee, Ha Ruda, Ha Yura (and Yura's mom), Ha Chai and Novick and the unnamed twins that started the split lineage.

\*SIU had stated that he personally likes the Ha Family. They have this sense of "No matter what, charge forward" mentality, and feel more "human" than the other 10 Great Families, while also treating branch members with the same respect as direct descendants. Of course, on the flipside, their physical capacity is extremely inhuman.

\*there's some conflicting info on the genders of the Ha twins, which are shown as female on the wiki, but stated as male by the original fan-translator on Vatoto.com ([\\*which is why I would take everything in this file with a grain of salt as many things may be subject not just to future change but also to incorrect source translation that even I may not be able to help with](#))

>**Ha Yurin** - Yurin was the first person to hold the Scout position in The Tower. She has no interest in family politics and, lately, she has even ceased all her other activities and is dedicated to enjoying herself in her main house. Although she had many other relationships since Ari Han - she never gave birth again. She possesses a very aggressive and bold personality. Amongst the 10 Great Warriors, she would often be the first one to engage in combat. Her style of fighting is very rough, yet intelligent, and she possessed a strong enough physique to perform the duties of both a fisherman and a scout. With grace and flexibility, she weaved through the battlefield, and it is said she was the first to use Shinsu to strengthen one's body (\*Shinsu reinforcement). After she became a Family leader, she has not participated in battle since. Within the Ha Family, her presence as the Head is more symbolic, and she rarely governs the clan herself.

**Hendo Lok Family** - This family is led by Hendo Lok Bloodmadder. It is the Great Family with the least influence in the Tower and also has the smallest amount of Rankers. This is due to a pact that Bloodmadder made with the 100th Floor Guardian in exchange for eternal life, which curses all of Hendo's children to have short lifespans ([\\*more on that below](#)). As a result, Bloodmadder chooses to adopt his family members. Its members still uphold an ironclad set of rules, and Bloodmadder's position within the clan is absolute. The Rankers that uphold the Hendo Family are all Hendo's adopted sons and daughters. The Hendo Family are famous for having the strongest defensive power of all the 10 Great Families; as such, those that possess Hendo's blood usually have high Shinsu resistance. The only known members are Hendo Lok Bloodmadder, Hendo Lok Gladmerry Jahad and a weak Regular by the name of Bel Berhino ([\\*who appeared in the webcomic for a brief test before the gang boarded the Hell Train](#))

>**Hendo Lok Bloodmadder** - One of the few to specialize in the unique position of Defender, a position that protects Spear Bearers and Light Bearers ([\\*the only other one we know of is Aka Williams](#)). It is said that when he teamed up with the once-greatest Spear Bearer in the Tower, Khun Eduan, they were unstoppable.

As a reward for passing its test, the Guardian of the 100th Floor offered Jahad and the Great Warriors the gift of immortality. Bloodmadder was excluded from this gift, however. The exact reason for his exclusion is not known, however, Bloodmadder begged the Guardian for a way to receive eternal life and the Guardian decided to offer it under one condition:

*“If you give your children and your children's children the curse of a short life, you alone will be able to live an eternal life through the life you've taken from them.”*

—The 100th Floor Guardian's proposition to Bloodmadder

Although conflicted, Hendo could not overcome his fear of death and accepted the Guardian's conditional immortality. All those born under Bloodmadder are cursed with a short life: a 'short life' in the Tower being roughly a 100 years, and while it may be slightly longer for Rankers of the bloodline, even then they cannot become immortal.

Because his longevity is tied to the sacrifice of his children's lifespans, Bloodmadder had to sire many children. Unsurprisingly, of all the heads of the 10 Great Families, Bloodmadder has the most children (he does not have the most wives as this distinction goes to Koon Eduan). No one knows the exact details of his contract with the Guardian, but it seems definite that he needs to maintain as many children as possible.

Blood descendants of Hendo often lie about their backgrounds in order to marry. Because of this practice of “deceptive marriage”, Bloodmadder's blood was scattered throughout the Tower and eventually the government was forced to expend significant resources to seek out and isolate those carrying “Bloodmadder's Blood”.

\*SiU states that he has some deep connection with Hansung Yu, whatever that may be.

**Khun Family** - One of the most notable Families led by Khun Eduan. Khun Eduan has the greatest number of wives and the second-greatest number of children out of the 10 Families after Hendo Lok Bloodmadder. There is a lot of veiled competition among his children and due to this insane amount of sibling rivalry, the Family created the 'official' brawls, held once a year (the children have to reach the age of 10 first before competing). After the fights, the winners, who get to bear the Family crest, are declared to be his true children, while the losers are abandoned. Although the fights are inhumane and bloody, Eduan himself

says he's "not very interested" ([\\*truly the father of the century along with Arie Hon](#)). This family is famous for its cunning intelligence. Additionally, there is likely a lot of competition among Eduan's wives as they seek to gain favour and power from their husband. It was vaguely mentioned that "the 'powers' have shifted" and Khun Aguero Agnis' mother said she had "lost her fight" (for 'power'). The "house head" that was mentioned to be the person who was responsible for "casting aside" Khun Aguero Agnis is likely a person who holds a high position within the Family and could even be the wife of the main branch. The current known members of the Family are: Khun Edahn/Eduan, Khun Hachuling/Hatzling (a.k.a Blueberry), Khun Hynd Luch, Khun Marco Asensio, Khun Maschenny Jahad, Khun Maschenny (the mother), Khun Royale Elliot, Po Bidau Khun Lyborick, Khun Kiseia, Khun Maria, Khun Icardi, Khun Ran, the unnamed Khun (who helped stop the Hell Train during early Hoaqin Arc) and finally Khun Aguero Agnes.

\*On a more humorous note, according to SIU, the common trait of the Khun Family is that they are basically just douchebags. SIU has jokingly stated that Khun is his "least favourite" character, because "he is rich and smart and the plot gets hard to follow when he's around" - which often gets misconstrued by fans. SIU gave this answer when asked who his favourite character was, which implies that Khun is actually his favourite character, and that SiU simply gave his classic dry-humor response. This is basically confirmed, as SiU has also stated that he feels attached to Khun as a character, because he feels that "Khun is very human". ([\\*general response to ToG fans > stop parroting around everything you hear because it may just be poorly translated or conveyed by the majority](#))

> **Khun Eduan** - Khun Eduan holds a special test with a shocking condition, which is 'Whoever fights him and wins is given everything from the family', but none of the Regulars who have participated have survived the test thus far. He is famed as a collector of a multitude of the highest-ranking items in the Tower, as he values his collections very highly. This is evidenced by the shock the administrators have on the Floor of Test after Yu Han Sung explains Khun Aguero Agnis had plundered his father's "treasure house" before coming to the Tower, taking such amazing items as Manbarondenna and a high-grade suspendium pulley. He is friendly with Arie Hon despite their families being rivals (and the previously mentioned skirmishes on who gets the 80~90 Floors), but is a bit jealous of him for being ranked higher. The mythical god Dionysus was the

inspiration for Khun Eduan -> So, among the 10 Family Heads, he is the one most known for dissipation, hedonism, womanizing, etc.

**Lo Po Bia Family** - \*not much outside/external info besides what is already offered in the webcomic. The Lo Po Bia Family Head is the only one of the Greats whose personal name we don't know. Current known members of the Family are: The Unnamed Head, Lo Po Bia Dokoko, Lo Po Bia Didiano, Lo Po Bia Fucile, Lo Po Bia Haratcha, Lo Po Bia Ha Satcha, Lo Po Bia Lefav, Lo Po Bia Porp, Lo Po Bia Ren, Lo Po Bia Yasratcha, Lo Po Bia Elaine (Kaiser), Lo Po Bia Alphine, along with Lilial and Shilial Jahad.

**Po Bidau Family** - The males of Gustang's family are selected to work in a research group called the Research Association. If they do not make it as members, they are eventually kicked out of the family. Because it is a very powerful and exclusive group, the members enjoy high reputation and fame, matched only by the "Chosen children of Khun". The requirements for becoming a member of the Association are unknown; it is unknown if the females of the Po Bidau Family are allowed to join, or if one must be a Ranker to be selected. It is also unknown if people who aren't from the Po Bidau Family are allowed to join. Current known members of the Family are: Po Bidau Gustang, Po Bidau Khun Lyborick (alternative name order -> Lyborick Khun), Eurasia Enne Jahad and the unnamed Po Bidau at the end of season 2.

The association also holds various tests for people not in the Family, such as the Wonsul Test: In order to learn Wonsul ([\\*Mule Love's blue disc that became Bam's signature technique](#)), one must be chosen to take certain Tests from the Research Association. Those who have passed the Tests become certified and are chosen to learn Wonsul. Requirements to be chosen to take the tests are currently unknown and it is also unknown if Regulars are allowed to take this test, or if it's exclusive to Rankers. Currently only Love and Hansung Yu are known to have passed.

\* again, on a more humorous note: 'Lightpen', the Vice-President of the Association, is known for his "wise" words regarding reverse-flow Shinsu control: "There is only one thing needed to defeat an enemy using reverse-flow control. You just have to be overwhelmingly more powerful than your opponent!".

**Tu Perie Family** - literally no info on these people, besides that they are leading in the art and skill of Light Bearing, so let's talk about the Family Head -> Tu Perie Tperie - Tu Perie Tperie is the first Light Bearer in The Tower's history, but how they came to be in that position is unknown. Whenever they reminisce about the time they became a Light Bearer, they're known to say, "The Heavens gave me the Eyes of God". However, it could be that people choose to believe a "romanticised story" rather than the "exact truth". Tu Perie Tperie became one of the most active Family Heads and is known to have created many items along with the Blacksmiths of the Workshop. They're also crucial in the pioneering of the system in which Light Bearers act as the intermediary for all communications within a team. The most famous of Tu Perie Tperie's creations is the three "Opera" Lighthouses, among the greatest Lighthouses of The Tower. Tu Perie Tperie does not use the one they still possess however, preferring to use the "Eyes of God" instead (*\*not much info on the Eyes of God besides that it's a lighthouse and supposedly one notch above the Operas*).

In theory, the Opera extends the user's Shinsu field to infinity (beyond all reason and boundaries), making it the ultimate dream of all Light Bearers. It also contains defensive measures that put even Armour Inventories to shame. Through the use of Shinsu-controlled interlocking Lighthouses, it has no weak spots.

Because the man (*\*Tperie is supposedly a man, but it's not entirely clear*) who developed the system where "the Light Bearer acts as the center of all other Positions" also created an item that turns "the Light Bearer into a one-man-show", many complain that while the Opera Lighthouse is the ultimate evolution of the Lighthouse, it is at the same time an item that makes the basic purpose of the Light Bearer moot. Of course, these are the complaints of those who cannot comprehend the powers of those above. (TN: SIU wasn't clear, it's basically saying that the man who created the Light Bearer Position also made an item that made the Light Bearer Position basically unnecessary.)

Also, the communication function of the Opera and any other device connected to it cannot be stopped or jammed by other devices such as the Hell Train.

Lord Flux and Princess Jaina Repellista Jahad are the other two owners of Operas. It is theorized by fans that Repellista is from a branch clan of Tu Perie - Jaina, but this is unconfirmed.

Should an Opera ever appear on the market, there is talk that the price would be immeasurable, but looking at the three current wielders, it's unlikely that it will ever appear on the market.

**Yeon Family** - led by Yeon Hana. Interestingly enough, members of the family do not carry her blood as all of them are born from Ilarde, the "godmother" of the clan. Like the Ha Family, the Yeon Family is a thoroughly matriarchal Family (to an even larger degree), so males cannot take central roles in either the main house or the branch house of the Family. Thanks to this, the females of the Yeon Family, especially those of the main house, have a tendency to look down on men. Daughters of the Yeon Family line are born around once every 100 years. Among the several branches of the Yeon Family Yeon Yihwa comes from a very rare family gifted with amazing flame manipulation abilities which can develop abilities that would even put members from the Khun Family to shame. They are also the rulers of the 21st Floor. Current known members are: Yeon Hana, Yeon Woon, Yeon Ilarde and Yeon Yihwa.

Although Hana is the Family Head, there is not a single child in the official Yeon Family, or in general, who has received her blood (in other words, Hana has never had sexual relations with anyone). Ilarde gives birth to and raises Hana's 'children' in her stead, so the children of the Yeon Family all call her "godmother". Once every 5 years, Ilarde selects a man to sleep with her, and it is said that Rankers from all over the Tower gather for a chance to become that man; however, Ilarde's eyes for choosing men are very "cold", so unless one is a decent male Ranker, it is difficult to even get past the paper document interview. Selected males live in the palace for 5 years, and only one of these men will receive the right to sleep with Ilarde and, if a child is born, they attain the glory of being accepted into the Family.

>**Yeon Hana** - According to a rumour, she could not forget and/or forgive a man whom she broke up with a long time ago, so she made a contract with a Guardian to become a "female that cannot feel love towards the opposite sex". Hana is considered to be the most beautiful among the 10 Heads. Despite sometimes being suspected of possibly being a misandrist, Hana actually has a gentle personality (which is very rare among the 10 Family Heads) and treats both men and women kindly. Though she has a gentle personality, Yeon Hana is "the scariest woman when angry" according to the 10 Family Heads. It is said that when she got angered once, she surpassed Ha Yurin, who was famous for

having a terrible personality, but this is impossible to confirm at the present time in which the 10 Family Heads are not active in public.

\*it is stated that Ilarde is “an old fellow family member and a main member of the Yeon family”, so this wording implies that she either also entered the Tower with the Family Leaders + Jahad + V and Arlene (which gives us an entirely new take on the story we thought we knew) OR the wording is simply vague and twisted around and that she might just have been a resident of the Tower whom Hana welcomed and regarded as a family member (which gives us a new perspective on the children of Yeon). In addition, here are GoDai’s words:

(GoDai: The term used here for "family member" has various meanings. It can mean "member of household" as in "Member of the Household of God" - pertaining to religious groups calling themselves family, even if not related by blood. Same with "the children/brood of darkness" and "fraternity/sorority" - This term can refer to literal families or people that consider each other to be family.)

\*GoDai is a fan-translator and the main source for a sizeable portion of this translated info

## Part VII - Rankings

Sobriquet (이명, 異名, I-myeong; "nickname" or "pseudonym") is a type of nickname issued by the Ranking Administration Office, usually in reference to the High Ranker's battle Position or other notable features and/or aspects. Only High Rankers (the top 1000) are able to receive a sobriquet.

A sobriquet can also be turned down, as Baek Ryun and Khun Eduan refused their sobriquets. Also, a person might be presented with more than one sobriquet as with Khun Eduan.

Fishermen are usually given the names of Shinheuh. Guides are usually given the names of Boats. Wave Controllers are usually given the names of various winds and waves.

## Phantaminum

**Rank: 1**

*Sobriquet: The Riddle*

*Age: Unknown*

*Height: Unknown*

*Birthplace: Unknown*

*Position: Unknown*

**Extra info:** It is said that he had a freewheeling and desultory combat style, and had used a weapon that was never seen anywhere inside the Tower. The negative views toward the irregulars have grown because of him and it had a big impact on Urek when he climbed the Tower. When Phantaminum broke into the palace, it is said he met Yuri Jahad in the inner palace, and there is a great diversity of opinion as to why he didn't kill her. Yuri didn't say anything about the matter except that 'He was a messy/nasty one (read: 'scumbag').' There were a lot of objections in the Rank Administering Office in regard to giving Phantaminum, who disappeared after the attack on the palace of Jahad and subsequently becoming inactive, the top rank. But everyone agreed his impressive strength alone was overwhelming (even causing eye witnesses to lose their minds). As a result, Phantaminum became the No. 1 Ranker after only one battle, dragging the 'Red Tower' Enryu down to 2nd rank.

Reportedly, he had been seen on very brief occasions within the Tower after the attack of the palace, but most of the stories are rumors, therefore it's hard to confirm any of them. There's also a rumor

that he is on cat-and-dog terms with another irregular, Urek Mazino, but that is also subject to doubt. All in all, Phantaminum is a monster whose information starts with a riddle and ends with a riddle. Every Ranker is on the watch for any and all movement from this 'monster'.

**Important note** - the following info pertains to non-canon or "extended universe" exposition that may or may not be integrated into the ToG story (especially considering SiU himself stated that there's a possibility of Phantaminum never actually appearing in the webcomic):

Phantaminum is an "Axis User" (and the only confirmed one in the story so far). An Axis User, also known simply as an Axis (or Axes plurally), is a person with the power to influence a "tale" within the Talse Uzer Story (Talse Uzer being the larger universe that ToG belongs to - [\\*more on that in a bit](#)). They are the greatest variables which determine the future (supposedly more so than someone like Jahad or Khel Hellam).

There are many Axes outside the Tower. An Axis is named as such because their ability is invoked with the user as an axis (\*the poor wording here is vague and redundant - it is most likely referring to the axis of rotation or the optical axis). Apart from this fact, their abilities do not hold almost any similarity with each other. A non-Axis User is unable to interfere in any way, meaning even the weakest Axis could defeat the strongest non-Axis. An Axis User can only be defeated by a more powerful Axis.

In the Tower of God universe, Phantaminum is the "author", or god, of one "story" in the universe. In exchange for taking on the responsibility of managing this story, he is given powerful authority over the events that occur in the story. He is able to "write" records that cannot be erased or changed.

Every Axis has the power to generate a space around them, in which they can use a unique power that cannot be denied or negated. Under the specifications of this ability, an Axis can control some aspect of reality within their own field. Axes primarily have the ability to control the reality of a finite amount of space around them.

**Talse Uzer (pronounced Tales User):** the larger universe that SiU's stories belong to. The *TUS* is a universe that works under the premise that "The world comprises several 'tales' as its centre, with these tales persisting as unchangeable records". In other words, in Talse Uzer Stories, the past cannot change and the future is already set. Once written, a tale from the Talse Uzer universe cannot be set back or restored to a previous state. Hence, the past becomes permanently fixed, which in turn restricts future events. It's a universe that rejects the existing hypothesis that the world holds infinite possibilities.

Tower of God is one of the "several stories" in Talse Uzer, but these stories do not have much connection to each other. According to SiU: "There are no reasons to understand/analyze Talse Uzer. You can still enjoy Tower of God even if you ignore other Talse Uzer Stories entirely."

Up to this point, Tower of God is the only 'official' TUS in Talse Uzer, but SiU has published previous works that are currently up in the air in terms of their canon status (most of them have been preserved by various people and can be read online with TNs under them).

## Enryu

**Rank: 2**

*Sobriquet: Red Tower (unofficial nicknames include: "the Guardian/Administrator Murderer")*

*Age: Unknown*

*Position: Spearmaster (Spear Bearer) - "Throwing type"*

**Extra info:** Enryu is known to fight by creating thousands of spears made with red/crimson Shinsu and striking them downwards. Some people use a poetic expression, describing it as 'Red Rain', but it wouldn't look beautiful from the victim's point of view. Enryu's overwhelming control against the Shinsu is rated a cut above the Guardians, and it is considered a 'heretical' ability, breaking the laws of the Tower.

It is not known where Enryu is or what he's doing currently, but it is rumored that Headon is seeking him with avidity.

## Jahad

**Rank: 3 (previously the No. 1 Ranker before Phantaminum and Enryu appeared)**

*Sobriquet: King of the Tower*

*Age: Unknown*

*Height: 2 m 40 cm*

*Birthplace: Unknown*

*Position: Fisherman*

\*no extra info as it's all known, previously stated and/or redundant

## Urek Mazino

**Rank: 4**

*Sobriquet: Ray-Barakuda*

**Extra info:** Currently the strongest Ranker on the move (read: active/not missing/not 'sleeping'). He is the most recent irregular to appear in the Tower of the Top 5 specifically. His sobriquet, 'Barakuda', is the name of the most aggressive and ferocious white steel eel in the Tower. 'Ray' is the sobriquet suffix attained from his combat style, which focuses on forwarding Shinsu that is as fast as light in the form of rays. Although his formal sobriquet is 'Ray Barakuda', simply 'Barakuda' can also be used to refer to him.

His other sobriquet, the Blue Thunderclap (푸른 진격 (震擊), *pureun jingyeok*; literally "Blue Thunder/Quake Strike" or "Blue Lightning Strike") is a sobriquet that was based on the property of the shinsu he wields. Reportedly, someone from the ranking bureau stated that his sobriquet should be "Electric Eel". To that, he said "I'll kill all of those who call me an electric eel" boldly, and this became a fun (?) anecdote that tells us how he came to be known as Marlin. Although for the ranking bureau it was actually a problematic event in which their lives were at stake...

Becoming one with the forest, he lived there for a long time and naturally learned to control Shinsu through everyday life in the wilderness. Later on at some point, Headon, who was interested in Baek Ryun's abilities, picked him and made him a Regular. As a Regular, he quickly became a Ranker; as a Ranker, he then returned to the forest without any further activity/duty/missions. He spent a long time doing gardening-based activities. His forest, which is said to be like a living animal, is reported to emit a "mysterious atmosphere"...

The name "Baek Ryun" either originates from the fine silk that he was covered with when he was abandoned or from a nickname based on his silk-like personality.

Ryun's real appearance is a subject of controversy/conflicting accounts. Normally, he appears to be an ordinary boy according to most people, but he sometimes appears as a tall young man. In addition, some say that they have seen Ryun as a giant, tall enough to touch the ceilings of the various floors within the Tower.

So, Anaak decided to throw her just a little ember.

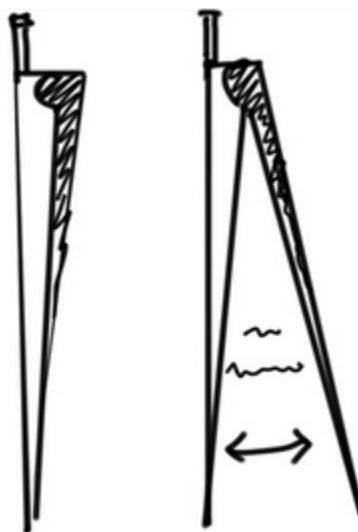

“In the auctions, the base monetary units come in 10K Points and above. Since the Tower is so large, each area has its own currency units, but among the Regulars and the Rankers, it’s Points. Points are a very loosely defined concept for a currency and they can be bought using official regional currencies. Of course, they can be exchanged as well. Since each region has their own currency values, the exchange rate is different on a region-to-region basis, but in most regions, having 100,000,000 Points would mean you’re filthy rich. This is unless you’re near the regions where the 10 Families are based in (because the value of money greatly differs there) but still, 100M Points is a huge amount of money in the Tower at the end of the day. With that kinda money you can ditch the Tests, go into the Middle Area, and live out the rest of your days rich and carefree.”



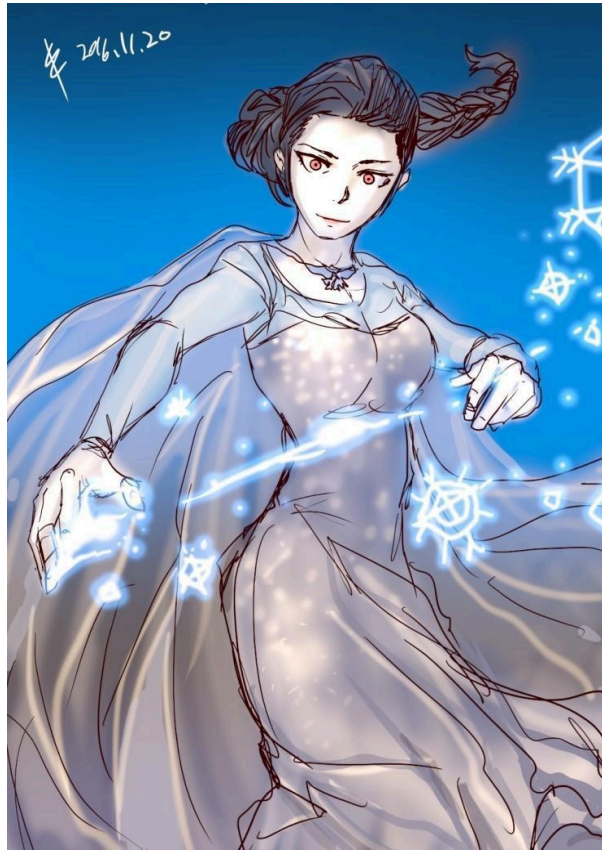
