

## DARIEN HIGH SCHOOL TEST CENTER INFORMATION

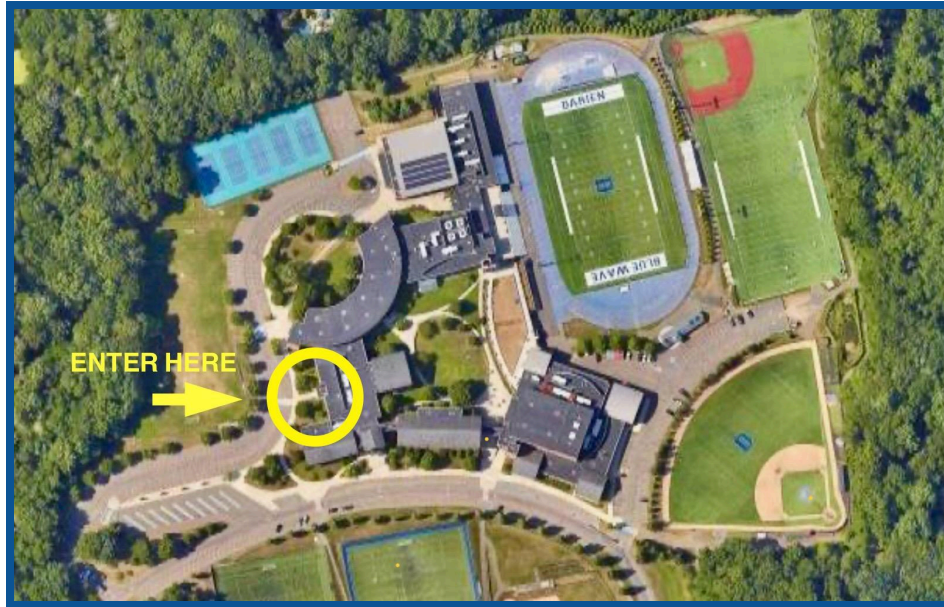

### WHAT SHOULD YOU BRING TO THE TEST?

---

#### ACT

1. Admission ticket
2. Proper photo ID
3. Two number 2 pencils (*not mechanical*)
4. An approved calculator

#### SAT (Digital)

1. Admission ticket
2. Proper photo ID
3. **Fully charged** personal device with charger
4. Download [Bluebook](#) app
5. Two number 2 pencils for scratch work\*
6. An approved calculator\*

*\*Testers can use digital scratch page/calculator embedded in Bluebook app*

Snacks/drinks permitted. Testers may only access these during official breaks.

## ARRIVAL AND CHECK IN PROCEDURES

---

1. Before test day, be sure to confirm your test center location on your ticket
  - Students who do not have DHS listed on their ticket as the test center will not be admitted
2. Arrive by 7:30 AM to check in
3. Use the Library entrance and join the check in line
4. Have your ticket and photo ID ready before checking in
5. Testing staff will check your ID and admission ticket, admit you to the test center, and direct you to your test room
6. Turn your cell phone OFF when you enter the building
7. Testing will begin promptly at 8:00 AM and no students will be admitted after that time

## TEST ROOM PROCEDURES

---

1. Follow all proctor directions carefully and completely
2. No food or drink except on breaks
3. Keep silent in the halls while on breaks, and return promptly
4. Follow all testing rules completely - listen carefully!

## DEPARTURE

---

1. When all test materials have been collected, you will be dismissed
2. Please leave quietly through the library entrance at the bottom of the stairs
3. Do not turn on your cell phone until you have left the building
4. Estimated End Times for Tests (*approximate*):
  - **SAT (Digital)**
    - Standard Time SAT – between 10:45 AM and 11:15 PM
    - Time & One-Half SAT – between 12:00 PM and 12:30 PM
    - Double Time SAT - between 1:00 PM and 1:30 PM
  - **ACT**
    - Standard Time ACT (no Science or Writing) – between 11:00 AM and 11:30 AM
    - Standard Time ACT (w/ Science OR Writing) – between 11:45 AM and 12:15 PM
    - Standard Time ACT (w/ Science AND Writing) – between 12:30 PM and 1:00 PM
    - Extended Time ACT (no Science or Writing) – between 12:00 PM and 12:30 PM
    - Extended Time ACT (w/ Science OR Writing) – between 1:00 PM and 1:30 PM
    - Extended Time ACT (w/ Science AND Writing) – between 2:00 PM and 2:30 PM
