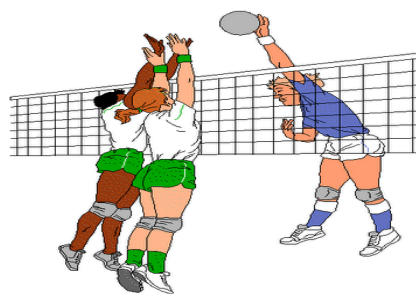

Attendance and Behavior Reminders

Bus Service
