

Bug stats: $\frac{495}{1}$ +51 -14 ($\frac{453}{1}$ +14 -30): (It's a lot more, but that's because all broken unittests are now registered as bugs)



Commits in the past week (copied from github):

- Excluding merges, 6 authors have pushed 13 commits to master and 53 commits to all branches. On master, 32 files have changed and there have been 190 additions and 293 deletions.

Release

Release procedure for stable releases:

• We release every other month

- Four weeks before we release, we close the merge window: only regression fixes are allowed
- Four weeks before the release, we release a "beta" with a link to a survey for testing
- When we tag the final release, the merge window opens again

Builds & Dependencies update

- A number of updated deps don't build on Windows: https://invent.kde.org/kde/krita/merge_requests/198
 - Mostly fixed, see "Dependencies update"
- Qt 5.14, SIP 5.0 woes
- Python 3.8.: it doesn't work on Windows (reason unknown yet)
- OpenEXR: it doesn't install properly (it isn't found by Krita's cmake)
- SIP and PyQt were updated as well, but Qt wasn't. The new sip (5.0) is incompatible with our findsip.cmake.
- No update for 27th
- Dmitry will look into updating to Qt 5.14; after that ivan will look into fixing sip and pyqt.

Youtube Channel

• . We are almost **9000** subs in the Youtube channel. I am in production stage. The script is done. Recording Chroma parts and Desktop scenes. Finally i will publish 14 brushes for the part one. Ramon proposes to publish the video as a premiere and make an announcement for it on krita.org. It will be ready in ~2 weeks.

Roundtable

- Boud: I had a good week working on the resources branch. I'm not so tired anymore, and I managed to wrap my brain around the code again. I did some more bug fixing, lots of admin stuff and worked on the Team page because of emmetpdx's remarks that we really should our human face even more. Also, I'll be away monday mornings starting from mid march because of a course in painting.
- **Tiar**: I was doing general cleanup of tagging system, removing unused functions and signals and all that. I removed KisTagsResourcesModel. The last thing exposed a design issue regarding tagging in ItemChooser, which we'll talk about.
- Dmitry: The vectors threading work is done now, it only needs mr tested by someone again: https://invent.kde.org/kde/krita/merge_requests/194. There is one design "issue" everybody should be aware of: on every shapes rendering cycle (once every 100ms) all the layer's shapes are shallow-copied. This copy might take up to 1ms for complex documents, which is up to 1% overhead. It should be okay, just remember about that.
- Ramon: Has ideas about tagging, plus the video should be done in 2 weeks
- Wolthera: Working on the manual, also did KSoC mentoring.
- IvanYossi: I've been working mostly on bug, I test and start working on everything I can reproduce. But one at a time to avoid holding into a lot of bugs as before. I finally was able to make apitrace work and have an idea on how to fix openGL slowlyness in macOS
- Lynx3d: I've been working on the "internal" color selector some more lately, also to make it more viable for the popup palette, but got a bit tangled up in reworking some signal handling and an issue with the (old) resource system. Also the work on L*a*b and CMYK from amyspark will affect it some, so it's a bit on hold right now. Apart from that I wrote some code to make the brush preset history more configurable (not just a static order), but I need to find a proper way to present the settings in the UI.
- Hellozee: So I have been trying to get the canny filter in, the math is not that hard but, I have a couple of problems which I need to debug, first is qDebug() is not ouputting anything when called from the overriden virtual method and currently the method doesn't seem to be writing to the paintdevice I'm pretty sure the qDebug problem is a build setting issue, or an issue with environment settings.
