As your constituent, I am writing today to urge you to request your recognition of the recent events in Iran and to support the Iranian people.

On September 16th, 22-year-old Mahsa Amini was violently arrested in Iran for improperly wearing her headscarf. While she was detained, she was beaten into a coma and died. Her death has sparked an uprising in protests around Iran, standing in solidarity with Amini and against the Iranian Regime. To quell the protests, the Iranian government has shut down the internet and is arresting, beating, and killing protestors, including children.

At this time, Iranians in our state are living in fear and sadness over the injustices their family and friends are experiencing in Iran. Our state representatives must take a public stance in recognizing these atrocities.

Therefore, I am urging you and the United States to support the people of Iran in the following ways:

- To stop the negotiations with the Islamic Republic of Iran for JPCOA. These negotiations provide financial resources and power to suppress the Iranian people furthermore.
- To lead the way at the United Nations by setting up a system to identify and track the abuses in the country and hold the IRI accountable.
- To lead the investigation of the recent events and killings in Iran. This includes the killing of underaged individuals by the authorities in Iran.
- To help provide access to the internet for all. Many communication applications have been blocked by the IRI to limit communication between those outside Iran and their families.
- To welcome Iranian refugees waiting in second countries such as Turkey for resettlement. Many of these refugees faced persecution in Iran and the current situation has made it more dangerous for them.
