Time Trials-

1. There shall be NO Time Trials for Terry Gibson Memorial Fast 50

- 1. All competitors shall be lined up and will start qualifying heats based on points won handicap system
- 2. Qualifying heats shall be 10 laps in length and shall start no more than 8 cars per heat
- 3. Top four finishers per heat shall be locked into Terry Gibson Memorial Fast 50
- 4. Top two finishers per heat shall be eligible for pill draw inversion to determine feature starting position
- 5. Finishing positions three and four from each heat shall start straight up behind cars eligible for inversion.
- 6. Any car not finishing in the top four positions in heat shall move to B-Main
- 7. Number of qualifying heats shall be determined by overall car count.

SUPRS Option-

- 1. At the completion of heats, a provisional starter may be added to the Terry Gibson Memorial Fast 50 line up according to the SUPRS Option Rule
- 2. The driver with the most points in the 2019-20 SUPRS Gold Crest Wing Championship season as of January 13, 2020, and has not qualified for feature and has not already previously used their SUPRS Option, can choose to be added to the feature starting field immediately behind qualified cars.
- 3. If SUPRS Option is used, one less car shall transfer to feature event from B-Main.
- 4. Silver Crest Members are not eligible for SUPRS Option.

B-Main-

- 1. Cars not qualifying through qualifying heats shall run B-Main
- 2. Starting positions for the B-Main shall be determined by finishing order of qualifying heat races.
- 3. Pole position for the B-Main shall go to highest finishing position of qualifying heats. I.E. Fifth position heat 1 starts pole, fifth position heat two starts second and so on.
- 4. B-Main shall be no more than 25 laps.
- 5. Enough finishers shall transfer to Feature to bring starting field up to 20 cars and shall start 'straight up' behind qualified cars.

Feature-

- 1. Top two finishers from each Heat Race will be inverted by pill draw whereas numbers 2, 3, 4, (3,4,5,6 if two heats), will be used. Numbers will be drawn using a computer generated, random draw to determine the amount of cars to be inverted.
- 2. P3 & P4 from Heat Race to be lined up by Points Won Handicap.
- 3. Remainder of cars to be lined up based on their finishing position of the B-Main after inverted cars.
- 4. Terry Gibson Fast 50 shall start no more than 20 cars.
- 5. Terry Gibson Fast 50 shall be no more than 50 laps.
