<b>Planned number of students</b>	34 first and second grade high school students
<b>Planned number of hours per week</b>	1 hour per week
<b>Objectives of the activity</b>	The objectives of this course are to enable students with special needs, as well as regular high school students to acquire important competencies that would allow them to independently and correctly decide on their own behaviors and actions in case of natural disasters and other emergencies. As all people are in situations of danger, disaster and catastrophe, regardless of their abilities or difficulties, our priority in this area is to work in an inclusive manner and simulate real situations in which all members of society are equally involved.
<b>Purpose of the activity</b>	Awareness of the need to acquire practical knowledge and skills to deal with situations of natural disasters and other emergencies. Prepare students to face dangerous and threatening situations and face the consequences, and prepare them to actively take on civic responsibilities and help others who find themselves in the same situation.
<b>Expected educational outcomes</b>	Students will apply the acquired practical knowledge and skills in moments of potentially dangerous situations. It will encourage other students to participate and develop responsible behavior and to help others who find themselves in situations that are potentially dangerous to life and health.
<b>Realization of activities</b>	Theoretical activities will be realized in the classroom and other areas of the school through individual, group and practical work. After the acquisition of theoretical knowledge, outside the classrooms, in real situations and through visits to relevant institutions, practical knowledge and application of practical knowledge will be practiced.
<b>Activity time frame</b>	Commencement of activities School year 2022/23
<b>Activity cost</b>	Material and resources needed to carry out the planned activities.
<b>Evaluation method activities</b>	Regular monitoring of student activities, participation in practical work and assessment.
