

Classroom Reset Planning Tool

When planning a reset, focus on the following things:

1. **State specific actions**, routines/procedures, etc. you are resetting
2. **Give rationale** with a connection to something important (STAAR exam, creating an environment where everyone can learn and feel respected, alignment to your class rules/norms, etc.)
3. **Be transparent** (what isn't working or hasn't been working up to this point? Think about teacher actions as well as student actions) but **positively framed** (things may not have been working in the past but you believe in student and teacher ability to turn things around)
4. **Clear teacher model** planned
5. **Clear student practice** planned
6. **Opportunity for specific praise/feedback** during and after practice

What specific actions/skills/expectations are you targeting with your students? What needs to be reset?		
What is the rationale for why you are doing this reset as a class? Why should kids care about this?		
How will I be transparent but positively frame this so that students recognize the problem but feel open to engaging and confident that things can and will improve?
