ITINERARY:

DAY 1 – A WARM WESTERN WELCOME IN SALT LAKE CITY (THU, JUN 17)

- Arrive by 4:00 PM and meet your friendly Tour Director
- Settle into your hotel and unwind before the adventure ahead
- Enjoy a delicious welcome dinner with fellow travelers
- Visit to Temple Square for the Mormon Tabernacle Choir rehearsal (schedule permitting)

Overnight in Salt Lake City, UT (D)

DAY 2 – SCENIC VALLEYS, BLUE WATERS & JACKSON CHARM (FRI, JUN 18)

- Begin the morning with a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to tour the newly renovated Salt Lake Temple during its 2027 Public Open House — the first time the temple has been open to the public since 1893
- Stop at beautiful Bear Lake — the “Caribbean of the Rockies”
- Journey through serene Star Valley, framed by rugged peaks
- Arrive in Jackson Hole and explore its wooden sidewalks, boutiques, and western saloons

- Marvel at the Grand Canyon of Yellowstone and its roaring waterfalls
- Arrive in West Yellowstone for a relaxing evening

Overnight in West Yellowstone, MT (B)

DAY 4 – OLD FAITHFUL’S POWER & A NIGHT OF COWBOY FUN (SUN, JUN 20)

- Explore colorful geyser basins including Fountain Paint Pots
- Watch Old Faithful erupt in spectacular fashion
- Travel to Cody for a true Western celebration

- Tap your toes to lively cowboy music
- Cap the evening with an exciting professional rodeo

DAY 5 – HISTORY & DINOSAURS (MON, JUN 21)

- Visit the world-class Buffalo Bill Center of the West (5 museums in one!)
- Explore the Wyoming Dinosaur Center with a guided behind-the-scenes experience
- Participate in a hands-on fossil digging activity
- Travel onward to Riverton for a restful evening

DAY 6 – WILD MUSTANGS & WESTERN HERITAGE (TUE, JUN 22)

- Visit the Wind River Wild Horse Sanctuary to meet real wild mustangs
- Learn about deep cultural ties between these horses and Native American traditions
- Explore the Fremont County Museum’s stories of pioneers and Native peoples
- Return to Salt Lake City through stunning Wyoming landscapes
- Enjoy a festive farewell dinner with your travel companions
