Intent Forms

Once a student has enrolled at RCS, there is no application or lottery process required to remain an RCS student. Students who are currently enrolled at RCS are automatically enrolled for the following school year. **HOWEVER**, we do need to know whether your plans have changed and your student will not be returning to RCS next year. We need accurate enrollment figures in order to hire qualified personnel, purchase equipment, plan for space, and most importantly, determine how many openings we will have available for new students to enroll for the 2024-2025 school year.

IMPORTANT REMINDER FOR FAMILIES WITH SIBLINGS WHO WILL BE COMING TO RCS FOR THE FIRST TIME NEXT SCHOOL YEAR:

If your student has a sibling who will be attending RCS for the first time next year, you MUST submit a 2024-2025 Lottery Application for them. This year, we are again working with a company called Lotterease to provide an online application/enrollment process. Siblings of current students will be given priority in the lottery, but we MUST receive an application for them by **NO LATER THAN March 5, 2024** or the computer system will waitlist them. Roxboro Community School Open Enrollment for the 2024-2025 school year is officially underway! We are once again partnering with Lotterease to offer an online application/enrollment process. We will be accepting applications for the 2024-2025 school year from now until March 5, 2024. If we have more applications than openings, we will hold an online lottery on March 7, 2024.

A few reminders

- * Students who are currently attending Roxboro Community School DO NOT need to re-apply to attend next school year.
- * Siblings of current students or alumni DO need to complete an application to attend RCS next year. They are given preference in the lottery because they are the sibling** of a current student or alumni. But they do have to apply by the March 5, 2024 deadline or the Lotterease computer system will automatically place them on a waiting list. [**"Sibling" includes brothers or sisters, half-siblings, step-siblings, or foster siblings living in the same household.]
- * Paper copies of the 2024-2025 application are available at the Front Desk for anyone who does not have internet or computer access.
