The student who has given you this letter is applying to participate in the Jeju Youth Forum 2025. This gathering of over 150 students from 30 cities around the world will take place in Jeju, South Korea with students being gone from October 24 - November 2, 2024.

The Forum is a chance to meet other young people and to share ideas and solutions related to a variety of topics. The theme of the forum is on topics directly related to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). While there is no cost for students to participate in this event, getting to and from Korea with a few days of exploration in Seoul will cost approximately \$3300 - \$3500.

This program requires the student to miss 6 days of classes.

We want to ensure that we are selecting students who are not only motivated and effective listeners and communicators, but who also possess the willingness and ability to adjust to people and situations that may differ from their own social and cultural backgrounds.

We are currently opening the application only to students in the OCDSB's <u>International Certificate</u> <u>Program</u> (ICP).
