 - 6officer for student body, class, or club; committee chairperson; team captain; newspaper editor; work area manager;
 or other community leader, etc).
- <u>Service</u>: service activities are those that are done for or on behalf of others (not including family members) for which no compensation (monetary or otherwise) has been given.
- <u>Character:</u> a person of character demonstrates the following six qualities; trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring, and citizenship
- <u>Citizenship:</u> has participated in organizations which; demonstrate the importance of civic involvement, has a high regard for freedom and justice and makes the student demonstrate mature participation and responsibility.
