



Mano County Sheriff's Office Training Guide

Lieutenant Training: Sergeant Only

Introduction:

Introduce yourself to the Lieutenants formally such as,
"Hello, I am Administrator (Name) and welcome to my Lieutenant Training."

Then tell them the rules for the training, and what happens if they misbehave, or do not follow orders.

"In this training, you are to follow all orders given to you by a Administrator that are reasonable, follow these simple rules and there won't be any issues, Do not speak unless spoken too, Ask for permission to go AFK or Speak, and finally, Act professional & mature."

"If you fail to follow those simple rules, you will be given either laps, or a kick from the training."

After that, announce that it is now uniform check time.

Go through every person and look for the following:

Extremely Spiky Hair,

Abnormal Faces,

Unrealistic Skin Color,

Unneeded Pets or Shoulder Figures,

Unneeded Objects Covering the Face,

Objects Around Their Backs,

Glasses or Weird Hats.

If they have any of that, ask them to change it.

Make sure they have a MCSO uniform on of your liking.

Then do faces, once again, they should know these, but if they don't know them, explain to them the commands:

Eyes Front - Face the Stage

About Face - Face Opposite

Left Face - Face to the left of where you were facing

Right Face - Face to the right of where you were facing

Control Face - Follow the person that said it.

Incline faces - Go at an angle to the specified face.

Then proceed to have them do about face from the stage.

Following that, have the Lieutenant(s) make a Single-File-Line behind you, with 1 stud spacing each. Then direct them with the commands:

Ready,

Prepare,

March!

Then, have the Lieutenant(s) SFL, and march them over to the Shooting range.

Shooting Range:

Have the Lieutenant(s) STS and explain the following to them:

“Welcome to the Shooting Range, here we will be testing your marksmanship, and general firearm capability. There are some basic commands to the range:

Go - Fill in as many booth's as you can.

Unholster - Equip your firearm.

Aim - Aim your weapon.

Fire - Fire your weapon for the selected amount of time.

Cease - Stop firing.

Holster - Unequip your weapon.

Withdraw - Back away from the booths, and STS.

Now, with them having that in mind, have everyone run through it all, then have them SFL again. Lead them to the Defensive Tactics mats.

Defensive Tactics:

Have all of the Lieutenant(s) STS, and explain to them:

“Welcome to Defensive Tactics, here we will be testing your knowledge on the Use of Force Model. Respond properly to the situations and circumstances we provide you with. You should get this correct as you have had lots of time to prepare and train.”

Then have them line up in line(s) depending how many admins are assisting. Give them all the ER-31X, Pepper Spray, Police Baton, and Handcuffs.

Proceed to do each Lieutenant and name them whether they passed or not, and then have them STS.

Once every Lieutenant is done, go to the Breaching House, or Obstacle Course with a SFL.

Breaching House:

Only do this if you know how to breach. All you have to do is explain the breaches and the commands, then have the Lieutenants do it.

Then SFL and march to the beginning spot, and STS, OR go to obstacle course and have them do that.

Ending:

Here you will tell the Lieutenant(s) that they all did fantastic and that it is time for promotions.

Force field anyone that you deem fit for a promotion, and have them walk up to the bottom of the stage. You may promote everyone if you deem them all fit. Anyone who has questions should stay and ask away.
