Looking to be a part of the Gen:Thrive landscape analysis project? As a Washington service provider, begin by navigating to www.genthrive.org/waesemap. Here you will find the Washington "landing page" where you can either *Log In* with an existing account or *Register With Code*.

HOW TO REGISTER:

1. To register an account on Gen:Thrive you will need an invite code. You will have received one from your partner administrator if it exists.
2. If you have not received a code, please reach out via the Contact Us form located in the bottom banner of each Gen: Thrive page. We will reply to your form with your organization's unique invite code.
3. Once you receive a code, navigate to the Register With Code section, or the orange button, on the landing page. This code will automatically associate your email account to the service provider or organization profile.
4. Once you have registered with the correct code, you should be able to add information to the service provider profile, as well as adding programming information. You only need to register once! You can simply log in after registration.

Gen:Thrive

Gen:Thrive, a program of EcoRise, is a collaborative initiative that provides shared data and technology tools to accelerate sustainability and advance health, equity and climate resilience in K-12 schools.

Project Overview Here

The Washington Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) Environmental and Sustainability Education program and E3 Washington, the state affiliate of the North American Association of Environmental Education (NAAEE) are collaborating to build a map of Environmental and Sustainability Education (ESE) providers and associated resources. The map, dashboard, analysis tools, and other features are intended for use by:

1. PK-12 educators/schools/districts to find ESE resources in their region,
2. Community-based organizations, government agencies, and other partners to support service and collaboration,
3. Formal and nonformal PK-12 and pre-service educators to access professional learning/higher education opportunities, and
4. OSPI and others to conduct resource analysis and identify solutions that will best support students historically underserved by science education.

Expected Outcomes

- This map will increase access to and engagement with ESE organizations statewide. It will boost access for educators and community based organizations to find and work with each other. The map will help educators find local organizations engaging in environmental science research, sustainability education, engineering solutions, providing natural resource career pathways in their communities, and more.
- Spatial analysis provides an additional depth and breadth of analysis when compared to traditional resource databases. For example, environmental and socioeconomic data will support educator and student understanding of local environmental problems, perspectives, solutions, and challenges of sustainability.
- The map may be used to customize environmental and sustainability education resources so they best fit the communities we serve.

1. Once you log in, you will see the Gen:Thrive Dashboard. Here you can select Edit Profile to change your personal information, Change Password, or access your Inbox for important Gen:Thrive notifications.
2. Click the Organization Name (IE: EcoRise) link under "My Organizations" to access the Organization and Program surveys for your associated Organization or Service Provider.
3. You can add other Service Provider Contributors or additional organization users by entering their email in the "Invite User" button.

NAVIGATING THE ORGANIZATION DASHBOARD:

1. Once you go into your organization, you will be at the Organization Dashboard. Here you can find the Organization Survey sections and add Programs to the organization.
2. If you have not entered information in an org section survey, you will see a link that encourages to start there. However, if you have input information, it will turn into an edit button. This will open the individual segments of the organization survey.
3. You can select the "Create a New Program" button to add programs to the organization.
