This started on Monday 2/19/2024, one day after I shared concepts of Emergency Power Network (EPN) stickers featuring trans-positive messages. This was the second batch of stickers I had designed, featuring artwork by Derry Luttrell of Dice Will Roll. The two stickers that came up in this conversation are shown above. Cooper's character, Pons, is the brain. The other character is Sworkuz, who is an NPC played by GM Adam.

So, I've gotta talk to you about something, and I was having trouble sleeping because I was thinking about it.

I want to make sure not to misrepresent or misconstrue anything and accidentally cause hurt feelings or mess up friendships but there are a few things I want to talk over with you. If you are working, and don't have the time at the moment, that's fully fair and you can hit me back later, but I'll put a bit here so you have some context on what I want to talk about. Sorry for the text wall.

#### The first is:

Cooper hit me up last night concerning the stickers with the EPN characters and the Trans support messages. He laid out that while he is generally good with the idea, his concern lay with the potential of having his character being directly connected to a stance on Trans athletes. Being in the same field I understand where he is coming from. It's an absurdly complex issue that doesn't have an answer that works for everyone. He would like it if Pons would not be linked to that particular issue. (I know that in your last mock-up batch that message was on the Sworkus sticker, but he's looking at it as a whole.)

I don't want this to come across as Cooper is unsupportive of the LGBTQ+ athletes community or anything, as that isn't at all the case. He even lamented society is so fucked that it can't sort it out in a way to have competitions that is satisfactory for everyone, (I'm paraphrasing obviously, haha). He's just in a position where the issue is a contentious one and having his character, and therefore himself directly, taking a stance one way or another could be a potential issue.

If you have time to do a mumble call or something that might be nice but, again, I know you're probably working right now. I was going to ask you to voice call first but I didn't want to just blind side you or something. Just let me know if that's possible.

Alright. I'm heading home from the store. I'll message you when I get there.

Included below is the letter I read during the call with Adam.

First: I regret that the burden of arbiter has been placed on Adam. I know you have no ill intent in coming to me with this, but you need to know that this is not a small or simple thing that is being asked.

I am deeply disappointed, hurt, angry, sad, and frustrated that we are talking about this. I get more and more NOT OK with it with each passing moment. The Pons sticker isn't even the one with a message about trans athletes. The Pons sticker has the most cat-poster "hang in there" message of ALL the stickers. His complaint doesn't hold water.

There's no EPP branding on the stickers to tie it back to him. Nobody in the gymnastics sphere is going to see a sticker of Pons (if they even see the stickers AT ALL) and think "Hey that's Cooper's character." The Venn diagram of "gymnasts" + "people who listen to EPP" is 2 people: Adam and Cooper.

I can't not take this personally. Trans people are being stepped on so much right now and too few want to stand up for them even in the most microscopic way. Cooper is afraid of the repurcussions of having a nice thing written about trans people on a sticker. Meanwhile others are being actively denied from participating in sports, both at the competetive and recreational levels, and still others are being physically harmed simply for being themselves. I don't even know if I'll be welcome in this country this time next year. That is not the behavior of someone who is "supportive." He quite literally is not supporting trans people here. He can't claim to be supportive if he's apathetic, nor can he be supportive if he actively distances himself from statements of support.

I'm still trying to process everything. My feeling of safety and comfort at the table has definitely been shaken. It's gonna be weird that Pons doesn't have a sticker and everybody else does. But it is Cooper's character, so so be it.

Once again I'm sorry that you are being put in the middle of this conflict between two of your friends.



I don't even know... because there is a split opinion on an important issue that's very personal to yourself, and several at the table. I'm worried I could have misconstrued Coopers viewpoint. I'm worried I ruined everything... from friendships to the whole podcast.

I just fuckin' wrote like three paragraphs and deleted it. I don't want accidently to cut you more. I don't want to speak, or even misspeak for Cooper.

I just... don't want you to think Cooper is a piece of shit for their opinion. I don't think he is taking aim, or trying to shame trans athletes. I don't think he's trying to shame you. I think he wants to have a say in where is voice lies in a really fuckin' complex issue, and he was bringing it to me because maybe it's where he felt safe too. The way he sees things is in such a different perspective, I know for sure it's not with any malicious and bigoted intent.




# Cooper Bishop Today at 2:11 AM

I didnt ask Adam to talk about this with you, he just said he would. I thought Kay was in charge of the stickers initally but I really wasnt clear on what was going on with them when I messaged Adam explaining my concern with it. I could have said "no Ill talk with Leslie about it" when he explained you were the one working on them. I don't think posting in the group chat would have been a good idea on this matter. My goal was to just opt out of my characters being used for messages I havent excplicitedly said I support as there was a topic I didnt support in the mix. I wasnt sure if talking about it with you would make you upset or if you would accept my desires coming from Adam at face value. Im not sure if I could have taken the time to talk in person with you at that time for how quickly I wanted my message delivered. Someone else delivering this message to you was not the best option. I put people at risk of creating a conflict on my behalf with the hope that it wouldnt be a conflict in the first place. I may have also had Adam get in an arguement with you that was unnecessary. But obviously I don't know what was said or how the communication happened. I am still good to talk with you tomorrow late afternoon or sunday if you want. I am also ok to leave the podcast if this is something that will cause continued tension but I would need to check in with everyone to see what is best for the podcast first. I am open to hear out what anyone has to say on the matter but only if all thoughts and opinions will be considered from both parties. I am also ok to just say we have different views and move forward with the relationship. I dont have any negative feelings towards you for your opinion or wanting to express it however I also want to know that my characters voice will stay my own. (edited)

As you can see, we had a second misunderstanding caused by indirect communication. I originally thought Cooper had asked Adam to talk to me.

I did not feel safe at the table but wanted to see if it was possible to get us all to a place where we can play together again. The items below I sent to Cooper and Adam, outlining what it would take for me to feel safe again at this table. In short: if Cooper is doing this to protect his job and not because he holds transphobic beliefs, I felt I can move on from this.



After 5 days of total silence, Adam then responded in a separate group chat, with me and Kay. Cooper was not included and never responded to my previous statement.

I've written down my thoughts and feelings, and for the sake of transparency, I have brought Kay into this conversation.

I've been taking time to sort out the situation and my emotions as best I can. This situation falls to me to decide on and it's been painful to say the least. My life is tumultuous right now, trying to secure a home, work has been pretty bad recently, and for a great many reasons and this situation has drastically affected me. I know this will be hard for you to see or understand, please know that I am coming from a place of empathy and love. You are my best friend and I want things to remain that way.

Right now, as you are reemerging as a new and wonderful person, finding who and what you are in a world of possibilities, everything is fresh and raw. Words can bump up against deeply personal issues, without ever intending malice, dismissal or offense. Everyone at the table is and has been supportive of you and your journey, and I want to make sure that comes across clearly, even when such painful misunderstandings happen.

As GM, it falls to me to oversee and ensure the well being and mental health of everyone at the table, myself included. It is very important to me that everyone has a right to their voice and the feeling of comfort and safety. I want to assure you again that everyone at this table supports you, your journey, and your people, but I fear that guidelines you have offered will make others at the table think that their voices won't be allowed to be heard. Your safety and comfort are important to me, but so are the safety and comfort of everyone else at the table. If everyone is not able to express their concerns in a safe way, where we are all heard and are able to discuss, underlying issues will go unresolved. Those situations are not only unhealthy, but it means that we will all miss our chance to grow.

So for the time being, I would like to ask you to take a step back from the podcast for a bit.

I've set the importance of this issue right alongside Dani and I trying to buy a house, thinking about having children, and how the next 30+ years of our life are going to look. I have it there because of how deeply I care about you. So I think it would be best to give the whole thing some space, and give yourself the room to grow in the way you are striving towards. Then, down the road if the situation changes and you feel the comfort return, then I would be thrilled to have my best friend back in the mix.

All of that said, if we find other opportunities to game together, maybe on the same side of the table for once, I would be fuckin' thrilled. Maybe this environment just isn't the right one at the moment. Kind of like how our game with your coworkers went, how we just couldn't all get on the same page. Maybe we can find something else a little more relaxed to play in. Gods that sounds nice.

If all of this hurts, and is upsetting, then I fully understand. Your feelings are valid. Please take all the time you want to process this. I truly do want only happiness and fruitful discovery for you.

I love you, my friend.

I've tried to keep my personal opinions out of the main body of this document, and included them here.

# My thoughts

The sticker with the "combination particularly discussed" DOES NOT EXIST nor was it planned to exist. The whole reason this was brought to me was completely imaginary. But that is now beside the point.

I am astounded that Cooper and Adam would think that delivering this transphobic message via intermediary was a good idea.

I am hurt that Adam chose to not only allow this transphobic message, but to deliver it himself thereby throwing his support behind it.

You cannot claim to be supportive when you are actively enabling a talking point championed by bigots nationwide.

I will say it again: If cis women athletes were being discriminated against the way trans athletes are, and the sticker was "Protect Women Athletes," this complaint would be immediately recognized as sexist and never would have been brought forward. But since it harms trans people, "we have to make sure everyone's voice can be heard"

Everyone at the table is and has been supportive of you and your journey, and I want to make sure that comes across clearly, even when such painful misunderstandings happen.

The "misunderstanding" I was trying to clear up was whether Cooper held transphobic beliefs or was just taking that stance to protect his job. You initially claimed it was the latter. But when I requested a statement to that effect that would allow me to feel safe at the table, you changed your tone.

See previous statement. I didn't realize we were giving equal talking space to bigoted opinions. Isn't this table a safe space? Or just a "safe space"?

You just missed the chance. Here. Just now. Instead of growing, you doubled down on a bigoted comment.

Re: not "intending malice, dismissal, or offense": *Impact > Intent*. You know, Marc's wife Rhe called me out with this response once, and it's true. We don't always realize the impact we have on others unless someone speaks out. But when someone does speak out, a good ally will listen and change their behavior, not defend it.

You cannot try to claim you are "asking me" to step down. It was already clear I was going to step down due to feeling unsafe at the table after being approached with a transphobic message.

This isn't "The new me" that I am finding, it's only <u>new to you</u>. I was always me, hiding under layers and layers of protective masks that I wore for my own safety.






In the interest of transparency, I feel I should state that if Adam and the remaining crew agree to continue recording new content and finish out this season, I intend to do so as well.

Additionally, I want to address something that was brought to my attention over the last couple of weeks. Kay told me that you reached out to them in a private message to ask if you needed to address me for using "gendering/misgendering" language in response to a message I sent in Roll Ass along the lines of "girl same" or "yas girl" that was intended for them.

If I look at this action in the most positive light, I can interpret your intent as checking in with a friend who may possibly be experiencing discomfort due to another friend's words. But if I look at it in the context of my total past experiences of dealing with individuals who use social justice language in private conversations to gather clout or negatively influence a person's reputation, I have to admit that this knowledge leaves me feeling quite gunshy.

I do not need my speech policed in whispers among friends; viewed in the most cynical way, your query to Kay strikes me as a means of "othering" an individual within a circle of queer-identifying friends for being the "least queer" and calling them to task as a means of bolstering your relationship with another person you deem "more queer".

And the thing he accused me of being the PC police for? A casual check-in with a mutual friend when **I personally** wasn't sure if how they were addressed was how they identified.



I never spoke to Richard about this (because once I got the response from Kay, nothing needed to be said), which means Kay was trying to stir up shit where they KNEW there was none, in order to paint me in a bad light.

# Adam's history of transphobia and abuse

Preface: After struggling with the trauma from this ordeal for 8+ months, I was seeking some kind of closure. Most of the crew has blocked me as of this excerpt, except for Pan (who distanced themself from all this) and Marc (who stepped down when I did). So instead, I reached out to Adam's ex Sam [He/They], who Adam had once told me was trans (I learned through the course of conversation that Sam has since discovered he is intersex and no longer identifies as trans). Sam and Adam lived together for a large portion of their relationship. I am only sharing the parts from Sam that I have permission to share, but I think it shows that, even though I did not see this coming, it was nothing new for Adam.

TM = Twin Mask. The LARP we all used to attend.

Adam said some things that made me feel tiny, in the way, and inhuman. He told me to not be out at TM, he constantly sexualized my body, I actually think he traumatized me more than anyone else because he was supposed to be the nice normal guy and he was suppressing everyone around him in passive toxic masculinity and constantly blaming everyone but himself for not liking his environment. I so believe he would say that to you, but I am not happy to hear it. I am very sorry.

I wish he had grown after we drifted apart; I wish for better things but there is still time to make better times!
